As an update, apparently Samaritano was before the Atlantic County Drug Court Judge, Judge Waldman, for a virtual court appearance. There was a colloquy between the defendant and the Judge in light of his anticipated sentencing on Monday, December 7, 2020. The following issues were discussed:

1. Defendant told a DC staff member that it was his opinion that there is now a conflict with Judge Waldman because Judge Waldman was the Judge assigned to his Atlantic County case before he was considering DC (when his Atlantic County case was being handled by a "trial team" Judge – before he pled on the Atlantic County case for DC).
2. Defendant complained that he was "blackmailed" into pleading on the Monmouth case, but would not specify how.
3. Since defendant has yet to plead to his numerous Ocean County cases that were transferred to Atlantic County for disposition, he continued to complain about what he perceives are discovery violations and a lack of a dismissal of one matter allegedly promised to him by a Judge.
4. Judge Waldman informed defendant that if he felt he was "blackmailed" in Monmouth, he would let him file a Slater motion and let him withdraw his plea. Judge Waldman gave defendant until Monday, December 7, 2020, to either be sentenced into Drug Court on his Monmouth and Atlantic Cases or file the Slater motion, but that he must decide one way or the other.
5. The Atlantic County AP brought up the concept of sending cases back to their original jurisdictions and Judge Waldman indicated he would need to speak to the Assignment Judge, who accepted the Ocean County matters. The Atlantic County

AP is of the opinion that since our case was transferred per a Consolidation Order solely for the purposes of sentencing, it would be easier to send back, without involving the Atlantic County Assignment Judge.

6. There was some talk that defendant would be hiring a private attorney, he complained about his current public defender, and represented to the Court that he had already spoken with a private attorney.

I know you already gave it a January tracking date, but I wanted to let you know what occurred most recently. I also wanted make sure Al was aware, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I would note that it would be my position that if the defendant opts for filing a Slater motion with respect to his plea to our case, that I would be seeking to have the case returned to Monmouth County, as the Consolidation Order specifically limits disposition to entry into and completion of Drug Court in Atlantic County – withdrawal of his plea would result in return of the case to us.
