ORIGINAL REPORT Reported By: BOTURLA, KYLE D. 1/26/19

On the above date and time, at the intersection of Broadway and Highway 35 north this officer was stopped behind a [REDACTED]. As the light turned green to proceed south, the above mentioned vehicle slowly traveled down the highway at approximately thirteen miles per hour. The posted limit is thirty-five. This vehicle was followed and when it was near the Dunkin Donuts, without signaling, the vehicle crossed over a lane of travel to the right to head south onto River Ave. This officer continued to follow this vehicle south on River Ave. This vehicle was now traveling approximately fourteen to fifteen miles per hour on River, which was a twenty-five mile speed limit. As the vehicle came to a stop at the Arnold Ave intersection, it stayed stopped for several minutes before making a right turn onto Arnold Ave. The vehicle now was traveling west, but in the empty designated parking spots. At this time, this officer activated the emergency lights and conducted a motor vehicle stop.

This officer approached the driver's side door and identified myself as a Pt Beach Police Officer, and asked for all of his credentials. The driver handed his license over and then went into the glove box to retrieve his other documents. The driver's movements were very slow and he dropped his other documents twice before handing them over. The driver was now identified as [REDACTED]. As [REDACTED] asked to why he was stopped, there was a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage detected emanating from his breath and from inside the vehicle. [REDACTED] was advised that he was traveling very slow down two streets, wasn't staying in his lane of travel, and then was traveling through approximately a dozen empty parking spots down Arnold Ave. This officer explained that if there were vehicles parked in them he would've been hitting into the back of each one. [REDACTED] stated "no that's not why" and now wouldn't look at this officer. [REDACTED] was asked where he was coming from which he stated from his house in the boro. This officer asked if he was sure about that because he was being followed down the highway onto two other roads before being stopped. [REDACTED] stated, "I know where I was coming from and I was coming from my house in the Boro and going to drop my friends off." [REDACTED] paused then stated he was in the Inlet Lot where he picked up his two friends, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and now was driving them both home.

This officer asked if anyone had been drinking due to the odor detected and [REDACTED] stated "no." This officer asked [REDACTED] to exit the vehicle and he stated, "no." He was asked a second time and at

this time, he exited the vehicle. [REDACTED] exited his vehicle and was observed staggering alongside his vehicle and then towards the sidewalk. [REDACTED] stopped on a portion of the sidewalk that wasn't level so this officer told him to move into the parking lot for the field sobriety tests.

In the lot, which was level and clear from any debris, this officer began to explain and demonstrate the first test. The first test was the Walk and Turn. [REDACTED] was told not to begin the test until told to, which he understood. [REDACTED] was instructed to take nine steps in a heel-to-toe manner counting each step out loud as he went. When his ninth step was reached, he was to take a series of small pivot steps turning around and going back nine paces, heel-to-toe while counting each step out loud. [REDACTED] stated the he understood and was instructed to begin. [REDACTED] began taking the correct paces, but while stepping he was not in a heel-to-toe manner, he was stepping to the middle of his foot and at times were apart.

The second test was the One Leg Stand. [REDACTED] was asked if he had any leg issues or back problems, which he stated he sees the chiropractor for spinal issues. [REDACTED] was instructed to keep his arms loosely at his sides, raising the leg of his choice approximately six inches off the ground. While his leg is elevated he was to have his toe pointed upward staring at the toe while counting by one-thousands. For example, one- thousand-one, one thousand two, up to and including one thousand thirty. This officer demonstrated the test and after [REDACTED] was asked if he understood, the test which he stated, yes. [REDACTED] was now instructed to begin the test. [REDACTED] was observed to raise his right leg just barely off the ground and kept his knee bent. He counted up to one thousand twelve losing balance and then dropped his leg. [REDACTED] stated that he pulled a muscle and grabbed his arm. [REDACTED] started over and counted not as instructed, tapping his foot on the ground, and then stops to grab his leg saying he sprained his knee.

The last test was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. This officer held a pen out in front of [REDACTED] face approximately fifteen inches away just above eye level. This officer asked [REDACTED] if he could see the tip of the pen. [REDACTED] stated he could. [REDACTED] was asked to keep his head straight and follow the pen with his eyes only. This officer observed lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation, and onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in [REDACTED] eyes.

At this time PO Garcia escorted [REDACTED] to his patrol vehicle where he was searched prior to being placed into the rear of his vehicle. [REDACTED] friend, [REDACTED] was also placed in the rear of R/C 180. Both were now transported to headquarters by PO Garcia. PO Benites transported the back passenger, [REDACTED] to headquarters. Point Beach Towing impounded the vehicle at this time. Once at headquarters, [REDACTED] was contacted and he came to pick her up. [REDACTED] was contacted and she later came to pick him up.

[REDACTED] was placed on the bench and this officer read his Miranda Rights to him, which he signed acknowledging his rights. This officer then read the Standard Statement, which [REDACTED] stated, "No, I prefer not to." The additional statement was now read to [REDACTED] and he stated, "No" to providing breath samples.

This officer now went through the process on the Alco-Test and noted that the subject refused the test and printed the report. [REDACTED] was issued summonses for DWI, Underage DWI, Reckless Driving, Refusal of Breath Samples and Failure to Maintain Lane all with a pending court date of January 4, 2019 at 10am. [REDACTED] was later released [REDACTED] who signed the Potential Liability Form upon release.
