Re: Request for Access to Public Records

Dear Mr. Kratovil:

As requested pursuant to the Open Public Records Act, enclosed please find all records readily identified as responsive to your request. With respect to your request, please be advised that the enclosed records have been redacted to remove personal email addresses. OPRA provides that "a public agency has a responsibility and an obligation to safeguard from public access a citizen's personal information with which it has been entrusted when disclosure thereof would violate the citizen's reasonable expectation of privacy . . . " N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1. The potential for harm in subsequent nonconsensual disclosure and the lack of any adequate safeguards preventing unauthorized disclosure of the email addresses outweighs your degree of need for access to the email addresses. See Gettler v. Twp. of Wantage (Sussex), GRC Complaint No. 2009-73 (redaction of email addresses accompanied by identifiers were determined to be lawful); D'Andrea v. New Jersey Civil Service Commission, GRC Complaint No. 2014-153 (redaction was proper and there is sufficient information in the emails to determine the identity of the senders/recipients).
