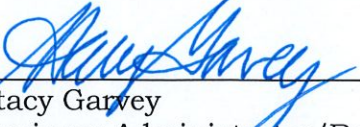
Please accept this correspondence in response to the Open Public Records Act ("OPRA") request you submitted to the Midland Park Board of Education ("Board") regarding the below-referenced requests on August 2, 2021. Recall that by letter of August 9, 2021, I informed you that the Board would need an extension until August 31, 2021, to complete its response. The Board had requested additional time to respond to your request due to the volume of responsive emails and the need to redact information that is exempt from access under OPRA. Records were promised to you by September 7, 2021, in the most recent extension.

Please be advised that your request is granted. The Board does not maintain and does not have the ability through Microsoft Outlook to create an email server log. Consequently, you are being provided with all of the emails from November 1, 2008 through July 31, 2021 from recipient: Victor Pennetta or Pennetta Automation or Pennetta and Sons or vpennetta3@pennetta.com or any email from the domain Pennetta.com or sgarvey@mpsnj.org OR sender: sgarvey@mpsnj.org or vpennetta3@pennetta.com or any email where the sender is Victor Pennetta III or any email from the domain Pennetta.com. These documents have been redacted to remove security access codes and personal cell phone numbers. These redactions are pursuant to the privacy exception and the security exception. The privacy exception applies to the employee's private cell phone. See *Perino v. Borough of Haddon Heights*, GRC Complaint No. 2004-128 (Nov. 2004) and the redaction of the passwords and other security information under the security exceptions, N.J.S.A. 47:1A-9(a).

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the Board's decision to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the GRC by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at (866) 850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, New Jersey, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their website at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
