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On Sunday January 11, 2026 at approximately 5:23 p.m. Officer K. Rosen #359 and I were assigned to marked patrol vehicle #18 and were patrolling in the area of State Street and Teaneck Road. While on patrol, Teaneck Police Dispatch advised the units on the road of an ALPR HIT for a felony vehicle wanted for striking a Police Officer with their vehicle in New York City, NY. Dispatch advised that the vehicle was traveling north on Teaneck Road from East Forrest Avenue. Dispatch advised that the felony vehicle was a silver Honda Accord, bearing Pennsylvania registration MWS-2361.

Officer Rosen and I were driving west on State Street when Dispatch provided the ALPR HIT. Officer Rosen made a U-turn and began to drive east on State Street. While making the left turn onto Teaneck Road, we observed a silver Honda Accord make a left turn onto State Street going west. Officer Rosen made a U-turn on Teaneck Road and we continued west on State Street. The Honda Accord then made a right turn into the Municipal parking lot of 29 State Street just south of 1500 Teaneck Road. Officer Rosen and I followed the vehicle into the parking lot. While entering the parking lot, the Honda Accord was at the dead end of the parking lot attempting to make a K-turn. As Officer Rosen and I pulled up to the vehicle, Officer Rosen activated the emergency lights and we exited our vehicle. As Officer Rosen exited the driver side of the police vehicle, the Honda Accord accelerated towards Officer Rosen striking him with the front driver side of his vehicle causing him to fall down to the ground. Officer Rosen then communicated over the police radio to dispatch that the Honda Accord had just struck struck him and fled south from the parking lot. Officer Rosen advised dispatch that the Honda Accord is heading east on State Street towards Teaneck Road.

I observed that the Honda Accord entered the parking lot of 1400 Teaneck Road and updated other responding officers. At that point, Officer G. DiStasio #396 observed the Honda Accord exiting the parking lot onto Teaneck Road south bound and initiated a motor vehicle pursuit. Refer to Officer DiStasio's supplemental for further information.

Officer DiStasio continued to pursue the Honda towards the George Washington Bridge where traffic became heavy and speeds reduced to approximately 50 MPH. It continued through the tolls to George Washington Bridge Lower Level. At that point, Lt. Moliere ordered termination of the pursuit. Officer DiStasio terminated the pursuit and the Port Authority Police Department took over the pursuit as primary.

At approximately 5:28 P.M., Port Authority Police Department notified Teaneck Police Department via SPEN that the vehicle was involved in a motor vehicle crash and they had the driver in custody. The Port Authority PD arrested the driver, Royer Soto and later charged him with Resisting arrest, Eluding, Possession of Stolen License Plates, CDS, and Aggravated Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer. Refer to their reports for further under 2026-009405 and 2026-009493.

When back at headquarters, Teaneck volunteer ambulance responded to evaluate Officer Rosen's injuries. Officer Rosen was then transported to [REDACTED]

PADP eventually transported Mr. Soto to Bergen County Corrections and Rehabilitation Center on their warrant. Lt. M. Moliere completed Teaneck Complaint Warrant 0260-W-2026-000013. Mr. Soto was charged

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with the following criminal offenses:

- Resisting Arrest: 2C:29-2B
- Aggravated Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer: 2C:12-1B(5)A
- Eluding: 2C:29-2A(3)(A)
- Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon: 2C:12-1B(2)
- Possession of a Weapon for Unlawful Purpose: 2C:39-4D
- Hindering: 2C:29-3B(2)
- Failure to make Lawful Disposition of CDS: 2C:35-10C

The warrant was later submitted to BCC&RC and Bergen County Sheriffs officers processed Mr. Soto on the complaint.

Mr. Soto was remanded to the jail awaiting a bail hearing.
