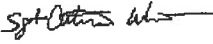

Bergen County Communications reported to surrounding agencies that the Closter Police Department was on a motor vehicle stop when the vehicle took off during the stop. The vehicle involved was a White Honda Accord bearing NY registration LXP9607 that was last seen on Piermont Road possibly heading toward Closter Dock Road. While on patrol in the area of Route 9W and exit two I observed the vehicle matching the description driving North on Route 9W merging onto the Palisades Interstate Parkway. At this time, I positioned my patrol vehicle behind the vehicle to follow it to which the driver was not aware of my presence yet driving within normal conditions. I was monitoring traffic, checking the speed of the vehicle, and providing updates to Bergen County Communications. Simultaneously, I also was maintaining visual to confirm the registration of the vehicle, I toggled the overhead lights switch to what I believed was the third toggle but only reached the second toggle switch. In doing so, the DVR and body cam failed to activate during the incident. I was not aware of this until the end of the incident. While the emergency overhead lights were activated, I attempted to stop the vehicle. The vehicle began to accelerate quickly reaching speeds of approximately 75 mph. The weather conditions were sunny and clear with moderate traffic. The Palisades Interstate Parkway Police entered the pursuit in the area around 6.7 mile marker, and I immediately moved over one lane to let the PIP PD units take primary position. At this time, I was not primary in pursuit. Simultaneously, I was advised by a Closter Police Officer via the radio that all they had on the vehicle at this time was only motor vehicle violations and possibly involved in a shoplifting at the Lululemon store in Closter but not confirmed yet. Given the circumstances and information provided, I immediately determined the safest decision was to terminate the pursuit. During the whole course of the incident, I followed the vehicle for approximately 3.1 miles ending in the area of mile marker 4.7 on the Palisades Interstate Parkway Southbound.
