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On Saturday, October 4, 2025, I was assigned to Motor Patrol Squad #1, patrolling Post 3 West in patrol vehicle #9. At approximately 5:50 PM, off duty Teaneck Police Officer M. Pellegrino #371 contacted me in regard to a motorcycle traveling in the vicinity of Windsor Road, that he had been previously observed being operating in a reckless manner within the township in the past. A male, with a light complexion, was operating the motorcycle at the time, which matched driver description from other officers previous observations of the reckless driving.

The vehicle then proceeded westbound, continuing on New Bridge Boulevard, where it eventually continued to Hackensack Avenue. Officer Pellegrino was able to provide me with the license plate New Jersey 5KUV3. He was also able to provide me photographs of the operator and motorcycle which captured it's registration (NJ 5KUV3). An NCIC check of this registration revealed that the motorcycle was reported stolen out of Hackensack, NJ (NIC #V437169271).

I was able to locate the motorcycle on Hackensack Avenue at the intersection leading to the Hackensack Commons Shopping Center. I was also able to confirm the license plate that Officer Pellegrino provided me. I activated my emergency lights and sirens in order to initiate a motor vehicle stop. The male party turned around and pointed to his chest as to acknowledge that he was being pulled over. The driver then proceeded to flee utilizing the ramp from Hackensack Avenue at Riverside Square Mall towards Route 4 Westbound. At this time, I initiated a motor vehicle pursuit. I immediately advised police dispatch of the situation.

The pursuit lasted a total of approximately 1.78 miles and traffic density was medium. There was no pedestrian traffic throughout the entirety of the pursuit, however I observed several stationary pedestrians waiting at bus stops around Forest Avenue. Initially we began Route 4 Westbound and took the Grand Avenue exit in River Edge. The vehicle then merged back onto Route 4 Westbound and proceeded to exit on Forest Avenue in Paramus, NJ. At the intersection to go north or southbound onto Forest Avenue, the vehicle made a U-turn and proceeded past the IFLY business located at 211 Route 4. The vehicle continued again to the next Forest Avenue exit ramp before again make a U-turn and headed back towards Route 4 Westbound. The vehicle then proceed eastbound in the westbound lanes at which point I terminated the pursuit due to public safety and attorney general guidelines. I communicated to headquarters that the pursuit was terminated and I disengaged from the violator.

On October 5, 2025, I reached out to numerous police departments in the area to see if anyone could identify the male party from the pictures provided to me. Bergenfield Police Officers S. Barreneche and K. Brooks advised that they could positively identify the male party as Mr. Kevinangelo Cabrera, a 32 year old male out of Bergenfield. Each officer have had specific interactions with Mr. Cabrera in the past. I compared the photo from the day of the pursuit to his New Jersey driver license and backtrace information and confirmed the party involved in this incident was in fact Mr. Cabrera.

On October 5, 2025, I contacted the Hackensack Police Department to advise the case detective that the male party on their stolen motorcycle had been identified. I was provided a phone number for Detective Sergeant Tripodi and was advised to call tomorrow to update him.

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On October 7, 2025, I made contact with Sergeant Tripodi and kept him updated on this incident along with the identity of the male party.

On October 8, 2025, I responded to the Hackensack Police Department and met with Sergeant Seretis. He was able to contact the Honorable Judge Takvorian who authorized the issuance of Hackensack Complaint Warrant 0223 W 2025 000531 in violation of the following;

- Eluding in violation of 2C:29-2B, a crime of the second degree
- Receiving Stolen Property in violation of 2C:20-7A, a crime of the third degree

The warrant was entered into NCIC by Hackensack Police Department under NIC #W123091293.

A pursuit report was completed in benchmark.

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
