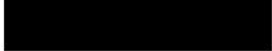

Christopher Kiszka #164 was working the 1900-0700 hours shift. I was in police uniform operating marked police vehicle #4 equipped with emergency lights and sirens. At approximately 2318 hours I was conducting traffic enforcement in the area of Midland Street and Essex Street. My vehicle was positioned southbound towards all lanes of traffic on Essex Street. I had a clear and unobstructed view of all vehicles on the roadway. Moments after I parked my vehicle in position, I observed...

a white Lexus sedan traveling westbound on Essex Street in the right lane of travel. I observed that the vehicle was traveling at an abnormally slow rate speed and also did not have its rear-lights / head-lights activated (39:3-47).

As the vehicle drove in front of me, I observed a light skin male driver wearing dark clothing with a beard who was the sole occupant. I entered traffic and was able to follow the vehicle and get behind with the intersection of Essex Street and Rochelle Avenue at a red traffic signal. I observed that the vehicle was displaying NJ Plate # B40PPU. A MDT check revealed that the vehicle was valid and returned to a female owner "Nebal Nasser".

The light turned green and I activated my emergency lights and sirens to stop the vehicle. The vehicle continued westbound onto Market Street underneath Route 80. It pulled over to the right on top of a curb as if it was stopping for my emergency vehicle. Shortly thereafter the vehicle proceeded back into traffic failing to stop for my emergency vehicle. The vehicle proceeded to turn southbound onto Saddle River road at a slow pace and drive in the opposite lane of travel in the northbound lane. There were no vehicles nearby to cause an accident. The vehicle continued adjusting into the correct lane at around 25 mph. Based on my observations, it appeared the male driver was operating under the influence, and posed an imminent threat to the safety of the public.

I followed the vehicle with lights activated and advised dispatch of my location and direction of travel. I turned off my emergency lights and followed the vehicle. I advised dispatch that I was not in pursuit, although I was following it. I bridged the gap again on the vehicle which was traveling slowly around 30 mph and attempted to conduct a stop again by activating my emergency lights and sirens. The vehicle continued southbound passed Railroad Avenue on Saddle River Road.

I again deactivated my emergency lights and kept a safe distance behind the vehicle following its direction of travel. Dispatch was notified and contacted outside jurisdictions. Traffic on the roadway was extremely light and I attempted again to stop the vehicle nearby the intersection of Rochelle Parkway in Saddle Brook. The vehicle pulled over as if was stopping, and then again failed to yield proceeding northbound on Saddle River Road. I deactivated my emergency lights again and maintained a large safe distance from the vehicle. My speed never reached over 41 mph according to MVR footage.

I advised dispatch of my location and direction of travel. I observed the vehicle proceed onto Paramus Road from Red Mill Road and struck a curb at a slow rate of speed before entering the parking lot of 61 Paramus Road (Mack Cali Building) and make a circle in the parking lot. The vehicle continued onto the Garden State Parkway Southbound and I terminated from following the vehicle at a safe distance. This was due to there being more vehicles on the roadway of the Garden State Parkway.

Dispatch advised outside jurisdictions on SPEN channel of the last location of travel of the vehicle. The registered owners address came back to [REDACTED]

Clifton PD Sgt Matthew West was contacted who responded to the residence to make contact. Upon arrival, CPD observed the vehicle involved in the incident in the driveway. They made contact with two family members of the owner of the vehicle : Nidal Nasser and Aladin Nasser at the residence. I was advised they were extremely uncooperative and Nidal was extremely intoxicated. When Nidal was told that the owner would be getting tickets, he stated he wanted the summonses issued to him. When asked if he was driving he denied it, but stated to issue him the tickets so the owner would not "get them".

Aladin possessed multiple open ATS WARRANTS as well as a suspended driver's license. He was placed under arrest by Clifton PD. Both Aladin and Nidal never admitted to operating the vehicle. Nidal DMV driver photo looked very similar to the suspect operating the vehicle at the time of the incident.

Criminal Charges are pending after further investigation into positively identifying the driver of the vehicle.

Sgt Gallina was contacted off duty via telephone regarding the incident. It was determined that I was in pursuit of the vehicle even though at times I was at a safe distance with lights deactivated at a slow rate of speed following the vehicle.

NJ Benchmark and RPPD Pursuit reports completed. Suspected Nidal Nasser was contacted via his telephone and left voice mail regarding the incident.

On 09/07/2025 at around 20:30 hours Mr. Nidal Nasser contacted police headquarters. He stated that the vehicle is registered to his mother Nebal, but it belongs to him. He continued to state that he loaned his vehicle to a friend named "Jason Seveda" and has known him since he was 5 years of age. He stated that "Jason" picked up the vehicle from him at around 1930 hours and did not say anything to him.

He stated that prior to Clifton Police showing up, "Jason" returned the vehicle and handed him the keys. Nidal admitted to being extremely intoxicated the night before during which the incident took place. He stated "Jason" races the vehicle in the Teterboro area and that is why he believed the vehicle fled from the stop. Based on my observations, this could not be the case as the vehicle was driving with its headlights off and slow on Essex Street when I initially observed it in operation. When advised that the registered owner would be receiving summonses pending the ID of the driver, Mr. Nidal stated to issue the summonses to himself, even though he stated he was not driving. Mr. Nidal stated he would be responding to our police department to provide a statement.

He provided a phone number for "Jason" which using police investigative tools revealed the phone number was owned by "Jeffrey Sheldon". The number was contacted and Jeffrey stated that he knew no one by the name of Nidal Nasser and it was not "Jason Seveda's" phone number.

At 2135 hours, Mr. Nidal's sister Reem Nasser contacted police headquarters in reference to her brother. She stated that Mr. Nidal left a [REDACTED] the night prior and was wondering if he had responded to our police station. She stated that he [REDACTED] She was advised to contact Clifton PD and to report her brother [REDACTED] Clifton PD was contacted and updated regarding what Reem stated to us. Clifton PD was in route to Ms. Nasser's apartment to take the report regarding the [REDACTED] While speaking to Nidal on the phone, he mentioned nothing of being [REDACTED] and made no [REDACTED] statements. Clifton PD reported Mr. Nidal [REDACTED] operating the same vehicle from the incident.

On 09/08/2025 at 00:11 hours Nidal called the police headquarters in a manic state apologizing for not responding to the police station to provide a statement. He made an admission of eluding officers the night before, and that he was present with officers again. Based on his admission he will be charged accordingly criminally and issued the appropriate summonses. Clifton PD was contacted and they stated he was located at "Fat Bastard and Son's Restaurant" in South Hackensack.

South Hackensack was contacted who transported Nidal to [REDACTED]

Nidal was issued traffic summonses for the following offenses:
