1. OPERATION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE:

Initial Complaint:

On Sunday, November 22, 2020, at approximately 5:31 PM, I was on patrol in marked patrol unit #506. I was notified by Somerset County Communications (SCC) of a possible DUI driver traveling north on N. Main St. in front of Reading Cinema towards Bridgewater unable to maintain a lane. The vehicle was described as a silver colored pickup truck bearing NJ Reg. YCZ35U. Once in the area I observed a pickup truck making a right turn onto E. Main St. nearly hitting a vehicle in the opposite lane of travel stopped at the stop light. I followed the suspected vehicle now traveling east on E. Main St. which at this time was traveling in the middle of a two lane roadway. I confirmed the suspected vehicle to be a 2008 silver GMC Sierra pickup truck, bearing NJ Reg. YCZ35U. At this time I activated my emergency overhead lights and attempted to conduct a motor vehicle stop. The suspect vehicle continued to travel east from E. Main St. onto Talmage Ave. maintaining a speed of 30 m.p.h. It should be noted at this time the suspect vehicle was unable to maintain its lane and almost struck a telephone pole. The suspect vehicle then made a slight right turn onto Columbus Pl., which turned into W. Main St. still traveling east. The suspect vehicle then came to a stop at the ending location of W. Main St. and Drake St. in Bound Brook, NJ.

Once Stopped:

I approached the driver's side window of the vehicle and made contact with a male driver, who was the sole occupant of the vehicle. I asked for his documentation and he handed me a credit/debit card instead. I asked the driver for his driver's license again which he subsequently handed over identifying him as James Iannetti. He was advised of the reason for the stop and questioned on why he did not stop when I activated my overhead emergency lights. Mr. Iannetti advised me he did not think I was attempting to stop him and that he did not see me behind him. While speaking with Mr. Iannetti I detected a strong odor of a consumed alcoholic beverage emanating from the interior of the vehicle. I asked Mr. Iannetti to step out of the vehicle in order to speak with him. As Mr. Iannetti exited the vehicle I observed him holding onto the vehicle for balance and when walking to the rear of the vehicle he stumbled and staggered almost falling. His speech was slow/slurred and his eyelids were droopy. It should be noted while speaking with Mr. Iannetti he was unable to stand up unless he was leaning up against his vehicle.

Tests:

I asked Mr. Iannetti to perform several tests in order to determine if he was intoxicated. He agreed and the tests were performed at the rear of Mr. Iannetti's vehicle.

Alphabet Test:

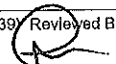
Mr. Iannetti indicated he was familiar with the English alphabet and would be able to recite it. I asked him if he would be able to recite the alphabet starting with the letter C and ending with the letter T. At first Mr. Iannetti advised me he did not understand what I was asking for. I repeated the test and he advised he understood. Instead of starting with the letter C Mr. Iannetti began with the letter A. He stumbled a few times and repeated letters. Mr. Iannetti finished the test with the letter Z instead of the letter T like I had requested.

Counting Test:

Mr. Iannetti was asked to count backwards starting with the number 96 and ending with the number 69. At first Mr. Iannetti advised me he did not understand what I was asking for. I repeated the test again and he advised he understood. During the test he counted backwards in the wrong order many times and when he got to the number 70 he began to count forward. Eventually he realized and began to count backwards again until reaching the number 69.

Walk And Turn:

Mr. Iannetti was asked to perform a series of heel to toe steps on a straight line on the sidewalk. He attempted to start the test before I was finished explaining. Once I advised him to make his way to the starting position of the test he staggered and almost fell onto the ground. At this time I concluded the test.

(37) NARRATIVE OF INVESTIGATION (Continued)

Police Action:

Due to my observations Mr. Iannetti was placed under arrest for D.W.I. He was handcuffed, searched, placed in the rear of patrol vehicle #506, and was read his Miranda Rights on scene. Sgt. Canuso remained on scene for Rich's Towing to remove Mr. Iannetti's vehicle in accordance with John's Law. It should be noted as I was en route to police headquarters my patrol vehicle filled with the odor of a consumed alcoholic beverage.

At Police Headquarters:

Mr. Iannetti was secured to the cuff bar in processing. He was read the NJ Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operations to which he understood. Mr. Iannetti was given the opportunity to submit a breath sample with the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C administered by Ofc. Zangrillo, but refused to do so. He was advised of his Miranda Rights once again, which he advised he understood and did not want to make a statement. An evidence card with Mr. Iannetti's Miranda Rights form was completed and stored into evidence locker #1. Mr. Iannetti was photographed and provided with copies of the summons he was issued (listed below). He was then turned over to his son, later identified as Blaze Iannetti, who signed a Potential Liability Form in accordance with John's Law (see attached). Mr. Iannetti was then released from police custody. A Pursuit Incident Report was then completed and attached.
