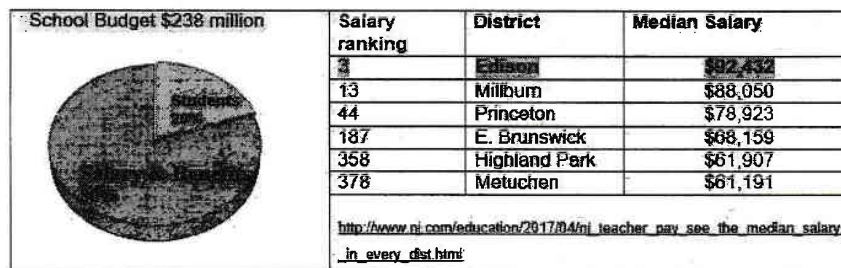

Alert Regarding Your Child's Education

Are your Tax Dollars Reaching Your Children ?

60% of your property taxes are allocated to our school budget.

80% of the school budget is used for salary and benefits of school employees mostly Teachers
Meanwhile, we don't have full day kindergarten, our schools are overcrowded and our children are forced to eat at their desks due to space shortage



Edison is the 3rd highest paid district in the State of New Jersey, topping 647 other districts. The Teacher's Union negotiates with Board of Education for an annual increase in salary and benefits forcing tax increases or cuts to your child's education. Every time the Board of Education caves to the union, either you pay for it, or your kids pay for it.



No Accountability in our Schools

Most teachers are great. However, there are also ineffective teachers who aren't getting the job done. In the last 8 years, NO tenured teachers were let go due to performance. When teachers are held accountable, the Teacher's Union takes Edison to court and it takes about two years and costs taxpayers up to \$100,000 in legal fees. The Union uses over \$1 million in annual union dues to sue Edison and donate to politicians.

What's at stake this year?

It takes at least 5 out of 9 board votes to hold teachers accountable and pass a responsible budget. Teacher Union backed candidates are trying to take control of the Board.

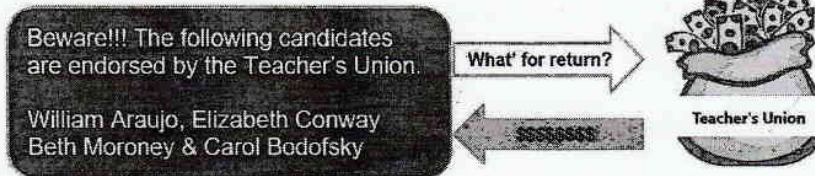
We Need a Board Not Controlled By the Teacher's Union
