On August 10, 2019 at approximately 0351 hours, I P.O. Ippolito responded to the area of Herbertsville and Boulton Ave for a report of a motor vehicle accident. Upon arrival, I observed the vehicle parked at the intersection of Boulton Ave and Herbertsville Rd. The operator Francine Zichella was located by the drivers side of the vehicle and the vehicle had been moved off the roadway out of the way of traffic. I spoke with Ms Zichella who believed that she had been travelling towards Howell where she resided, when she had gotten into an accident(see 19-284-AC for full report). Ms Zichella stated that she was coming from her boyfriends house and was heading home to Howell. She advised that her boyfriend lived on Cramer Rd in Point Pleasant Beach and the two had recently got into an argument. I asked Ms Zichella if she had anything to drink that evening and she responded "no". While speaking with Ms Zichella I detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage and slurred speech. First aid was dispatched.

During the HGN test Ms. Zichella had a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. She also had distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation as well as onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. I asked Ms Zichella if she had any issues with her eyes and she advised that she was legally blind without her glasses.

I advised Ms. Zichella that I would be conducting some further testing. I began explaining and demonstrating the One Leg Stand test to her. After my explanation and demonstration Ms. Zichella confirmed that she understood my instructions. She first lifted her left foot off the ground, counted one one-thousand, two one-thousand and then dropped her foot to the ground. She then picked up her left foot and counted one one-thousand and two one-thousand and dropped her foot to the ground. Ms. Zichella repeated by lifting her foot off the ground and counting one- one thousand, two-one thousand and dropped her foot again.

I explained and demonstrated the Walk and Turn test. While explaining the test to Ms. Zichella, I instructed her to stand heel to toe with her arms at her side. Ms. Zichella was unable to stand heel to toe during my explanation. After explaining and demonstrating the test Ms. Zichella advised that she understood my instructions and began the test. She walked six steps and stepped off the line and then continued to thirty steps and stopped. It should be noted that Ms. Zichella was unable to walk heel to toe and did not walk the 9 steps as instructed. Ms. Zichella did not turn around and walk back to where she started.

I advised Ms. Zichella that she was under arrest for operating a motor vehicle while intoxicated 39:4-50. She was placed in handcuffs and signed off that she did not require first aid at that time and read Miranda. It should be noted that first aid was dispatched because of airbag deployment. Ms. Zichella was placed in the back of my patrol vehicle and advised that everything was audio and video recorded. P.O. Mergner remained on scene until Tow By Us took custody of Ms. Zichella's vehicle.

I transported Ms. Zichella back to police headquarters. Upon our return to police headquarters the 20 min observation period started at 0430 hours. Ms. Zichella was read his Miranda rights and explained the implied consent form advising him that she would be giving breath samples to determine Blood Alcohol Level (%BAC), to which he replied "yes". After completion of the 20 minute observation period Ms. Zichella was brought up to give the breath samples for testing with the Alco Test. After two samples were given the Alco Test machine at police headquarters advised that the control test failed and rendered the machine inoperable.

Ms. Zichella was placed in the back of my patrol vehicle and transported to Bay Head police headquarters. Upon arrival, the 20 minutes observation period began again at 0512 hours. Ms. Zichella gave sufficient breath samples resulting in a BAC.13% . The New Jersey State Police calculator determined that

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the samples were within a tolerable level. I transported Ms. Zichella back to police headquarters where she was finger printed and photographed.

Antonio Zichella responded to police headquarters and took custody of Ms Zichella. Antonio signed the Potential Liability Form (Johns Law) and was given a copy. At 0617 Ms Zichella was released from custody and given her pertinent paperwork. The summonses were as follows:

On 08/16/2019 around 2050 hours I, PO M. Nickerson was traveling east on Herbertsville Road near Osborn Avenue. As I approached the traffic signal at Rt 88 and Herbertsville Road. I observed the traffic signal for southbound traffic to be green. I observed a white vehicle in the left lane on Herbertsville Road not moving while it had the green signal.

The vehicle was stopped for about 3-5 seconds and eventually began to move. The vehicle appeared to be traveling south across Rt 88 and appeared to intend to continue south. The vehicle began to drift left and began to make a wide left hand turn onto Rt 88. I observed no turn signal and the vehicle almost crashed into the support poll for the Rt 88 traffic signal. the vehicle continued and crashed into the curb on Rt 88, just east of Beaverdam Road.

I made a left turn on Rt 88 from Herbertsville Road and could observe the vehicle travel into the left lane of Rt 88 and continue east over the bridge. The vehicle than traveled back into the right lane of Rt 88 and continued east, eventually drifting back into the left lane, which was now the left turn lane for Arnold Avenue. I observed the vehicle travel through the left turn lane and continue east on Rt 88. At this point, I felt this vehicle was a danger to other vehicles on the roadway or any pedestrians in the area and activated my overhead lights near Benedict Street in order to get the vehicle stopped. The vehicle eventually made a right turn onto Sherman Avenue and stopped the vehicle (NJ-A95LGL).

I approached the vehicle from the passenger of the vehicle and made contact with the driver, Jeffrey Evon. Mr. Evon stated he works at Maria's Pizza (3122 Rt 88) and that is where he is coming from. Mr. Evon stated he had gotten out of work at 2045 hours and now he was going home. While speaking with him, he had slurred/sloppy speech. Mr. Evon stated he does not take any medications nor did he consume any alcoholic beverages. I had Mr. Evon exit the vehicle so I could speak with him further.

I spoke with Mr. Evon outside of vehicle and spoke with him further. While he was speaking to me, I could detect an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath as he spoke. He stated that he was not coming from work, but he was coming from the Idle Hour Bar (2600 Rt 88) and had consumed two (2) beers. I asked him what time he arrived at the Idle Hour and he stated, "8:55". The current time was 8:56. I told Mr. Evon his concept of the time difference did not make sense. I asked him what time he had left the Idle Hour and he stated "8:45". I asked him that he had left the Idle Hour eleven (11) minutes ago and he stated, "Yup". I observed Mr. Evon keep his feet wide apart for balance and he was swaying. I again could detect the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath as he spoke. After this interaction with Mr. Evon, I administered Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) to Mr. Evon.

HGN Test: Mr. Evon told me that he has no medical issues and no medical issues with his eyes. I had Mr. Evon stand with his feet together and to keep his hands at his side. I instructed him to follow the tip of my finger with his eyes and his eyes only and he stated he understood. When I began the test, he immediately began to follow my finger with his head. I again had to instruct him to only follow my finger with his eyes and he stated he understood. Due to Mr. Evon unable to follow the basic instructions, I had to perform each test multiple times. After completing the test, both his eyes tracked equally and I observed no resting nystagmus. I observed the lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained nystagmus in his left eye. I was unable to positively observe distinct and sustained nystagmus in his right eye due to him not following instructions. I observed nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both his eyes. Vertical nystagmus was not conducted.

Walk and Turn Test: I instructed/demonstrated to Mr. Evon to place his right foot in front of his left foot, heel to toe (starting position). I had to instruct him multiple times to get into the starting position. Once he got into the starting position, he staggered backwards and separated his feet for balance. Despite telling me several times that he has no medical issues prior to this test, he now informed me that he has a bad right knee. Mr. Evon now stated he has a bad right knee from a motor vehicle accident that occurred twenty (20) years ago back in 1986. Again, Mr. Evon's concept of time seemed to be off. Mr. Evon stated he is unable to walk a straight line.

One Leg Stand Test: I had Mr. Evon keep his feet together and to keep his hands at his side (starting position). while demonstrating the test to him, he kept separating his feet for balance. I explained/demonstrated to him to keep a foot of his choice raised about six (6) inches off the ground, look at his raised foot, and count 1001,1002,1003 and so on until I told him to stop. Also, I told him it would be a timed test. He stated he understood and raised his right foot several inches off the ground and stated, "1001,1002,1003" and lost his balance and put his foot down. He was also observed holding his shorts up for support. After putting his foot down, he stated he will fall over if he tries the test again.

ABC Test: Mr. Evon stated he understood the english alphabet and his highest level of education was 12th grade. Before giving him instructions, Mr. Evon started reciting the alphabet at a fast pace. He also stated, "W,X,Y,R,Z". His speech was again slurred.

After the conclusion of the tests, I placed Mr. Evon under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated (39:4-50) and handcuffed him utilizing the double locking technique, He was secured in the back of my patrol vehicle and told him he was being video/audio recorded. PO Popiel conducted a search of the interior of the vehicle for any intoxicants, but none were located. Sleepy Hollow Exxon was contacted and responded to the scene.

While on the way to Police Headquarters, Mr. Evon was very upset. he made statements that he will never drink again and that he'll never go out and drink and drive again.

While at Police Headquarters, I removed all portable electric devices and brought Mr. Evon into the booking area to obtain breath samples. While in the booking area, I read the NJ Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators to Mr. Evon and he stated he will provide breath samples. I completed a 20 minute observation period and did not observe anything go in or out of his mouth. I operated the Alcotest machine and was able to obtain 2 breath samples from Mr. Evon. I changed the mouth piece between each breath and read the standard statement to him prior to each breath. The breath samples were registered through the State of New Jersey Alcotest Calculator and were within acceptable tolerance. The BAC was registered at 0.16%. I read Mr. Evon a suicide evaluation form and placed him into cell #2.

While in the cell, Mr. Evon became angry and verbally aggressive. He even covered up the camera with toilet paper and it had to be removed. Mr. Evon continued to be verbally aggressive stating he never got his phone call. I told him his boss, Giacomo Martino, was contacted and was at Police Headquarters, as Mr. Evon had requested. While completing paperwork, I could hear Mr. Evon now begin to use offensive/racist language. After completing Mr. Evon's summonses, I had Mr. Martino complete the John's Law form and he stated he will take responsibility for Mr. Evon.

I completed all necessary paperwork and went to remove Mr. Evon from the cell for processing and release. Once he came out of the cell, he began to make statements that his life is over and that he is going to jump off a bridge. I felt these statements were suicidal in nature and that Mr. Evon may intend to harm himself if released. I had Sgt. Wells meet me in the booking area. After processing Mr. Evon, he was told he would be going Brick ER for an evaluation. Mr. Evon protested and stated he was only joking about the statements. I placed him in the back seat of my patrol vehicle and transported him to Brick ER. While heading to the hospital, Mr. Evon made statements that this department/Officer were unprofessional for taking him to Brick ER for a mental evaluation. Also, that his uncle is in law enforcement and he plans to contact him to conduct internal affairs. While at Brick ER, Mr. Martino had made contact with the nursing staff. He stated when Mr. Evon was ready to be released, he will come back and take him. I gave the nursing staff a copy of the John's Law form. Mr. Evon was turned over to the hospital staff for a mental evaluation.

On 08/17/2019 at 2059 hours I, PO M. Nickerson responded to the 7-11 (3201 Rt 88) for a report of a motor vehicle crash. On arrival, I made contact with both vehicles in the parking lot. I spoke with one of the parties involved, Pravin Dumasia, who was operating NJ-Y16CZH during the crash.

Mr. Dumasia stated he was waiting in the westbound lane on Rt 88 at the red traffic signal at Rt 88 and Bridge Avenue. While waiting, he stated he was crashed into from behind by another vehicle, which was parked on scene. The other vehicle, NJ-A91HPV was parked in the lot, but was in the middle of two (2) parking spots.

I spoke with Mr. Dumasia's wife, Niranjana Dumasia, who was a front seat passenger in the vehicle. She stated she was shaken up from the crash, but was not injured and did not require first aid assistance. While speaking with her, I observed the driver of the other vehicle leaning on the trunk of Mr. Dumasia's vehicle. I observed her to be fumbling through paperwork and leaning against the trunk for support. I also observed her hand movements to be slow. I identified this subject as Lucille Townsend. She also had her dog out of the car and it was roaming around between the vehicles. I gathered the paperwork for both vehicles and spoke with Ms. Townsend briefly. She continued to have slow hand movement and was talking about her dog and how her dog does not like fireworks. I observed her speech to be slowed and slurred.

While back in my vehicle, PO Popiel stayed with Ms. Townsend. While he was speaking with her, I could observe her to continue to lean on her vehicle for support. I made contact with PO Popiel and we spoke about Ms. Townsend. PO Popiel stated while he was speaking with her, she would just ramble on. I asked Ms. Townsend for her insurance card, which she had left on the trunk of the other vehicle. She went to go retrieve her insurance card and I observed her staggering to her right, walking slowly, and unable to walk straight. After she obtained her insurance card, she walked back to PO Popiel and I. While she was walking back, I observed her drift to her right while walking, walked in a slow manner, and could not walk straight. While at the trunk of her car, she continued to go through different insurance cards and was speaking slow and lethargic. She stated she takes medications for blood pressure, Lipitor, and insulin. At this point, I conducted Standard Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) on Ms. Townsend.

HGN (Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus): Ms. Townsend stated she had no medical issues with her eyes and stated she understood the instructions. I observed no resting nystagmus in her eyes but she would not follow the tip of my finger like she was instructed. After instructing her again, she followed the instructions. I observed both eyes track equally. After the test, I observed the lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and the onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Vertical nystagmus was conducted and I observed jerking in her eyes.

Walk and Turn: Ms. Townsend stated she has a bad back and she takes Tramadol for the pain. Ms. Townsend said she would be able to walk a straight line. I instructed Ms. Townsend to get into the starting position (hands at her side and her right foot heel to toe with her left foot). I had to instruct/demonstrate for her multiple times the starting position. Once she was in that position, I began to explain/demonstrate the rest of the test. While doing so, she separated her feet for balance and staggered forward. After getting back into the starting position, I finished the instructions and she stated she understood the instructions. When she began the test, she did not touch heel to toe on any of the first nine (9) steps. On the return steps, she did not touch heel to toe on steps 1,2,3,4 and on step 5, she staggered to her right and stepped off the line. Ms. Townsend took eleven (11) steps back.

One Leg Stand: Ms. Townsend stated she would be able to lift a leg of her choice off the ground and I explained this test to her. After demonstrating/explain the test, she began the test. Ms. Townsend lifted her right knee off the ground, staggered to her left, and put her foot down. I explained/demonstrated the test again to her and she stated she understood. Ms. Townsend raised her right foot off the ground and counted, 1001,1002 and put her foot down. She raised her right foot again and counted, 1003,1004 and put her foot down again. She lifted her right leg up again and counted, 1005,1006,1007,1008,1009 and put her foot down. I terminated the test at this point.

After concluding the tests, I placed Ms. Townsend under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated (39:4-50) and handcuffed her utilizing the double locking technique. I guided her to my patrol vehicle and placed her in the back seat and told her she was being audio/video recorded. Ocean Bay responded to the scene to tow the vehicle as per John's Law. Her dog was brought to Police Headquarters and secured in the back pen by PO Fennessy. I transported Ms. Townsend to Police Headquarters without incident. Prior to going into the booking area, I removed all electric devices and left them in my vehicle.

While in the booking area, I read the N.J. Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators to her. Ms. Townsend stated she would provide samples of her breath for testing purposes and I began a twenty (20) minute observation period. During the observation period, I did not observe anything go in or out of her mouth. Once the observation period was concluded, I operated the Alcotest machine. I was able to obtain two (2) breath samples from Ms. Townsend and I read the standard statement to her prior to each breath sample and changed the mouth piece after each sample. Ms. Townsend's reported BAC was 0.00% and they were put through the state of New Jersey Alcotest Calculator and were within acceptable tolerance. A Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) was contacted and responded to the scene to test Ms. Townsend further. I read Ms. Townsend her Miranda Warning and she stated she understood her rights. Ms. Townsend stated at 2100 hours, she took three (3) 100 milligrams of Tramadol, 800 milligrams of Advil, and eight (8) units of insulin.

Brick Police Officer Caufield responded to Police Headquarters and performed a DRE evaluation on Ms. Townsend. A copy of his report will be attached to this case file once completed.

I made contact with Marie Saporito and she responded to Police Headquarters to take custody of Ms. Townsend. I completed a John's Law form with her and gave her a copy. She signed the form indicating she would take custody of Ms. Townsend. I explained the summonses to Ms. Townsend and her mandatory court date of 09/13/2019 at 1000 hours. She was released to Ms. Saporito without incident. I also released the dog to Ms. Townsend and Ms. Saporito.

On 08/24/2019 at approximately 033 hours, I, Officer Christopher Henrich was traveling east on Herbertsville Road when I observed a vehicle, NJ/N65HLN, traveling west at a high rate of speed. I estimated the speed at 50 mph, the posted speed limit is 35 mph. I locked the speed of the vehicle in at 56 mph. There were no other vehicles on the road at this time. As the vehicle passed my position I turned around to follow the vehicle and conduct a motor vehicle stop. As I was gaining distance on the vehicle I observed it cross over the center line. I activated my emergency lights and conducted a motor vehicle stop. I approached the passenger side of the vehicle and asked the driver for his driving credentials. I immediately smelt an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the inside of the vehicle. I asked the driver, identified as Travis Cotter, if he had been drinking. He stated he had three Coors Lights. I then asked Mr. Cotter if he could tell me what time he thought it was and he stated 1230. It was approximately 1235 at that time. Next, I explained to Mr. Cotter that I wanted him to say the English alphabet starting with the letter "B" and ending with the letter "U". Once he began he said it correctly until he reached the letter "T" at which point he stated "E,F,B,U". At this time I asked Mr. Cotter to turn off the vehicle and step to the rear of the car. Once Mr. Cotter was out of the car and in a safe area I asked him again how much he had to drink and he stated three vodka drinks. While he was speaking I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath.

As I began to explain to Mr. Cotter that I would be performing a few tests Officer Ippolito deactivated my emergency lights so they would not interfere with the testing. The first was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. I began the test by asking Mr. Cotter if he had any problems with his eyes which he stated he did not. I asked him to stand with his feet together and his hands at his side while I explained the test. I explained that I wanted him to keep his head still and follow the tip of my pen with his eyes and his eyes only. He stated he understood. At this point I positioned the tip of pen approximately 12 inches from his nose and slightly above eye level. It was at this time I observed his pupils to of equal size and there was no resting nystagmus observed. His eyes were bloodshot and watery. Mr. Cotter's eyes were able to follow the pen together, showing that equal tracking was present. The test showed the lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes and the onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees was also present in both eyes. Vertical Gaze Nystagmus was also present.

The second test administered was the walk and turn. Prior to the test Mr. Cotter removed his slip on sandals. I asked Mr. Cotter to stand heel to toe with his right foot in front of the other while explained the instructions. I explained to Mr. Cotter that when told to begin he was to walk forward 9 steps touching heel to toe while counting out loud and on his 9th step he was to take a series of small steps around and walk 9 steps back while touching heel to toe. I gave Mr. Cotter a 3 step example on how to do the test but advised him he was to take 9 steps. He stated he understood. During his nine steps forward he never touched heel to toe and on his 8th step he stepped off the line for balance. On his 9 steps back he never touched heel to toe and on his 6th step he stepped off the line for balance.

The final test was the One Leg Stand. Prior to starting the test I asked Mr. Cotter to stand with his feet together and his arms at his side. I explained that when told to start he was to lift the leg of his choice approximately 6 inches off the ground while looking the foot. He was to count out loud, one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand 3, and so forth until I told him to stop. I gave Mr. Cotter a brief demonstration and asked him if he understood the test which he stated he did. He began by lifting his right leg. As soon as he lifted his leg he began to lose balance and lifted to his arms to counter it. He placed his foot back down on his 9th and 10th step and then stopped at 12.

Based on the operation of the vehicle, my observations and the results of the tests I placed Mr. Cotter under arrest for driving while intoxicated. He was handcuffed, search incident to arrest and placed in the rear of my patrol car. He was advised that everything in the vehicle is audio and video recorded. Officer Ippolito remained on scene with the vehicle until the duty tow arrived to tow the vehicle as per John's Law.

Once at headquarters I escorted Mr. Cotter into the processing room where he was placed on the holding bench. I read Mr. Cotter the Miranda Warning which he stated he understood. I then read him the questions on the Drinking Driver Questionnaire which he chose to answer. The form was completed and in placed in records. I then read Mr. Cotter the Attorney General's Standard Statement Form. After reading question 9 Mr. Cotter replied with "I choose not to". Based on his response I read the next paragraph and he responded with "I have to say no". I entered all the proper information in the Alcotest Machine and ran it as a refusal.

At this time Mr. Cotter was given his phone calls and made contact with Pascal Drew was coming in to give him a ride home. Mr. Drew arrived and signed off on the Potential Liability Warning form, taking responsibility for Mr. Cotter.

On 08/24/2019 at 20:13 hours, I was traveling north on Bridge Ave. near the intersection of Rt.88 and Bridge Ave. I observed NJ registration: B89CUJ stopped at the above intersection in the right lane north bound. The vehicle then attempted to make a right turn on Rt.88. The vehicle's front and rear driver side tires were in the left lane as he made the right turn onto Rt.88. Once the vehicle made a right turn, the vehicle's front and rear driver's side tires drifted onto the center yellow marker. The vehicle then overcorrected and the vehicles's front and rear passenger side tires went over the white shoulder marker. I then activated my emergency lights to initiate a motor vehicle stop. The vehicle was stopped in front of Maria's Pizza on Rt.88.

I then approached the vehicle and identified myself as Officer Waterson. I then requested his driver's license, registration and insurance card. The operator identified as Cristobal R. Garcia handed me his driver's license. Mr. Garcia then began to fumble through his glove box. Mr. Garcia was slow with his movements and handed me the vehicle's registration and insurance card. I then detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from inside the vehicle. I then asked Mr. Garcia if he knew the english alphabet, Mr. Garcia stated that he did know the alphabet. Mr. Garcia then was asked if he could recite the alphabet without stopping or singing. Mr. Garcia then advised me that he could not recite the alphabet. Mr. Garcia was slurring his words during the interaction. I then had Mr. Garcia step out of the vehicle to conduct field sobriety tests. It should be noted that the ground was level and well lit for these tests to be conducted. On 08/29/2019 at 1950 hours I, PO M. Nickerson responded to the area of Bridge Avenue for a report of a possibly intoxicated driver. An anonymous caller stated that NJ-N42EYZ was driving on the sidewalk of Burnt Tavern Road in Brick Township. The vehicle registration came back to 1116 Northstream Pkwy.

I drove to 1116 Northstream Pkwy and observed NJ-N42EYZ parked in front of the residence. I put my hand on the hood of the vehicle and it was still warm, indicating it was either just operated or running. I walked to the front door of the residence and attempted to make contact with the vehicle owner, Donald Schollenberger.

I made contact with Donald and identified myself. I asked him to exit his residence so I could speak with him, and he willingly did. While he was exiting, he lost his balance and had to grab onto the doorway entrance so he would not fall. He then had to use the railing to keep his balance and get down the front steps. Donald then sat down on a bench located in front of the residence, just right of the front steps. While speaking with him, he stated he was in Brick Township and was operating his vehicle. Donald said he had gotten home about ten (10) minutes ago and did not consume any alcoholic beverages while he was inside his residence. Also, he stated he was in Brick Township purchasing wine. I told Donald of the complaint about his vehicle driving on the sidewalk/hitting a curb in Brick Township and he stated that he did strike the curb on Burnt Tavern Road. Donald had slow and slurred speech while he spoke with me.

I brought Donald over to his vehicle to examine some damage I observed on the front right quarter panel. While we were walking across his yard to his truck, he had trouble walking straight. While inspecting the damage, it was determined to be old damage. While I spoke with Donald in front of his truck, he kept leaning on the hood of his vehicle for balance. At this point, I detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath as he spoke and he was swaying from side to side. Since Donald admitted to operating the vehicle ten (10) minutes prior to my arrival, stating he did not consume any alcoholic beverages when he got home, and my observations of him, I conducted Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFSTs). Donald also stated he is on multiple medications, but could not name them.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) Test - I had Donald remove his glasses and he stated he has no medical issues with his eyes. I had to tell Donald multiple times to only follow the tip of my finger with his eyes and not to move his head. I observed no resting nystagmus and both eyes tracked equally. I observed the lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained nystagmus in both eyes, and the onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Vertical nystagmus was conducted, but I was unable to observe any clues/jerking in his eyes. While I was conducting this test, I could now detect a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath and his eyes were watery/bloodshot.

ABC Test - Donald stated his highest level of education is a college degree and that he understood the English alphabet. I explained to Donald to recite the alphabet from B to T and he stated he understood. While he was performing this test, his speech was slow/slurred

Walk and Turn Test - Donald stated he has had hip replacement/surgery in the past, but would be able to walk a straight line. I explained the starting position (right foot heel to toe with left foot, hands at side) to Donald and instructed him to get into the position. I had to explain/demonstrate this position multiple times to him. I also had to instruct him not to lean on his truck. Once in the position, he staggered to his left, separated his feet and lost his balance. He was also observed raising his left arm in the air for balance. He

got back into the position, staggered to his left and almost fell over, requesting the test be done in a different area of the road. PO Grohowski stopped traffic, which was light, and we moved to the middle of Northstream Pkwy. While he was attempting to get back into the starting position, he lost his balance, staggered to his right and almost fell over. I terminated the test for his safety. I had Donald go back towards his truck so he would be out of the roadway. While he was at his truck, he continued to lean on it for support.

One Leg Stand Test - Donald stated he would be able to lift a leg of his choice six (6) inches off the ground. I had him get into the starting position (feet together, hands at side). I had to tell him not to begin the test before I explained/demonstrated the test. After explaining the test, I told him he could begin. Donald lifted his right leg, but did not count. He raised his arms for balance and after about nine (9) seconds, he put his foot down. He raised his right foot again and counted to 1005, staggered, and almost fell. I terminated the test at this point.

After the conclusion of the tests, I placed Donald under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated (39:4-50) and handcuffed him utilizing the double locking technique. A search incident to arrest was conducted and I located three (3) pills, an orange pill, a white pill, and a grey capsule type pill. These were later determined to be antidepressant medications. I guided Donald to his front door, where he allowed PO Grohowski go into his residence so we could obtain the key for his vehicle. PO Grohowski obtained the key without incident and secured the house. I placed Donald in the rear seat of my patrol vehicle and told him he is being audio/video recorded. I transported him to Police Headquarters without incident. Tow by Us responded to the scene and towed the vehicle as per John's Law.

While at Police Headquarters, I removed all electrical devices and left them in my vehicle. I brought Donald into the booking area and began a twenty (20) minute observation period. I read the N.J. Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators to Donald and he stated he would provide breath samples. After the observation period, I did not observe anything go in/out of his mouth and I operated the Alcotest machine. Before each attempt, I read the standard statement to Donald and he stated he understood. I was able to obtain two (2) breath samples from Donald and changed the mouth piece after each attempt. While the Alcotest was processing the samples, it had a control test failure. The breath samples were observed to be 0.15%.

I transported Donald to Bay Head Police Headquarters to utilize their Alcotest machine. I brought Donald into the booking area and began a twenty (20) minute observation period. I read the N.J. Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators to Donald and he stated he would provide breath samples. After the observation period, I did not observe anything go in/out of his mouth and I operated the Alcotest machine. Before each attempt, I read the standard statement to Donald and he stated he understood. I was able to obtain two (2) breath samples from Donald. The Alcotest successfully tested the breath samples and the reported BAC level was 0.12%. The numbers were ran through the State of New Jersey Alcotest Calculator and were within acceptable tolerance. After processing him at Bay Head Police Headquarters, I brought Donald back to our Police Headquarters without incident.

While back in our booking area, I read a suicide evaluation form to Donald and placed him in cell #3. Christopher Sobolewski was contacted and responded to sign the John's Law form. PO Ippolito completed the form with Mr. Sobolewski and he was given a copy.

I inventoried Donald's property and complete a property receipt. I issued Donald a summons for Careless

On 09/01/2019 at 2005 hours PO Barker and I, PO M. Nickerson responded to Old Farm Road and John Street for multiple calls of a motor vehicle crash with unknown injuries. While traveling west on Old Farm Road, PO Barker arrived on scene and positioned his vehicle on Old Farm Road, just west of John Street. PO Barker stated the vehicles were still in the roadway. On arrival, I positioned my vehicle on Old Farm Road just west of Williams Street, blocking westbound traffic.

As I was walking to the crash to investigate, I observed a crowd of 10-15 people standing near the crash, which was in front 1018 Old Farm Road. I observed one (1) vehicle (NJ-E68LHJ) on the front lawn of 1018 Old Farm Road and it was facing east with heavy damage to the left rear quarter panel. I observed the second vehicle (NJ-M66HNN) which was in the intersection of Old Farm Road and John Street and it had heavy damage to the front right quarter panel. While investigating, an anonymous male stated the female in the second vehicle had the vehicle in reverse after the crash and was trying to leave the scene. The male stated he was able to put the vehicle in park and remove the keys from the ignition, placing them on the roof of the vehicle. He described the scene as frantic and neighbors were screaming that the female was trying to leave.

I made contact with the female in the second vehicle, who was speaking with PO Barker. PO Barker indicated to me that he believed the female was intoxicated. I began to speak with the female, identified as Michelle Ramirez. Mrs. Ramirez seemed agitated and stated she was coming from Brick, but when asked which direction she was traveling, she stated she did not know. She began to make statements about being on her cellular phone before the crash. I asked if she was on her cellular phone just prior to the crash and she stated that she was. Mrs. Ramirez had slurred speech and I could detect an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the interior of the vehicle where she was sitting (driver seat). She continued to talk on her cellular phone and made statements to the person on the other end of the phone call that she was attempting to call them just prior to the crash.

PO Barker and I told Mrs. Ramirez to exit her vehicle several times, but she continued to be agitated and answer her cellular phone when it rang. When she continued to talk on her cellular phone, her speech was again slurred. Mrs. Ramirez eventually exited the vehicle and tried handing me her phone, indicating she wanted me to speak with whoever was on the other end. I declined to do so and had her walk to my vehicle so I could accurately record Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFSTs). Also, I brought her to my vehicle, which was away from the crowd of neighbors, who were now recording/taking pictures. While walking to my vehicle, she could not walk straight and was drifting to her left. She continued to answer her cellular phone and again had slurred and slowed speech as she spoke. While at my vehicle, Mrs. Ramirez showed me a cut on her left index finger, but declined first aid assistance. PO Popiel provided medical assistance and wrapped her finger. At this point, I administered Standardized Field Sobriety Tests.

HGN (Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus) Test - I asked Ms. Ramirez if she had any medical issues with her eyes and she stated she did not. I explained the instructions and she stated she understood. While I was conducting the test, I had to continue to tell Mrs. Ramirez not to move her head and to follow my finger (stimulus) with only her eyes. I was able to observe both eyes track equally and no resting nystagmus. Once I concluded the test, I observed the lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Vertical nystagmus was conducted, but I observed no clues/jerking in the eyes. While I conducted this test, I observed her eyes to be watery/bloodshot and I could detect a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath.

The Walk and Turn Test - Mrs. Ramirez stated she did not have any medical issues and stated she would be able to walk a straight line. While I was trying to get her into the starting position (right foot heel to toe with left foot and hands at side), she continued to start to walk and I had to instruct her to stop and just stay in the starting position. Once in the position, she staggered to her right and started walking. I again had to instruct her to stay in the starting position and not to begin the test. While back in the starting position, she lost her balance and reached out and put her hand on my shoulder for balance. She again started to walk and I again had to instruct to her to simply stay in the starting position until I finished the instructions. While trying to back in the starting position, she continued to stagger and lose her balance and kept raising her arms over six (6) inches for balance. She now kept her feet wide apart for balance. After finishing the instructions, she stated she understood and began the test. Mrs. Ramirez took seven (7) steps forward and did not touch heel to toe on any of the steps, raised her arms for balance, turned incorrectly and staggered backwards when she turned. She took eleven (11) steps back and staggered to her left and stepped off the line on her 4th step. She also had her arms raised for balance.

The One Leg Stand Test - Mrs. Ramirez stated she had no medical issues with her legs and would be able to raise a foot in the air. I had her get into the starting position (feet together hands at side). I explained the instructions to her and she stated she understood the test. She raised her right leg/foot and counted, 1,2,3 and put her foot down. she raised her right leg/foot again and counted at a very fast pace, 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10 and put her foot down. She raised her left leg/foot for several seconds and put her foot on the ground. I terminated the test at this point. I observed her to raise her arms over six (6) inches for balance and was swaying while trying to balance. During these tests, the weather was clear and the road surface was flat.

After conducting the tests, I placed Mrs. Ramirez under arrest for Driving While Intoxicated and handcuffed her utilizing the double locking technique. A search incident to arrest was conducted and she was placed in the back seat of my patrol vehicle and was told she was being audio/video recorded. I made contact with PO Popiel at the crash location and gave him the keys to the vehicle for Tow By Us, who was on scene. PO Popiel conducted a search of the interior of the vehicle for intoxicants and located a large plastic QuickChek cup filled with a brownish liquid. PO Popiel removed the lid and I detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage. I transported Mrs. Ramirez to Police Headquarters without incident. Tow By Us towed Mrs. Ramirez's vehicle as per John's Law and towed the other vehicle since it was disabled. The QuickChek cup was later entered into evidence.

While at Police Headquarters, I left all electronic devices in my vehicle/sally port and brought Mrs. Ramirez into the booking area and place her on the bench. I read the N.J. Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators (N.J.S.A. 39:4-50.2(e)) and Mrs. Ramirez stated, "No" when asked if she would submit samples of her breath for testing. I completed a twenty (20) minute observation period and operated the Alcotest machine. I utilized the refusal function and utilized the State of New Jersey Alcotest Calculator. The samples were within acceptable tolerance.

I read the Miranda Warning to Mrs. Ramirez and she stated she understood her rights. Mrs. Ramirez stated she traveled south down Johnson Avenue, turned left on Burnt tavern Road, continued left onto Old Farm Road and traveled east. While traveling east, she stated she was utilizing her cellular phone and crashed into the other vehicle. She stated she had consumed only one (1) glass of wine at a private residence in Brick Township prior to the crash.
