Are you trying to claim that that McCall was travelling with Daddy King in 1952 as well?

I went to the church, the oral history of the church is well known that Dr. King preached there and used to frequent there, not his Father.

DEAN of Fort Valley College, Fort Valley, Ga., the Rev. Walter McCall who is on leave of absence to study, and the Rev. M. L. King, of Atlanta, were the weekend guests of the Rev. Lloyd A. Burrus, pastor of the Zion Baptist Church.
