On 01/1/2019 at 0210 hours, P.O. Mergner and I, P.O. Gunnell received a call of a motor vehicle crash. John Tobias from Tow By Us called in stating that he received a call from a male advising that he struck a parked car somewhere off of Bridge Ave and needed a tow. John advised the male, that he needed to call the Police and was unable to give any further information. After checking Bridge Ave with negative results I started to check the side streets. I came down Sleepy Hollow and made a left onto Shady Glen Ave. Upon entering onto Shady Glen Ave I saw a vehicle(NJ Registration W34ESP) crashed into another vehicle(NJ Registration H29DXA). The suspect vehicle had the hazards on. Both vehicles were in front of 2710 Shady Glen. There were no parties in either vehicle. I advised Dispatch of the location of the crash and C.O. Armstrong advised that he just received a call from the homeowner of 2710 Shady Glen.

I made contact with the homeowner, George Clark who advised that they were woke up when they heard the doorbell. George stated that the suspect, Robert Leach knocked on the door advising that he crashed into their car. Robert was sitting at the dining room table eating a sandwich and drinking water upon my arrival. Upon speaking with Robert, his words were slurred and he appeared to be having difficulty completing his sentences. Robert stated that he was at his residence on Sunrise Ave when he went to 7-Eleven. As he was coming home he stated that he lost control of his vehicle due to using his cell phone and crashed into the parked vehicle. While speaking with Robert I was able to smell an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath. P.O. Mergner arrived and I had Robert go outside and speak with P.O. Mergner.

As Robert went outside I spoke with George who stated that nobody inside the residence heard or saw the crash. When they let Robert inside they felt that he was intoxicated. They gave him a sandwich and a bottle of water. Robert crashed into George's daughters, Amanda Kukulski's vehicle. Amanda was at the residence and advised that she would obtain the registration and vehicle insurance. There was no other damage done to any other vehicles.

I went back outside and again spoke with Robert. I asked him if he had any alcoholic drinks that evening and he stated that he drank about a half pint. When asked if he drank more than he should have, he nodded yes and stated "probably". I advise Robert that he would need to perform tests in order to determine if he was intoxicated. I asked Robert if he had any injuries that he would prevent him from performing any tests and he advised that he did not.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test-

I explained the test to Robert and advised him to follow the tip of my pen with his eyes only. Upon starting the test. Robert followed with his head two times before I was able to correctly perform the test. I was able to detect in both eyes, lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation, and onset of Nystagmus at 45 degrees.

Walk and Turn-

Prior to explaining this test, I asked Robert to stand with his right foot in front of his left foot while I demonstrated the test. While he was doing this, Robert was swaying and attempting to keep balance. After I explained and demonstrated the test, Robert was standing with his feet wide apart and not in the position I asked him to be in. When asked if he understood the test and he answered that he was freezing. I again asked if he understood the test and he advised that he understood. Robert began the test and walked nine steps forward. He was unable to touch heel to toe on any step. On the ninth step he asked if that was nine steps. Robert turned around and took ten steps back. Robert did not touch heel to toe on any step.

One Leg Stand-

I explained and demonstrated this test. Robert stated that he understood and Robert was able to count to 25 until I advised him to put his foot down.

Based on my interaction with Robert and the results of the Field Sobriety Tests, I placed Robert under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated(DWI). Robert was handcuffed utilizing the double lock method. Robert was placed in the rear of my patrol vehicle where he was secured using the seat belt. I advised Robert that he was audio and video recorded while in the rear of the vehicle. Dispatch was advised of the arrest and a duty tow was requested. Dispatch advised that Tow By Us would be responding. P.O. Mergner stayed with the vehicle until the tow arrived.

Once at Headquarters, Robert was placed in the processing room. I read Robert his Miranda Warning Rights and he stated that he understood and signed the card. All electronic devices were taken out of the room, to include cell phones, radio and mvr recorder. Robert was read the NJ Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators Form. When asked if he was willing to submit a breath sample in order to determine his blood alcohol concentration(BAC), Robert did not give an answer. I read the last paragraph and again asked Robert if he was willing to submit a sample of his breath. When asked again, he replied " I'll submit to it". Drinking Driver Questionnaire was filled out.

I waited the standard twenty minutes prior to administering the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C. On the first breath sample, minimum volume was not achieved. Robert was able to give a proper breath sample for the next two samples. Mouth piece was changed after each sample. The Alcotest determined that Robert's BAC was .16%. These results were entered into the NJSP Alcotest calculator and found to be within an acceptable tolerance. Robert was given a phone call and called his father, Robert Leach Sr. who advised that he would respond to Headquarters.

I issued Robert his summons which included DWI-E19-000013, Reckless Driving-E19-000014, and Operating Vehicle with cell phone-E19-000015. All with a court date of 02/02/2019 at 1600 hours. Shortly later, Robert Sr arrived and was given potential liability form. He read and signed the form taking Robert Jr into his custody. No further action was taken.

On 1-11-18 at 1852 hrs, I, PO Maloney, responded to the corner of Cedar St and River Ave with PO Grohowski, Sgt. Wells and Lt. Radsniak for a motor vehicle accident involving an unconscious male that struck a fence at 900 River Ave. See 19-9-AC for reference. On arrival, I observed an NJ: Y11AKJ facing east on Cedar St with its front right bumper pressed against the fence of 900 River Ave. I also observed three females later identified as Carylton Jones, Katelyn Narcy, and Kerry Clayton in the roadway next to the vehicle. When I exited my patrol vehicle, I asked the ladies if the operator was conscious. They replied yes, but he seemed confused. I then approached the driver side door which was already opened and observed Kevin Buckwald in the driver side seat. It should be noted that there was a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle. I immediately asked Kevin if he needed any medical attention, while I scanned his body for any signs of injury. Kevin told me that he didn't need medical attention. It should be noted that I saw no signs of injury nor was there an airbag deployment, and when Kevin spoke to me the smell of an alcoholic beverage intensified.

At that time Carolyn, Katelyn, and Kerry informed me they were driving behind Kevin and observed the incident happen. It should be noted Carolyn and Katelyn were in the same vehicle which was directly behind Kevin's vehicle. Kerry was in a vehicle directly behind Carolyns and Katelyns. The ladies went on to say that Kevin was unconscious while in the driver seat and his vehicle "rolled " into the fence. PO Grohowski then spoke to the witnesses in depth. See his supplemental narrative for his findings.

After Kevin didn't want medical attention, he immediately told me he wasn't driving. It should be noted Kevin 's keys were on the passenger seat next to him. I then asked Kevin to provide me with his driver's license, insurance card, and registration. While he was looking for his documents, I began to ask him some questions. I asked Kevin if he had been drinking tonight to which he replied he had been. He then told me he loves us, meaning the police officers because his father was a state trooper. I then asked Kevin if he knew where his documents were, and he began to look again. While looking, I asked Kevin if he knew what day it was, and he answered by saying 210. I then asked him what 210 was, and he said it was his father's badge number. I then repeated the question, and Kevin did not know what day it was. I asked Kevin where he was drinking, and he told me at his friend Sandra's house. Also saying her house was located in Brick NJ, but could not give an exact address. While talking to him, Kevin blurted out that he was "fucked," implying he knew he was going to be in trouble for driving while intoxicated. It should be noted during my conversation with Kevin he consistently stumbled on his words and they were also slurred.

I then had Kevin step out of the vehicle and advised him I would be taking him through a series of sobriety tests. Before the test began, I asked Kevin if he had any medical issues that would prevent him from taking the test. Kevin told me he broke his foot. I then asked if it was still currently broken. Kevin then smirked at me and paused for a second. He then said he broke his right foot two years prior. I then asked him if he could take the test to which he said he could.

One Legged Stand

I then told Kevin to raise either leg he felt more comfortable with into the air approximately six inches. I then told him to count one one thousand two one thousand three one thousand while his foot was in the air until I told him to stop. While giving him these instructions, I also demonstrated the test to him. Kevin then began and raised his right leg in the air. As soon as he raised his left leg in the air before he finished one one thousand his right leg crossed over his left and he began to stumble. I then Kevin to make another attempt at the test. He then began the test again with the same results. I asked Kevin to perform the test one more time. When I did so, Kevin

replied saying "put me in handcuffs; I'm fucked." At that time I placed Kevin under arrest for driving under the influence.

I then responded to Police Headquarters with Lt Radsniak, while PO Grohowski stayed with Kevin's vehicle until the duty tow retrieved it. At Police Headquarters Lt. Radsniak read Kevin his Miranda warning to which he replied he did not want to talk and wanted a lawyer present if we began to question him. Lt. Radsniak then read him the New Jersey Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators form to which he refused to take the Alcotest. See Lt. Radsniak supplemental narrative for his findings. Kevin was then fingerprinted and processed.

Kevin was charged with 39:3-29a (failure to possess a driver's license), 39:3-29b (failure to possess a registration), 39:3-29c (failure to possess a insurance card), 39:4-97 (careless driving), 39:4-96 (reckless driving), 39:4-50 (driving under the influence), 39:4-50.4a (refusal to submit to a chemical test).

Kevin's daughter, Tess Buckwald responded to Police Headquarters to retrieve Kevin. Tess was advised of the Potential Liability and signed off on the form. Before leaving Kevin was given a copy of his summons's and informed on where to retrieve his vehicle.

SUPPLEMENTAL NARRATIVE FOR LIEUTENANT DAVID L RADSNIAK

Ref: 19-10-AR

I assisted PO Maloney in this investigation by operating the Alcotest. I read the Miranda Rights card to Kevin Buckwald to which he replied, "I want a lawyer". Following this, I read the NJ Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators. Upon asking Mr Buckwald to provide samples of his breath he replied, "No". I went on to read additional paragraph to which Mr. Buckwalk again said, "No" when asked if he would provide samples of his breath. I then operated the Alcotest and selected Refusal. I signed the Alcohol Influence Report and handed it to PO Maloney.

Lt. David Radsniak

On 1-11-19, at 1852 hours, I, Officer Grohowski, along with Lt. Radsniak, Sgt. Wells, and Officer Maloney, responded to the intersection of River Ave and Cedar Street for a report of a motor vehicle accident, where the driver was unconscious. Upon arrival, Officer Maloney was speaking with the driver, who was now alert and conscious. There were several people standing off to the side of Cedar Street. I heard one of them say that they witnessed the accident. I walked over to the group.

I first spoke with Kerry Clayton. She said that she was driving south on Cedar Street, approaching the intersection with River Ave. She stated that she stopped behind two vehicles. The vehicle directly in front of her was another witnesses vehicle, Carolyn Jones. The vehicle in front of Ms Jones's vehicle was the suspect vehicle. Ms. Clayton said that she was stopped for at least three minutes before she observed Ms. Jones pull her vehicle next to the suspect vehicle. She said that she observed Ms. Jones get out of her vehicle and look in the driver's window of the suspect vehicle. Ms. Jones turned towards Ms. Clayton's vehicle and shrugged her shoulders. Ms. Jones woke up the male driver and he began yelling at Ms. Jones. Ms. Clayton said that the suspect vehicle then rolled forward, across River Ave, and collided with the fence.

I then spoke with Ms. Jones. She said that she was stopped behind the suspect vehicle at the intersection of Cedar Street and River Ave for at least five minutes. She pulled her vehicle next to the suspect vehicle and observed the male driver slumped over. She put her vehicle in park, exited her vehicle, and looked into the driver's window of the suspect vehicle. Ms. Jones said that the male driver was sleeping. She woke him up and he began yelling at her. The suspect vehicle rolled forward, across River Ave, and into the fence of 900 River Ave. She said that she called 911.

I spoke with Katelyn Narcy, the passenger in Ms. Jones's vehicle. She confirmed what Ms. Jones told me.

I made contact with the home owner, Samantha Willmot, at 900 River Ave, where the fence was damaged. I advised her of the incident and provided her with the Case Number.

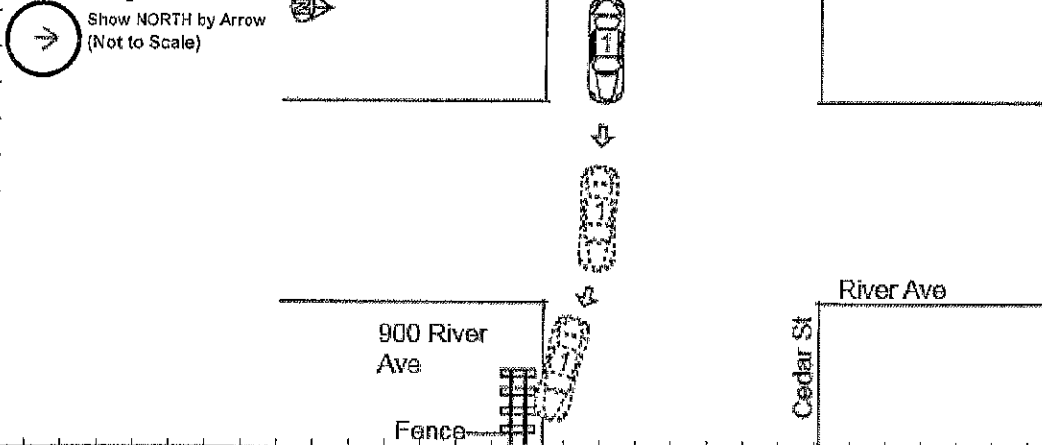

145. Crash Description/Narrative

I, PO Maloney, responded to the corner of River Ave and Cedar St for an unconscious male who crashed into the fence of 900 River Ave. On arrival, I observed Vehicle 1 facing east on Cedar St with its right front bumper pinned against the fence.

A witness named Carolyn Jones, was behind vehicle 1 when the incident occurred. Carolyn advised that Vehicle 1 was traveling at a low rate of speed, so she pulled alongside the vehicle. When doing so, she observed the D1 unconscious behind the wheel. She advised me that the car continued to roll down the street until the vehicle struck the fence. Katelyn Narcy was in the vehicle with Carolyn and confirmed her story. D1 was arrested for 39:4-50. See 19-10-AR for reference.

A third witness named Kerry Clayton was behind Carolyn's vehicle and also observed the incident.

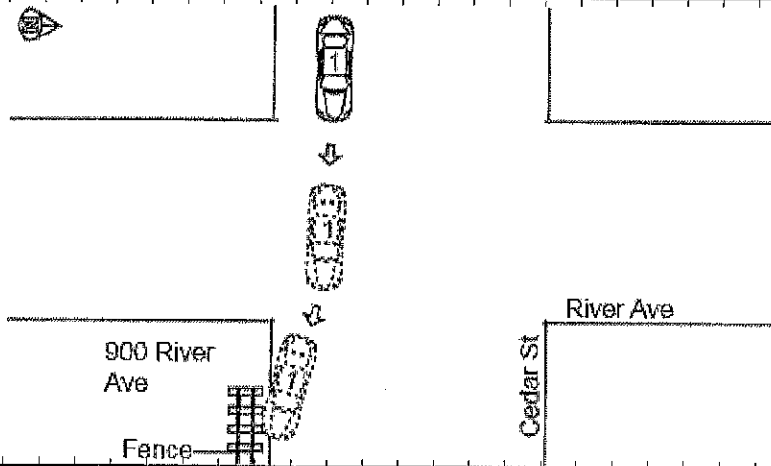

I, Officer Mergner, was conducting stationary radar on Beaver Dam Rd near Oriole Way. While conducting stationary radar, my vehicle was parked facing South in the parking lot of the business at 1620 Beaver Dam Rd. At this time, the weather was approximately 23 degrees Fahrenheit and clear. While conducting radar, I observed vehicle NJ:UVF83U traveling North on Beaver Dam Rd approaching my location. At this time, I observed that the front driver side headlight appeared to be out.

As the vehicle approached, I estimated the vehicle to be traveling approximately 43MPH in a posted 35MPH zone. I then activated my Stalker Radar Unit and received a reading of 47MPH. The audio pitch was high and clear. I then locked the reading into the unit. The vehicle then decelerated as it passed my location. As the vehicle passed, I turned on my headlights and entered the roadway in an attempt to perform a motor vehicle stop.

As I closed the distance on the vehicle, it turned onto Balle Ln. Once I completed my turn onto Balle Ln, I activated my emergency lights in an attempt to complete a motor vehicle stop for the above mentioned violations. The vehicle then came to a stop. I then approached the driver side of the vehicle.

As I approached the vehicle, I could observe the operator, later identified as Linda A. Lagos, searching in the vehicle. After I was standing at the driver side window for several seconds, Linda appeared to have difficulty lowering the window to speak with me. Linda was observed turning multiple knobs on the dashboard. Linda first turned on the heating and cooling system which appeared to be on full power. Linda was then able to shut it off and put the window down to speak with me. As the window was going down, music started playing from the radio at a loud level. Linda then turned the music off. At this time, Linda's eyes appeared watery.

I then identified myself, advised Linda she would be audio and video recorded, and requested her license, registration, and insurance. At this time, Linda provided me her New Jersey Driver's License. Linda then began searching for the additional documentation. Linda had difficulty finding the credentials and eventually provided me her registration but stated she was unsure if it was the correct one. Linda then asked the reason for the stop and asked if it was because of speeding. At this time, I detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath.

I then asked Linda where she was going. Linda advised me she was heading home. I then confirmed that home was on Northstream Pkwy. Linda was then asked if she knew where she was. Linda advised me she was in Point Pleasant. When I asked Linda what street, Linda advised she did not know this street. It should be noted that Balle Ln is a dead-end street with no outlet. I then reminded Linda that I was waiting for proof of insurance. Linda continued looking. While searching for the documentation, Linda appeared to be fumbling through the papers and was having difficulty locating the insurance information.

Linda then apologized and admitted she had been drinking and was on her way home. Linda was questioned to the amount of drinks and she replied three. Linda then informed me that she was returning from Tuscany in Brick, NJ. I again reminded Linda I was waiting for proof of insurance. Linda then provided the insurance information. Linda again asked what she was stopped for and I advised her that she was speeding and her driver side headlight was out. Linda replied that she thought the headlight may have been out. I then realized the proof of insurance Linda provided was expired and advised her to continue looking for the current one while I return to my vehicle. Linda was advised to remain in the vehicle.

At this time, Officer Aurin arrived on scene. I then went to speak with Officer Aurin. While speaking with him, Linda exited her vehicle and approached our location. Linda then advised that she found the current proof of insurance. I then questioned Linda again in regards to the drinking. Linda confirmed she had three drinks. Linda then stated, "Please don't. I'm a nurse." I advised Linda the reason for the stop as well as her admitting she had been drinking. Linda then stated "Please don't give me the DUI." I then asked Linda if she was intoxicated and she started to respond "Proba-." Linda did not finish the statement. I then advised Linda there would be no issue if she was not intoxicated and she stated she was not.

Linda was then advised she would be asked to complete some tests to determine her level of intoxication. Linda was advised of my reasoning for the testing. Linda stated she was just going home. At this time, I advised Linda that Balle Ln is a dead-end street. Linda kept repeating, "Please" and stated she was sorry.

Walk-and-Turn

Linda was then asked to place her right foot in front of her left, heel-to-toe, and keep her arms down at her side as I explained the test. Linda had to be told multiple times before she assumed the position. It should be noted, Linda failed to properly place her feet heel-to-toe at this time. Linda was then corrected. I then explained, and demonstrated, the test. Linda was advised she was to take nine steps, heel-to-toe, with her arms down at her side. Linda was advised on the ninth step, to take small steps with her outside foot to turn. Linda was advised to count out loud during the test. Linda was asked if she understood the directions and she stated "I do." Linda was asked if she had any injuries and she stated no. Linda then stated she doesn't know if she is going to pass.

Linda then stated she did not want to perform the test. Linda was advised of additional consequences should she refuse to complete the testing. Linda then stated she knows she's not that bad and she was almost home. Linda then continued to attempt to reason with Officer Aurin and myself. Linda eventually agreed to attempt the test. I explained, and demonstrated, the test again.

Linda then attempted the test. Linda took nine steps and counted out loud. In all nine steps, Linda failed to place her feet heel-to-toe missing by approximately 2-3 inches each time. Additionally, her feet were not in a straight line as she took the steps. After the ninth step, Linda stopped and asked for additional explanation. I advised Linda the test had already been explained to her. Linda then took ten steps back, counting out loud. Linda again failed to touch her feet heel-to-toe during the ten steps back.

One-Leg Stand

Linda was advised to stand with her feet together and her arms down at her side while I explained, and demonstrated, the next test. Linda then assumed the position. I explained to Linda that she was to lift the foot of her choice off of the ground approximately six inches. Linda was advised to keep her foot parallel to the and her arms at her side. Linda was instructed to count out loud starting with 1001 and continue until told to stop. Linda was asked if she understood the directions and she confirmed she did. Linda then asked some clarifying questions. Linda was then instructed to begin the test.

Linda then moved her left leg forward, lifting her toe, while keeping the heel of her shoe on the ground. Linda began counting, 1001, 1002, 1003, 1004, 1005. I then instructed Linda to stop due to her failing to lift her

leg off of the ground. Linda then apologized and attempted the test again. Linda lifted her left leg and counted to 1001 before she stumbled to her right. Linda was asked if she wished to attempt the test again but did not answer.

Officer Aurin then attempted to perform the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN). The test was inconclusive due to Linda's failure to follow directions. Sgt McNally, who had arrived on scene during the testing, then attempted to completed the HGN test. Sgt McNally's test was inconclusive as well for similar reasons.

I then placed Linda under arrest of Driving Under the Influence (39:4-50). Linda was handcuffed utilizing the double locking technique. Linda was then searched incident to arrest and placed in the back of my patrol car. Linda was then advised she would be audio and video recorded and was seat belted in. Officer Aurin then advised me that a 50ML unopened bottle of Absolut Vodka was found in the center console area near the shifter. I then transported Linda to Police Headquarters while Sgt. McNally remained with her vehicle pending impound per John's Law. Tow-By-Us later responded and impounded the vehicle.

Once back at Police Headquarters, Linda was advised of her Operating Under the Influence Rights. Linda first answered "I don't know." Linda was read the final section and she replied, "I'm not refusing." Linda then refused to give an answer of yes and continued to reason with Officer Aurin and I. After several minutes, Linda stated "I will" in regards to submitting breath samples. A 20 minute observation was then completed.

Officer Aurin then operated the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C. Linda failed to properly complete the test on the first two attempts. Linda was advised it would be considered a refusal to submit breath samples if she failed to give a proper sample on the next attempt. Linda then complied. Linda's Blood Alcohol Content was determined to be a .10%. A Drinking Driver Questionnaire, Point Pleasant Police Drinking-Driving Report, and a Driving While Impaired - Last Drink Location Report, were then completed. Linda was then finger printed and photographed. Linda was then placed in cell #4 and a Suicide Evaluation Form was completed. A Property Receipt was then completed for Linda's property. Linda was issued Summons E19-000023 for 39:4-98, E19-000024 for 39:3-66, E19-000025 for 39:4-50, E19-000026 for 39:4-97, and E19-000027 for 39:4-96. The 50ML bottle of Absolut Vodka was entered into the Beast and secured in temporary locker #8.

Linda was advised that she would need an adult to pick her up in order to be released per John's Law. Linda advised me that she did not have anyone who would be able to come get her. Linda was then placed in cell #4. Linda was released at 0657hrs. Linda was offered a ride back to her residence which she refused. A Daily Radar Enforcement report was completed and submitted to records. A Last Drink Location Report was faxed to NJABC.

On 1/19/2019, I, Officer Nicholas Rossi was in marked patrol vehicle #9 traveling west on Route 88 just west of Bridge Avenue. As I continued traveling west, I observed a vehicle approaching my patrol vehicle traveling east on Route 88. I observed the above vehicle failing to maintain its lane of travel, specifically by swerving over the marked white fog line of the highway several times. As the vehicle passed my patrol vehicle I was able to observe that it was a grey Kia sedan.

I safely turned my patrol vehicle around in the Sundaes Ice Cream parking lot on Route 88. As I re-entered onto Route 88 I observed the above vehicle approach the green traffic signal at the intersection of Route 88 east and Bridge Avenue. The above vehicle signaled a right hand turn onto Bridge Avenue and came to a stop prior to making the turn. The traffic signal was still observed to be green at this time. I closed the distance on the above vehicle and observed the vehicle drifting from side to side in the eastbound lane of travel on Bridge Avenue. I initiated a motor vehicle stop on the above vehicle (NJ-J80KNG), in front of 2310 Bridge Avenue (Gerard's Wine and Spirits). I exited my patrol vehicle and approached the above vehicle from the passenger's side.

As I was walking up to the vehicle, I could hear the vehicle's stereo system playing very loud. The front passenger's side window was rolled all of the way up. I illuminated the interior of the vehicle with my flashlight and knocked on the window several times, but I was unable to get the operator's attention. There was a female subject in the driver's seat who was the sole occupant of the vehicle. She was going through various documents at this time. After approximately 10-15 seconds the operator of the vehicle acknowledged my presence and rolled the window down. I identified myself and asked the operator to turn the radio down so I could speak with her, which she did. I asked the operator, later identified as Evelyn Cordorivas, for her license, registration and proof of insurance. Ms. Cordorivas handed me a yellow paper which was from the Lakewood Police Department referencing an accident report that she was involved in. Ms. Cordorivas went on to inform me that she was in an accident earlier in the morning in Lakewood Township. Ms. Cordorivas then handed me an expired insurance card stating that she did not have the current one with her. Lastly, she handed me her license and registration card. P.O. Aurin arrived on scene. Ms. Cordorivas stated that she was coming back from work in Jackson Township where she is a home care aid. While speaking with Ms. Cordorivas, I could smell the faint odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from within the vehicle. I also observed her eyes to be bloodshot/watery. There were also two six packs of 12 oz. Coors Banquet beers and a twelve pack of 12 oz. Budweiser beers on the front passenger's side seat. All of the beers were unopened.

I returned to my patrol vehicle and checked Ms. Cordorivas' license and registration both of which were valid. Based on the operation of the vehicle and the odor of alcohol I asked Ms. Cordorivas to step outside to perform field sobriety tests. I directed her to an area on the sidewalk which was well lit and clear of debris. I asked her if she had any alcoholic drinks and she stated, no. I asked her if she took any medications and she stated that she took blood pressure medication and water pills. I also advised that I observed her eyes to be bloodshot. She stated that was from her contact lenses. As I spoke with her further I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath. The first test that I explained was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test.

I asked Ms. Cordorivas to stand with her feet together and her hands down by her side. I asked her if she had any medical conditions that affect her eyes and she stated, no. I advised Ms. Cordorivas that I would be checking her eyes and to keep her head still and follow the tip of my pen with her eyes only. First, I performed a medical assessment and verified that she had equal pupil size and no resting nystagmus. Next, I ensured that equal tracking was present. During the test, I detected lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained

nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and the onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Vertical Nystagmus was checked and not present.

The next test that I explained and demonstrated was the walk and turn test. I asked Ms. Cordorivas if she had any injuries that would keep her from performing balance tests. She stated that she had [REDACTED]. I observed that she had sneaker heels on and she was afforded the option of taking them off for the test, which she did. She was asked to stand with her feet together and her arms down by her side. When told to do so, she was to take nine heel to toe steps down the line, and return nine heel to toe steps. On the ninth step, she was to keep her front foot on the line and turn by taking a small series of steps with the opposite foot. While walking, she was to keep her eyes on his feet at all times, count each step out loud and keep her hands down by her side. When asked if she understood these instructions, she stated that she did, but asked how many steps she should take and how she was supposed to walk. I clarified both questions and again asked her if she understood the instructions to which she stated, yes. Ms. Cordorivas then began the test. She took nine steps forward counting the steps out loud as directed. She did not touch heel to toe on any of the steps forward. Upon reaching the ninth step, she stopped and stood still. After a few seconds I advised her to turn around and take nine steps back down the line. Ms. Cordorivas took the requested nine steps back, but again did not touch heel to toe on any of the steps.

The next test that I explained and demonstrated was the One Leg Stand Test. I asked Ms. Cordorivas to stand in the starting position, feet together and hands at her side. When told to do so, she was to raise the foot of her choice approximately six inches off of the ground while counting out loud 1001, 1002, 1003 and so on until told to stop. I asked her if she understood these instructions and she stated that she did. I advised that she could begin the test. She then asked, 1000 how much. I again clarified the test for Ms. Cordorivas until she understood. She then began the test. On the first attempt, she raised her right leg which was bent at the knee with her foot pointing straight down towards the ground. She counted out loud until reaching 1007 and began falling to her left side. On the second attempt, she raised her left leg bent at the knee for approximately one second and put it back down on the ground. On the third attempt, she raised her left leg again still bent at the knee and rapidly counted upwards 100, 101, 102, until reaching 112 and put her foot back down. The Field Sobriety Tests were concluded at this time.

Based on the operation of the vehicle, the Field Sobriety Tests, as well as my observations Ms. Cordorivas was placed under arrest for 39:4-50 (Driving While Intoxicated). She was directed to the front of my patrol vehicle where she was handcuffed (double locked), searched and placed into the rear seat. She was advised that she was being audio/video recorded while in the patrol vehicle. All of Ms. Cordorivas' property was placed into a property envelope and secured into the rear of my patrol vehicle. P.O. Aurin stood by with the vehicle until the duty tow Ocean Bay responded towing the vehicle to meet the John's Law requirement. Ms. Cordorivas was transported to Police Headquarters and handcuffed to the bench inside of the processing area.

All cell phones, portable radios, MVR recorders and other electronic devices were removed from the room and a twenty minute observation period was started utilizing the clock on the Alcotest. I read the Miranda Rights card to Ms. Cordorivas which she acknowledged that she understood. I then read the Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operator's form to Ms. Cordorivas to which she replied yes to providing samples of her breath. I also filled out the Drinking Driver Questionnaire. After waiting the standard twenty minutes, Ms. Cordorivas was given five attempts to provide samples of her breath. The mouthpiece was changed after each sample. Only one of the attempts was successful with the others displaying an error message of

minimum volume not achieved. Ms. Cordorivas was not following the directions provided and was only blowing for a short amount of time and then stopping. After explaining the directions to her several times, she still only continued to blow for a short period of time. She was then advised that she was being charged with Refusal to Submit to Breath Samples.

I processed Ms. Cordorivas including fingerprints and photographs. Ms. Cordorivas placed a phone call to her husband Jorge Rivas-Labra who responded to Police Headquarters and met with Sgt. McNally. He read and signed the Potential Liability Warning. He was given his copy of the form. Ms. Cordorivas' property was returned to her and she signed the Property Receipt indicating same. She was given her copy of the form. She was released from custody at 0209hrs. I issued and explained the following summonses to Ms. Cordorivas regarding this incident all with a court date of 2/4/2019 at 1600hrs:

On 1/26/2019, I, Officer Nicholas Rossi was on patrol in marked patrol vehicle #4. I was the first vehicle stopped at the red traffic signal on Route 88 west at the intersection with River Avenue. I observed a dark colored Audi convertible traveling north on River Avenue. The above vehicle signaled a left hand turn and proceeded to make the turn at a very low rate of speed. The turn was made at a wide angle and the vehicle nearly drove into the curb line in front of the Cookie Lady Cafe with the front passenger's side tire. The vehicle continued traveling west on Route 88. The environmental conditions were clear and the roadway was dry.

I closed the distance on the above vehicle which was the first vehicle in front of my patrol vehicle. The above vehicle was slowly increasing its speed and I was able to pace it as traveling 50 MPH utilizing my patrol vehicle's calibrated speedometer. Upon reaching Mistletoe Avenue, I observed the vehicle's brake lights activate for several seconds then the vehicle continued traveling west on Route 88 through the intersection with Bridge Avenue. Near the area of Arthur Avenue I activated my emergency lights to initiate a motor vehicle stop. The vehicle kept traveling west on Route 88 and activated the left turn signal turning onto Jordan Road south. After the turn I activated my patrol vehicle's audible device in an attempt to get the operator's attention to pull over. The vehicle then pulled over shortly after turning onto Jordan Road. I observed the registration as NJ-H75GYD.

I exited my patrol vehicle and approached the vehicle from the passenger's side. I observed a male subject seated in the driver's seat who was the sole occupant of the vehicle. I knocked on the window and he rolled it down. I identified myself and asked the operator for his license, registration and proof of insurance for the vehicle. He began looking for the above documents and I observed his hand movements to be extremely slow. I asked the male where he was coming from and he stated, Toms... Brick Town. I advised him that I observed him coming from Point Pleasant and asked if he knew where in Point Pleasant he was coming from and he only stated, yeah. After approximately one minute he handed me his license and was identified as William H. Taylor Jr. He kept looking for the insurance and registration cards. As I spoke further with Mr. Taylor Jr. I could detect the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from within the vehicle. He then handed me his registration and an expired insurance card. He stated that he recently switched insurance companies and eventually found an up-to-date insurance card. I asked him if he had anything to drink tonight and he stated that he had two beers at the Idle Hour.

I asked Mr. Taylor Jr. to perform some tests while he remained seated in the vehicle. He replied by saying that he is unable to walk straight due to [REDACTED]. I asked Mr. Taylor Jr. if he knew the English Alphabet and he stated that he did. I then asked him to say the alphabet starting with the letter "D" as in dog, and ending with the letter "T" as in tango. I asked him if he understood these instructions, and he stated that he did. He then stated, D, O, G... um, and paused for several seconds. He then stated a second time, D,O,G... um, and again paused. He then stated that he was done with the test. I then asked Mr. Taylor Jr. if he could count to the number 100, and he stated that he could. I asked Mr. Taylor Jr. to start at the number "13" and count upward stopping at the number "30". Mr. Taylor Jr. completed this test without issue.

I then asked Mr. Taylor Jr. to exit and meet me at the rear of the vehicle. Prior to exiting he advised me that he cannot walk a straight line or balance due to [REDACTED]. While walking to the rear of the vehicle I observed his movements to be slow. While I was speaking with Mr. Taylor Jr. I observed him to have a flushed/red face and watery eyes. I then directed Mr. Taylor Jr. to an area of the roadway that was well lit and clear of debris for the purpose of Field Sobriety Testing. The next test that I explained was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test. I asked him to stand with his feet together and his hands down by his side. I asked Mr. Taylor Jr.

if he had any medical conditions that affect his eyes, and he stated no. I asked him to take his eyeglasses off for the test which he did. I advised Mr. Taylor Jr. that I would be checking his eyes and to keep his head still and follow the tip of my pen with his eyes only. First, I performed a medical assessment and verified that he had equal pupil size and no resting nystagmus. Next, I ensured that equal tracking was present. During the test I detected lack of smooth pursuit in his left eye only, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and the onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in his left eye only. Vertical Nystagmus was checked and not present. During the test I observed Mr. Taylor Jr. to be swaying slightly from left to right.

The walk and turn test and the one leg stand test were not conducted due to Mr. Taylor Jr's [REDACTED]. Based on the operation of the vehicle, the Field Sobriety Tests as well as my observations Mr Taylor Jr. was placed under arrest for 39:4-50 (Driving While Intoxicated.) He was handcuffed (double locked), and searched. Mr. Taylor Jr's property was placed into an evidence bag and a Property Receipt was later filled out. We attempted to place Mr. Taylor Jr. into the rear seat of my patrol vehicle, but were unsuccessful due to him not being able to move his legs inside while handcuffed. Sgt. McNally responded to headquarters and drove patrol vehicle #15 back to the scene. Mr. Taylor Jr. was placed into the rear seat of patrol vehicle #15, which has a bigger back seat, and I transported him to Police Headquarters. P.O. Waterson stood by with the vehicle until the duty tow Sleepy Hollow responded towing the vehicle to meet the John's Law requirement.

At headquarters, Mr. Taylor Jr. was secured to the bench inside of the processing area. All cell phones, portable radios, MVR recorders and other electronic devices were removed from the room and a twenty minute observation period was started utilizing the clock on the Alcotest. I read the Miranda Rights card to Mr. Taylor Jr. which he acknowledged that he understood. I then read the Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operator's form to Mr. Taylor Jr. to which he replied, yeah, to providing samples of his breath for testing. The Drinking Driver Questionnaire and the Last Drink Location report were also filled out. After waiting the standard twenty minutes, Mr. Taylor Jr. was able to provide two acceptable breath samples. The mouthpiece was changed after each sample. The results of the test were determined to be .11% BAC. The results were confirmed through the NJSP Alcotest calculator and found to be within acceptable tolerance. P.O. Waterson processed Mr. Taylor Jr. including fingerprints and photographs. Mr. Taylor Jr. stated that he did not wish to call anyone to pick him up. He was then placed into cell #3 with a Suicide Evaluation form completed. Mr. Taylor Jr. was later released from custody at 1020hrs. by P.O. Phillips. His property was returned to him and he signed the Property Receipt indicating same. Mr. Taylor Jr. was issued the following summonses as a result of this incident all with a court date of 2/4/2019 at 1600hrs:
