Subject: Selection of new promotional positions and assignments

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All,

I'm writing to let you know about the pending promotions and assignments due to Lieutenant Markulic's retirement and Captain Pilecki's pending retirement.

As you are aware, this is a tough choice that needs to be carefully thought through in light of a number of circumstances. A few criteria are crucial to the posts vacant in the department, even though they might not be immediately apparent to everyone. After much deliberation, I have selected what I feel are the most qualified candidates for the positions that will be open. However, I want to acknowledge that this was not an easy decision, and we understand that there may be some disappointment among those who were not selected. Please know that I value the contributions of all our supervisors and your continued excellence is not only requested, it's expected. Thank you for your understanding and support.

As of December 1st the following promotions and assignments will occur:

Lieutenant Mazzeo will be promoted to Captain and be assigned to the Service Division.

Lieutenant Revilak will be assigned to Administration and become the department's Internal Affairs officer.

Sergeant Levine will be promoted to Lieutenant. He will not only be responsible for Tech Services for the PD but we anticipate that in the near future he will be working more closely with tech services for Town Hall as well.

Patrolman Campagnola will be promoted to Sergeant. He will be assigned to the Patrol Division. Captain Yurgel will assign his patrol shift.

As of December 2nd 2023, the following promotions will occur:

Sergeant Hochhauser will be promoted to Lieutenant. He will stay in the Services Division to replace Lieutenant Revilak.

Patrolman Lawler will be promoted to Sergeant. He will be assigned to the Patrol Division. Captain Yurgel will assign his patrol shift.

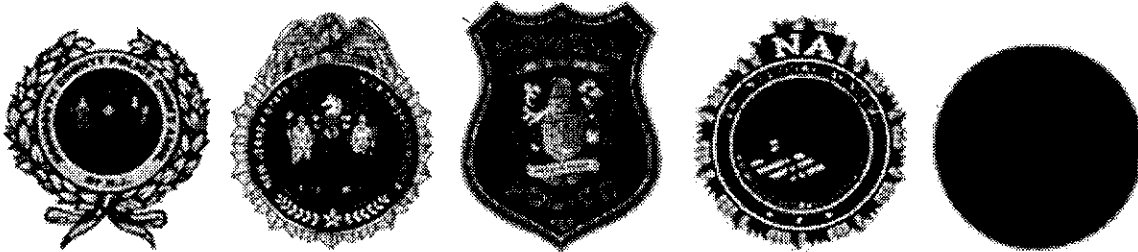
As of Jan 1st 2024, the following assignments will occur:

Sergeants Popek and Lowe will be assigned to the Services Division. Their specific assignments will be determined by Captain Mazzeo.
