Report Submitted by Detective Lieutenant Applegate #150.

On 01/30/2026, D/Capt. Yannacone, Det. Bruschi, Det. Vocaturo and I responded to the area of [REDACTED] in an attempt to locate Vishal Bhatt on an outstanding warrant out of our jurisdiction for eluding. After some time, Mr. Bhatt was observed operating a 2011 Kia on Day St. Due to vehicular traffic, we were unable to safely reposition our unmarked vehicles behind the Kia and effect a motor vehicle stop. A few minutes later, Det. Bruschi was repositioning his unmarked vehicle on [REDACTED] when he observed Mr. Bhatt in the rear-view mirror traveling directly behind his vehicle. Det. Bruschi stopped his vehicle on [REDACTED] and D/Capt. Yannacone and I approached the Kia. Mr. Bhatt was removed from the vehicle and placed under arrest without incident. Mr. Bhatt was transported to East Rutherford Police Headquarters by the undersigned and Det. Vocaturo.

At Headquarters Mr. Bhatt was fingerprinted, photographed and served a copy of his complaint. Mr. Bhatt was then transported and turned over to the Bergen County Jail Intake pending his 1st appearance in CJP Court.

01/29/2026 17:25

Defendant eluded PO Black #164 after such officer attempted to affect a motor vehicle stop by activating his emergency lights and sirens and positioning his fully marked patrol vehicle behind the defendant's vehicle. The defendant continued to operate his vehicle in a reckless manner placing the motoring public in dangerspecifically by speeding, driving on the opposite side of the road as well as failing to abide by traffic control devices, along with other title 39 violations.

01/29/2026 14:00

On the above date and time, P.O Lassoni, P.O Ryznar, and I responded to a report a disturbance. Caller reports having an incident on 1/28/2026 see report (2026-01108). The caller identified himself as Vishal Bhatt and was frustrated with how he felt the encounter went.

Vishal stated he was actively peeping through the gym windows again. Vishal also asked what we were going to do about it attempted to entice a response. On arrival, we did not see Vishal's 2011 Kia Rio. We then continued to search the area for the vehicle. While in marked patrol car 10, I observed a white kia traveling south past my vehicle while in the Oak St Apartment complex. At this time, I was able to identify the driver as Vishal Bhatt. On 01/28/2026, Sgt Alberta issued Vishal a summons while operating the 2011 Kia. Due to this fact, I was able to identify Vishal utilizing his DL photograph attached to the vehicle. Vishal disregarded a stop sign while exiting the apartment parking lot and made a right onto Central Ave before traveling north on Oak St. The vehicle then improperly passed a vehicle on the left-hand sign to merge onto Paterson Ave West Bound almost striking an oncoming vehicle. At this time, I activated my emergency lights and sirens and positioned my vehicle behind Vishal's vehicle to initiate a motor vehicle stop. Vishal then started accelerating at a high rate of speed and passed multiple vehicles on the left-hand side in an attempt to elude. Vishal, now Defendant, drove on the east bound lane into oncoming traffic multiple times. I terminated pursuit of the vehicle at the intersection of Paterson Ave and Grant St due to having positive identification of the driver. After disabling my emergency lights and sirens, I observed the Defendant drive erratically into oncoming traffic at a high rate of speed west bound on Paterson Ave.

SGT Perry reports that the Defendant called multiple times after the pursuit. The Defendant was proud of his ability to elude and was requesting we respond to a location in Garfield to arrest him. Referred to The Detective Bureau.

On Sunday, October 5, 2025, at approximately 2018 hours, I observed a red and white motorcycle improperly pass a vehicle on Paterson Avenue heading east bound in the area of Atkins Terrace. The operator was wearing a red hooded sweatshirt, khaki pants and a white helmet. I made a U-turn and attempted to catch up to the motorcycle to obtain the registration. While traveling in traffic, behind the motorcycle, I observed it cross over the solid, double yellow line into oncoming traffic and improperly pass another vehicle in the area of Paterson Avenue and Clinton Place. The motorcycle then stopped at the red traffic signal at Paterson Avenue and Uhland Street. At this time, I activated my emergency lights and siren and pulled behind the motorcycle. The motorcycle pulled into the parking lot of Cake and Cone Ice Cream and then accelerated and continued back onto Paterson Avenue west bound. I followed behind the motorcycle with my lights and sirens activated. The motorcycle continued west bound traveling approximately 45mph and drove onto the north sidewalk, heading west on Paterson Avenue. The motorcycle continued on the sidewalk to the bus turn around, making a left onto Hoboken Road and continuing west on Paterson Avenue. The motorcycle then improperly passed another vehicle on the right side in the area of Paterson Avenue and Jordan Avenue, continuing west on Paterson Avenue, Eluding police. Just past Johnson Avenue, the motorcycle attempted to pass a black Porsche on the right and collided, striking the Porsche on the front passenger side fender. The operator of the motorcycle, later identified as Jason Gage, fell to the ground and then jumped back up, approached this officer with his hands up and stated, "I am so stupid, all this because its not registered, I should have just stopped". I instructed Mr. Gage to have a seat on the curb and asked him if he was injured. He stated that he was not injured and felt fine. He was placed under arrest. I observed minor road rash on Jason's left elbow, left hip and right shoulder. EMS was requested. The occupants of the Porsche, listed above, were not injured. The motorcycle was bearing NJ registration 5VYB4 which is currently not on file. That plate was previously registered to a 2003, blue Suzuki motorcycle. The RO of the Suzuki was Eric Ivan Ruiz of [REDACTED]

At this time Officer Evans and Special Officer Mercedes arrived on scene. Wallington PD was requested and Officer Kullaf responded to take the MVA report. Wallington PD case number is 25-012276. EMS responded and Mr. Gage refused medical attention and signed a RMA. SPO Mercedes responded to HQ so Sgt. Zito can respond to the scene. Bergen County Sheriff's BCI unit was requested to take photographs.

Detective Bruschi and Sgt. Zito arrived on scene. Det. Bruschi and Officer Evans transported Jason Gage to headquarters for processing. BCI D/Sgt. On 11/05/25, while on patrol, I performed a random NCIC check on a silver Honda Accord (VA:TAK4331) driving east on Paterson Ave in the area of Uhland St. NCIC returned that the vehicle was a felony vehicle. Information was relayed to dispatch who confirmed the vehicle. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Dispatch was informed that the vehicle contained 3 occupants all were described as black males.

The vehicle continued east on Paterson Ave and entered RT. 17 North while I followed at a distance to wait for additional units. Once on RT 17 north I was joined by Sgt. Felten, PO Lassoni, PO Bury and PO Black. Sgt. Felten and I attempted to conduct a motor vehicle stop while other officers shut down the highway in order to conduct a felony vehicle stop. After my lights and siren were activated, the vehicle pulled to the right shoulder and slow rolled for approximately 100 yards. Once the vehicle reached the area of Moonachie Ave the vehicle began to accelerate in an attempt to flee the motor vehicle stop. Vehicle fled and I took primary until we reached the area of Franklin Ave when PO Bury took primary (See PO Bury's report).

Upon termination of the pursuit Sgt Felten and I responded to Port Authority HQ to gather pedigree information on one of the passengers from the fleeing vehicle. Port Authority reports that they had a male party by the name of Deshawn Parker in custody and two outstanding. Det. Lt Applegate was contacted with pedigree information for future investigation/complaints.

During the pursuit I attempted to activate my BWC with negative results.

The vehicle was observed by Sergeant William Zito #153 on Paterson Avenue in the area of Humboldt Street traveling eastbound. Sgt. Zito #153 notified Headquarters and began to follow the vehicle at a distance to wait for additional Officers in order to effectuate a motor vehicle stop. This Officer, along with Detective/Sergeant Kevin Felten #140, PO Christopher Lassoni #158 and PO William Black #153 coordinated with Sgt. Zito #153 in the area of Route 17 North, just entering the borough of Carlstadt.

At this time, Sgt. Zito #158 attempted to make a motor vehicle stop of the above vehicle. The vehicle slowed to the right shoulder where Sgt. Zito #153 radioed that he observed at least three (3) black, male occupants in the vehicle. Officers were tactically positioned amongst all lanes of Route 17 North in order to initiate a felony motor vehicle stop. At this time, the vehicle accelerated from the right shoulder and onto Route 17 North.

Sgt. Zito #153 began pursuing the vehicle and pursued it into Hasbrouck Heights. At this time, Sgt. Zito #153, who is assigned a ghost-lettered black Chevrolet Tahoe, asked for a marked vehicle to assume primary command of the pursuit. In the area of Route 17 North and Franklin Avenue, this Officer accelerated to take over primary. It should be noted that this Officer is assigned Patrol Vehicle #9, which is a marked, black and white Ford Explorer.

This Officer pursued the vehicle on Route 17 North until they exited the highway at Polifly Road in Hackensack. On Route 17, this Officer's top speed was approximately 85 miles per hour and the traffic was light to medium. Upon exiting towards Polifly Road, this Officer observed the vehicle enter the on ramp towards Route 80 East. While on Route 80 East, all East Rutherford cars were part of the pursuit. This Officer maintained constant communication with Sergeant Jeff Perry #151, Officer in Charge, updating speed, traffic conditions and other information. While on Route 80 East, traffic was light and speeds were approximately 100 miles per hour. The vehicle was observed continuously eluding Officers by weaving in and out of traffic and utilizing the shoulder to pass other vehicles.

While still primary Officer of the pursuit, this Officer observed the vehicle enter Route 95 North, towards the George Washington Bridge. The traffic was light and the vehicle continuously drove on the shoulder and drove around other vehicles in a weaving manner. Upon approaching the George Washington Bridge, Port Authority Police were notified, via SPEN radio, and took over primary in the pursuit. This information was radioed to Sgt. Perry #151. Officers continued pursuit onto the George Washington Bridge where the vehicle was observed weaving in and out of traffic and utilized a closed lane several times to elude Officers. After crossing the George Washington Bridge, this Officer observed the felony vehicle collide with the primary Port Authority police car. The vehicle lost their front bumper and they continued northbound on Route 95. While the traffic became heavier, Officers were unable to stop the fleeing vehicle. At this time, the vehicle was observed taking the Jerome Avenue exit (Exit 2A) off Route 95 North. The driver drove to the top of the ramp and immediately entered the adjacent on-ramp to enter back onto Route 95 North.

While radioing this information to Sgt. Perry #151, this Officer was made aware of unclear radio transmissions and Sgt. Perry #151 terminated the pursuit. The vehicle continued onto Route 95 North with several Port Authority police cars continuing pursuit. All East Rutherford Officers acknowledged the termination and deactivated all emergency lights and sirens on the ramp from Jerome Avenue to Route 95 North.

Less than a minute or so after terminating the pursuit, it was learned that the above felony vehicle crashed and the occupants bailed out of the vehicle. Port Authority Police were able to apprehend one (1) occupant and two (2) are still outstanding at the time of this report. Detective/Sgt. Felten #140 and Sgt. Zito #153 were joined by Lieutenant/Detective Robert Applegate #150 at Port Authority Police, George Washington Bridge Command, to coordinate an interagency investigation.

This Officer, along with PO Lassoni #158 and PO Black #164 returned to the Borough and began all appropriate pursuit paperwork including Benchmark Analytics and pursuit reports. No further action.

REPORT OF A LARGE NUMBER OF VEHICLES DOING BURN OUTS.

On Saturday, April 4, 2026, I prepared complaint summons 0212-S-2026-000070 for the above party. The defendant was issued his complaint by Officers Coleman and Sokol. The defendant was released without incident and issued a notice to appear at CJP court on April 7, 2026.

On the above date and time, P.O Lassoni and I responded to a report of a large car meet. On arrival, we observed a large number of vehicles in the area. Multiple parties were running back to their vehicles and fleeing the scene. I observed a grey Honda Accord bearing NJ reg C45UXP traveling west from 55 Madison Circle Dr. The vehicle improperly passing multiple vehicles and passing around pedestrians. I then positioned my marked patrol car #10 in front of the vehicle to initiate a motor vehicle stop. My emergency lights and sirens were activated at this time. The driver, later to be identified as Brian Gil, made eye contact me and attempted to pass my vehicle on his right-hand side. As the vehicle attempted to pass me, the Honda struck my vehicle's push bumper on the passenger side. The driver then fled at a high rate of speed. I then positioned my vehicle behind the Honda.

The driver passed multiple vehicles utilizing the wrong side of the road. The vehicle disregarded a stop sign and accelerated north on Murray Hill Parkway. The driver continued to drive towards oncoming traffic and began weaving in and out of vehicles. I was still positioned behind the vehicle with my emergency lights and sirens activated. The vehicle then disregarded a second stop sign and traveled west on East Union Ave. The vehicle continued to travel at a high rate of speed towards oncoming traffic. I then observed the vehicle merge onto Rt 17 North and accelerate to speeds exceeding 90 MPH. My emergency lights and sirens were still active at this time. The vehicle slowed and turned west onto Division Ave before having to come to a sudden stop due to the dead end. I then exited my patrol vehicle and approached the car on the driver hands side. I instructed the driver out of the vehicle multiple times to which he complied. The defendant was then assisted to the ground to effect and arrest. Once on the ground, Brian, now Defendant, was handcuffed. P.O Lassoni, Rutherford PD, and Carlstadt PD arrived on scene at this time. The Defendant was searched incident to arrest and placed in the rear of Patrol car #10. Two female passengers exited the vehicle and arranged rides home.

Nick's Towing was requested at this time. I then transported the defendant to Headquarters while P.O Lassoni followed. Sgt Ross remained with the vehicle until Nick's Towing took possession of the vehicle.

Once at Headquarters, the Defendant was fingerprinted and photographed. The Defendant was also read his Miranda Rights before being placed in temporary holding Cell #4. A pursuit report was also completed. Referred to the Detective Bureau.
