She also has a few cats that haven't been TNR'd that are becoming regulars so I'm going to set traps for her this week to try and trap them. I'll have her sign on as a colony caretaker with us too.

I told her we'd coordinate bringing the other 2 to her as well. Nina, I know the one cat had pretty significant conjunctivitis, maybe if he's doing a bit better I can plan to bring them to her by the end of the week? I know Dr. H wanted him to be getting antibiotics daily but I'm not sure that has been feasible. The clinic has me trapping only Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday this week, so I could bring them to her Thursday if that's a possibility. Let me know what you think.
