Our ordinance requires **full compliance** with state licensing standards. Currently applications are being accepted at the State level only.

Resolutions of support, which do not "approve" anything, they simply certify that the applications to the State were for sites located in a zone of the Borough of West Cape May where retail sales are permitted, are only considered after an applicant submits proof of ownership or rental of a WCM location and a full business plan for our Borough Attorney to review.

The ordinance that was approved by the Borough of West Cape May Commissioners is fully consistent with the State Statute and Regulations. I have attached it for your convenience. The section of the ordinance regarding distance from parks applies to manufacturing, wholesaling and distributing, not to retail operations. Of course all types are restricted regarding distance for churches, synagogues, schools, and playgrounds.

If you would like the Borough Commission to consider a resolution authorizing support for sustainability of cannabis business you should submit your information.

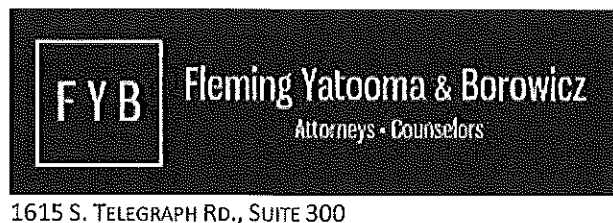

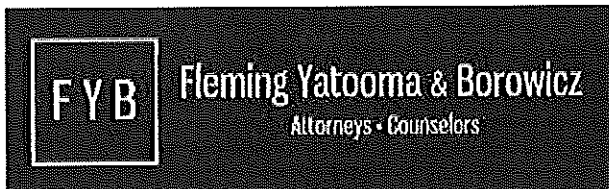
