On 12/23/2024 at 14:51 hrs I was on patrol in marked unit 506 running radar and observing traffic on the 200 blk of Dunellen Ave. At this time I observed a white sedan bearing NJ [REDACTED] traveling west on Dunellen Ave. I observed the driver's side window to be heavily tinted, and based on the violation conducted a lookup of the plate which returned with a no-bail NCIC entry for the registered owner, Tamir Johnson, issued by the Middlesex County Sheriff's Office.

I then spun my patrol vehicle around and at the intersection of Dunellen and North Washington and did conduct a motor vehicle stop. I requested backup and was joined by Ptlm. Lowder and Det. Issler. Upon contacting the operator of the vehicle and being presented a driver's license, I did confirm him to be the registered owner, Tamir Johnson. Dispatch was requested to confirm the hit.

After several minutes of no response, due to security concerns with several other persons in the vehicle, Mr. Johnson was removed from the vehicle, handcuffed, and detained in the rear of unit 506. He requested his cell to contact his parents to take custody of his small children and was able to do so. There was a female in the vehicle, [REDACTED], with whom there have been restraining orders in the past but it was confirmed that none were active.

Upon confirmation of the warrant, Ptlm. Lowder stood by for Mr. Johnson's parents to arrive while I transported Mr. Johnson to HQ in unit 506 without incident. Det. Issler followed.

On 12/24/2024 at approximately 18:53 hours I observed a male enter our police lobby looking for assistance. I made contact with the male now known to me as Mr. Christopher C. Bates who stated he has been receiving threats and is being scammed. I had him come inside at this time to gather more information on what was occurring. Mr. Bates began explaining and showing me text messages between him and an unknown party. The party stated he was Jose Benitez from an escort service and was apparently mad about a service between Mr. Bates and a few of his girls. I asked Mr. Bates if he knew anything about this and he stated he did not affiliate with any escort service. Mr. Bates started making phone contact with this male who stated he needed to send \$1000 to a male by the name of Alberto Cruz in order to protect his family. Mr. Bates then got Mr. Cruz's Zelle name and wired him \$1000. After the \$1000 had been wired the unknown party called Mr. Bates back asking for additional money. Mr. Bates then proceeded to go to a Walmart in Manville and took out two Western Union checks for \$2000 each and sent them to the unknown party. Mr. Bates sent a total of \$5000.

On December 27, 2024, at approximately 6:52 PM, I was dispatched to 330 Whittier Ave in response to a report of property damage. Upon arrival, I made contact with the homeowners, who confirmed that they did not call the police for assistance. Moments later, a woman, later identified as Ms. Sandra P. Ochoajaramillo, approached me and requested to speak privately away from the property.

I followed her further down the block to where her vehicle was idling on the side of the road. As I approached the rear of the vehicle, I heard a hissing sound coming from the rear passenger tire, which I observed was going flat while I was on scene.

Ms. Ochoajaramillo stated that her vehicle tires have consistently been vandalized, and she suspects that her s [REDACTED] is responsible. She informed me that the vandalism, which involved nails being placed in her tires, began in September of this year. She mentioned that she had her tires repaired, only for them to be vandalized again. Initially, this occurred monthly, but it escalated to happening every week, resulting in up to ten incidents in total. At one point, she reported finding five nails in a single tire. Ms. Ochoajaramillo noted that her vehicle has been damaged not only at her home but also while she was at the gym and during her time at work. She suspects that the vandalism may be connected to arguments she has had with her [REDACTED]

I advised Ms. Ochoajaramillo that there was insufficient evidence to charge her [REDACTED] with criminal mischief. However, I recommended that she install some form of CCTV to monitor her vehicle, in hopes of either preventing further vandalism or capturing the person(s) responsible in the act.

Ms. Ochoajaramillo also repeatedly requested that I not speak to her [REDACTED] who was on the property at the time of the incident.

Sgt. Lovell and I spoke with Ms. Sandra Ochoa-Jaramillo who stated that this was an on-going issue. I was aware that she reported property damage to her vehicle tires the day before (Ref CAD#24409127). Ms. Ochoa-Jaramillo stated that last night she had her rear passenger side tire

repaired. She said that after that she parked her vehicle on Whittier in front of the residence at around 20:00 hrs. Ms. Ochoa-Jaramillo said that this morning at around 06:30 hrs she discovered that her rear driver side tire was completely flat and she located a nail in it. Ms. Ochoa-Jaramillo said that she checked the camera outside their residence but it didn't capture the incident. I observed the rear driver side tire which was flat and a nail lodged in the tread.

Ms. Ochoa-Jaramillo was advised that she could park the vehicle in the driveway but she stated that the one camera they have faces the front of the house and she believes it would still happen. She stated that her family was going to install better cameras. There was mention that her family thought it might happen at her work in Basking Ridge or the gym she goes to. On 12/29/2024 at approximately 02:00 hours I was on patrol in vehicle 503 parked facing eastbound on the 300 block of North Ave observing traffic. At this time I observed a vehicle traveling west through the intersection of Route 28 and Washington Ave that was driving on and over the double yellow line. The vehicle continued past me as I spun around to follow. Now behind the vehicle on the 300 block of North Ave, I observed it to be swerving from side to side. We continued onto the 400 block of North Ave as the vehicle continued to swerve from right to left in the lane of travel. Now approaching Madison Ave the vehicle appeared to be making a left turn but then moved

around a vehicle appearing he was going to go straight. Instead, the vehicle did neither as it drove directly into and onto the curb nearly striking a street sign. Upon observing this action I activated my overhead emergency lights to initiate a motor vehicle stop on NJ reg [REDACTED]. The vehicle then pulled off of the curb and slowly made a right turn onto Madison Ave, as it came to a complete stop. After calling out my stop on the above listed vehicle I began to approach via the driver's side. While approaching a male exited the vehicle and began walking towards the rear as I ordered him to sit back in the car.

Now back inside the vehicle, the male driver rolled his window down to speak to me. I asked and then received Mr. Jhoan G. Cruzado Hernandez's license and began asking what he was doing. I observed that he had a phone in his hand with the Door Dash app open and also had a phone placed by his speedometer with what appeared to be a video playing. While speaking to Mr. Cruzado I observed his eyes to be both bloodshot and watery. I also could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage emerging from the vehicle. I continued to ask Mr. Cruzado where he was going and what he was doing. He showed me on his phone that he had a Door Dash pickup from McDonald's to an unknown address in Dunellen. I asked Mr. Cruzado several times how much he had to drink tonight as he continued to refuse to admit to having anything to drink. Due to the signs of impairment and Mr. Cruzado's careless driving, I asked him to step out of the vehicle in order to perform Field Sobriety Tests. I then escorted Mr. Cruzado over to a flat and level portion of the sidewalk in order to conduct the tests. I asked him again how much he had to drink tonight to which he continued to deny he had anything. Ptlm. Jones secured all forward facing emergency lights and ensured the MVR of vehicle 503 was pointed towards the testing area.

HGN:

Before administering this test I asked Mr. Cruzado if he had any problems with his eyes, to which he stated no. I then confirmed with him that he could see me and also had him verify that the pen I was using as a stimulus was blue, which he did. I then began to explain how to perform the HGN test to Mr. Cruzado. After completion of the test, I observed all six clues. Let it be known that now within close proximity to Mr. Cruzado, I could strongly smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage emerging from his person.

Walk & Turn:

Before administering the Walk & Turn test I asked Mr. Cruzado if he had any problems that would prevent him from walking a straight line, to which he stated no. I then attempted to place Mr.

Cruzado in the starting position, but he could not maintain the instructional stance while I explained the test. Once he was close enough to the starting position I began to explain the Walk & Turn test. Upon completing the test Mr. Cruzado performed an improper turn. Two clues were observed.

One Leg Stand:

I then began to explain the One Leg Stand Test to Mr. Cruzado. After completion of the test, I did not observe any clues.

I called Ptlm. Nierodzik over as I checked Mr. Cruzado for HGN again to verify what I was seeing. Again I observed Mr. Cruzado to have hit all six clues for HGN which Ptlm. Nierodzik agreed.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, Mr. Cruzado was placed under arrest for DWI at 02:10 hours. After being searched Mr. Cruzado was placed in the rear of vehicle 503 without incident. A brief probable cause search of the vehicle was conducted with negative findings. Somerset Hills Towing was dispatched to the scene for the John's Law Impound as Ptlm. Jones stood by for the tow. I then transported Mr. Cruzado to Green Brook PD due to our Alcotest machine being out of service.

Once at Green Brook HQ Mr. Cruzado was brought inside and secured to the cuffing apparatus mounted to the wall. I then played the NJ Standard Statement Form in Spanish and Mr. Cruzado responded with "si". I then gave Mr. Cruzado a Miranda Rights form in Spanish which he stated he understood and signed off agreeing to speak to me.

I ensured that all mic packs, cell phones, radios, and other portable electronics were removed from the testing room. At 02:24 hours I began a constant and uninterrupted observation of Mr. Cruzado during which time he did not cough, burp, belch, vomit, sneeze, or place any foreign objects in his mouth. His mouth was also checked to ensure it was clear. The time on the Alcotest was used for proper timekeeping.

At approximately 02:45 hours after a 21 minute observation I secured and removed my BWC from the processing room and began to enter the required information into the Alcotest. I operated the Alcotest 9510 Serial #ARMK-0083 on Mr. Cruzado and after two successful breath samples at 02:48 & 02:52 hours, the Alcotest indicated a reading of 0.061% BAC on sequential file #56. I then contacted dispatch and ensured that the breath samples were within acceptable tolerance, which they
