Attached please find the 2019 Emergency Management Budget and Capital Improvement Request.

All previous budget submissions since Hurricane Floyd (1999) included funding to build a much needed and long overdue Emergency Operations Center {EOC}.

Since 2012 including this budget submission, OEM requested the Township Committee explore options with the Board of Education to build the EOC on Midland School Grounds. We are sure you see the importance of this project as you have been actively involved with us during some of the most recent Flooding Emergencies including the evacuation of the Emergency Operations Center during Hurricane Irene from Fire Hq to Midland School as well as Hurricane Sandy, Numerous Table Top Exercises, Meetings and Special Event Planning.

Notwithstanding the current state of affairs within the Township and Township Committee, we are once again requesting you and the Township Committee take a serious look at constructing a viable Emergency Operations Center in an area that is outside the floodplain, has unrestricted access for emergency vehicles and personnel.

This is taken from the NJ State Police OEM website. It is referred to as the New Jersey Civilian Defense and Disaster Control Act. I highlighted the section I believe appropriate. The first section lists the OEM Coordinators partial responsibilities authorized under this act. The second section is the Disorderly Conduct provision. App.A:9 40.4. Duties of municipal emergency management coordinator

Each municipal emergency management coordinator shall be responsible for the planning, activating, coordinating, and the conduct of emergency management operations within his municipality. *L.1953, c.438, s.10; amended 1989,c.222,s.4.*

App.A:9_49. Violations as disorderly conduct; penalty; prosecution

Any person who shall:

- a. Commit any unauthorized or otherwise unlawful act during the threat or imminence of danger in any emergency that jeopardizes the health, welfare and safety of the people; or
- b. Commit any unauthorized or otherwise unlawful act during the threat or imminence of danger during any emergency that contributes to the loss of or destruction to property; or
- c. Hamper, impede, or in any way interfere with any person who is performing any function authorized under this act; or
- d. Drive any motor vehicle in a prohibited area during a blackout or while an air raid alert is in progress or in any other manner contrary to the rules and regulations covering any period of danger or any emergency; or
- e. Go within a prohibited area contrary to rules and regulations; or
- f. Refuse to obey the lawful orders of any air raid warden, civilian protection worker, or other person who is duly authorized to perform any act or function during the threat or imminence of danger or any emergency; or
- g. Refuse to cooperate with any air raid warden, civilian protection worker, or other person who is duly authorized to perform any act or function in connection with activities during the threat or imminence of danger or any emergency; or
- h. Violate any order, rule or regulation adopted by the Governor and promulgated as provided by this act; or

I. Violate any other provision of this act declared herein to be unlawful shall be adjudged a disorderly person and shall be subject to imprisonment for a term not to exceed 6 months or shall pay a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00 or to both a fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Prosecution for the imposition of a penalty pursuant to this section shall be commenced in the municipal court of the municipality wherein the offense is alleged to have occurred. The State shall be required to prove all elements of the offense beyond a reasonable doubt in order to obtain a conviction. *L.1942, c. 251, p. 687, s. 17. Amended by L.1953, First Poses., c. 438, p. 2412, s. 21; L.1982, c. 108, s. 1, eff. Aug. 4, 1982.*

App.A:9_50. Aiding or abetting violation

Any person who shall knowingly aid or abet another in the violation of any provision of this act shall also be adjudged a disorderly person and punishable in the same manner as the violation aided or abetted. *L.1942, c. 251, p. 688, s. 18.*
