On the above date and time, this officer responded to 1208 Route 35 south (Brave New World), for a report of a male subject acting disorderly inside the store. Prior to receiving the disorderly persons call at Brave New World, this officer was attempting to make contact with the subject at the motels he was paying for a room at (The White Sands and also The Pelican Point Motel). This officer was attempting to make contact with the subject, later identified as [REDACTED], because a crisis worker had been contacted in regard to his mental health and a field screening was necessary. This officer, along with officers Finn, Siculietano, Boturla, K-9 Tyson and Sgt. Kowalewski made contact with the subject. These officers advised [REDACTED] he was no longer allowed in the store as per Brave New World management and we escorted him out of the building. Officer Finn terry

frisked [REDACTED] and guided him into the rear of patrol vehicle 174. This officer then transported [REDACTED] to the Pelican Point Motel where the crisis worker awaited [REDACTED] arrival.

After speaking with [REDACTED] the crisis worker determined [REDACTED] needed to be psychologically evaluated. The crisis worker issued an involuntary commitment form for [REDACTED] and this officer transported [REDACTED] to Ocean Medical Center in Brick Township for the psychological evaluation. After [REDACTED] was admitted into the hospital, hospital security and this officer inventoried [REDACTED] property because he claimed to have a large amount of cash on his person. This officer found a total of \$16,233.00 in cash, seven syringes, Zig-Zag rolling papers, a silver spoon containing a white powdery substance, one translucent bag containing white powder and rocky substance and one yellow tube containing raw greenish/brownish vegetation.

At this time, this officer advised [REDACTED] he was under arrest and he was being charged with possession of a controlled dangerous substance and also possession of drug paraphernalia. This officer advised the hospital staff of the arrest. This officer reported back to headquarters and retrieved [REDACTED] complaint summonses for the charges. This officer then reported back to Brick hospital to serve [REDACTED] with his complaint summonses. [REDACTED] was charged with two counts of Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance, (2C:35-10A(4), 2C:35-10A(1)), and two counts of Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, (2C:36-2, 2C:36-6A). All charges are returnable for court on 01/18/2019 @ 10:00 AM. All evidence was placed in the evidence bin.
