Stockton University's Open Public Records Act (OPRA) Custodian received your OPRA Request on March 5, 2020. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is March 16, 2020.

Your OPRA Request sought access to the following

Your request requires additional time beyond the seven (7) business days to fulfill. OPRA allows custodians extensions of time to respond pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.i. Specifically, OPRA states that, "the requestor shall be advised by the custodian when the record can be made available. If the record is not made available by that time, access shall be deemed denied." Id.

The University requires an additional nine (9) business days until March 27, 2020 to respond to your request, due to the volume of documents requested and subject to review, and the impact of the University's emergent and ongoing operations response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

If your request for access to a government record has been denied, you have a right to challenge the decision to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511; by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625; by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us; or, at its web site located at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about OPRA. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
