Out of 20 articles found in the Chester Times, 10 use Jr., and 10 do not. 3 articles say he's from Atlanta. If you include the 3 clippings showing an M L King at Zion Baptist, then he is referred to without the Jr, more than he is with.

You haven't responded to the fact that McCall preached at Zion Baptist in Camden one week prior to the claim that Daddy King came up from Atlanta to preach the next week. Nor the buttressing fact that McCall and an "M L King" also visited the same church in 1952.

I wanted to read back over our research notes for constructing that timeline.

We wanted to differentiate between appearances by MLK, Jr. and Sr. (as both, obviously, have presentations announced via newspaper). While not an exact science, MLK, Jr.--more often than not--was identified as from Crozer or Chester.

Sr. was almost always identified as "of Atlanta." Again, not an absolute measure, but our decisions were based on percentages of occurrence.
