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On October 4, 2025, at approximately 5:54 PM, while in an off duty capacity, I was speaking with Officer K. Rosen utilizing my hands free device that was connected to the bluetooth in my personal vehicle.

While talking to Officer Rosen, I observed a white and black motorcycle that was bearing what appeared to be a New Jersey registration that was bent up in a manner that hinders the ability to read the characters. The motorcycle also matched the description of a motorcycle that had eluded Teaneck officers over the past few months on route 4 in our jurisdiction.

It should be noted that I observed this motorcycle traveling west on Roemer Avenue towards River Road. At that point, I had pulled next to the motorcycle and was able to read the license plate that was bent up at an angle under the rear fender of the motorcycle. I asked Officer Rosen to conduct and inquire into the New Jersey registration - 5KUV3, which revealed that the motorcycle was reported stolen out of Hackensack, NJ (NIC #V437169271).

I continued to follow the motorcycle in my personal vehicle, driving in a routine manner as I updated Officer Rosen as to my location and direction. We continued south from New Bridge Road onto Hackensack Avenue. I was able to give Officer Rosen updates on direction of travel and what the suspect was wearing. While giving Officer Rosen updates, I passed the motorcycle and then stopped at a red light on Hackensack Avenue and the Hackensack Commons shopping center.

I observed that Officer Rosen was traveling north on Hackensack Avenue stopped at the same traffic signal. At that point, Officer Rosen spotted my vehicle, the motorcycle and male party operating the motorcycle. As the traffic signal turned green, I continued south and observed Officer Rosen conduct a U-Turn and activate his emergency lights and siren in an attempt to conduct a motor vehicle stop. As Officer Rosen initialed the motor vehicle stop, I pulled slowly to the right onto the Route 4 West with the intention to wait for back up officers to arrive.

While stopped on the on ramp, the operator of the stolen motorcycle began to slowly weave in and out of traffic. The motorcycle then cut across several lanes of Hackensack Avenue, sped up onto Route 4 West and began to elude Officer Rosen. Due to the fact that I was off duty and in my personal vehicle, remained in Hackensack as Officer Rosen began to pursue the motorcycle on to Route 4 West. See Officer K.
