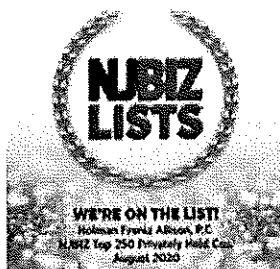

The Guide to Equitable Sharing for State and Local Law Enforcement Agencies requires agencies participating in the Equitable Sharing Program to annually submit an Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification (ESAC) form through the eShare Portal within 60 days of the close of their fiscal year. MLARS will review submitted ESAC forms prior to acceptance. If the ESAC is not accepted within 60 days of the fiscal year end, the agency will be made non-compliant.

To remain compliant and eligible to receive sharing, your ESAC form must be submitted through the eShare Portal, reviewed, and accepted by MLARS within 60 days of the close of the fiscal year. ESAC forms are reviewed in the order received. Peak times for submission are the last two weeks and first two weeks prior to and following the 60-day submission deadline.

Approval from the Agency and Governing Body Head are required prior to submission and must be retained in your agency records.

Dear Mayor Sabosik,

As per our meeting this past Thursday evening February 13th, enclosed is our list of items that we would appreciate being fixed at our building at 733 Albert E. Clifton Ave. These items being corrected or replaced would definitely help address some of the safety issues that we have with Point Paws. As we discussed, the following items need prompt attention: 1- The wire hanging across our parking lot needs to be raised and tightened or replaced, 2- We would like the phone line replaced so that we can use our phone and WiFi added to increase the productivity and organization of our program. 3- The front steps / Deck & Railings are in desperate need of replacement. They are rotten and we fear one of our volunteers may get hurt by falling through the boards or railing giving way. 4- Our buildings basement and the attached garage are infested with mice, which occurred after the OEM moved out, so we need an exterminator. Breathing in mouse feces are not only bad for our building cats, but most importantly, our volunteers and visitors too. 5- The basement needs to be emptied of items that have been ruined by the mice and lack of air circulation. We would like to have a dumpster so we can clean up. 6- The gutters do not work right which leads to water pouring down in-between the building and the garage causing the roof to leak. The roof on our building is in need of repair in a few spots as water damage inside is evident and you can see it on the ceiling in certain areas.

I know we briefly spoke about and you had wanted me to include in this email about our next fundraiser which will be Friday, May 8th at the Point Pleasant Moose Lodge on River Road. It is a designer bag bingo/gift auction which we've done a few times already and had great success. I know you wanted to let Frank know about that as well as including us on your website with other organizations in hopes that we can receive donations that way too. As soon as our flyer is printed up which should be within the week, I will forward that to you as well.

I am going to forward you a separate email with the natural deterrent information so cats that are nuisances in peoples yards or on their properties or by their businesses you will have this for future reference. Just a quick note so that you have it now these natural

deterrent's would include using coffee grinds or citrus peels such as lemons, grapefruits and oranges. They are natural and actually help enrich the soil in garden areas dirt etc. They are not harmful to wildlife. They are just too strong of a smell which deters the cat or cats from going in the area you place them.

Thank you so much for all your help now and in the near future. Hopefully we can continue to work together and help the community a lot more going forward. Any help from the town is and always will be greatly appreciated. Thank you so much !

As we discussed, the following items need prompt attention: 1- The wire hanging across our parking lot needs to be raised and tightened or replaced, 2- We would like the phone line replaced so that we can use our phone and WiFi added to increase the productivity and organization of our program. 3- The front steps / Deck & Railings are in desperate need of replacement. They are rotten and we fear one of our volunteers may get hurt by falling through the boards or railing giving way. 4- Our buildings basement and the attached garage are infested with mice, which occurred after the OEM moved out, so we need an exterminator. Breathing in mouse feces are not only bad for our building cats, but most importantly, our volunteers and visitors too. 5- The basement needs to be emptied of items that have been ruined by the mice and lack of air circulation. We would like to have a dumpster so we can clean up. 6- The gutters do not work right which leads to water pouring down in-between the building and the garage causing the roof to leak. The roof on our building is in need of repair in a few spots as water damage inside is evident and you can see it on the ceiling in certain areas.

I know we briefly spoke about and you had wanted me to include in this email about our next fundraiser which will be Friday, May 8th at the Point Pleasant Moose Lodge on River Road. It is a designer bag bingo/gift auction which we've done a few times already and had great success. I know you wanted to let Frank know about that as well as including us on your website with other organizations in hopes that we can receive donations that way too. As soon as our flyer is printed up which should be within the week, I will forward that to you as well.

I am going to forward you a separate email with the natural deterrent information so cats that are nuisances in peoples yards or on their properties or by their businesses you will have this for future reference. Just a quick note so that you have it now these natural deterrent's would include using coffee grinds or citrus peels such as lemons, grapefruits and oranges. They are natural and actually help enrich the soil in garden areas dirt etc. They are not harmful to wildlife. They are just too strong of a smell which deters the cat or cats from going in the area you place them.

Thank you so much for all your help now and in the near future. Hopefully we can continue to work together and help the community a lot more going forward. Any help from the town is and always will be greatly appreciated. Thank you so much !

How fast will state and local governments receive the aid? States, Tribal governments, territories, counties, and metropolitan cities (which generally have over 50,000 inhabitants) would receive their allocations within 60 days of submitting their certification of need to the Department of Treasury. Because it could take a full year for the Department of Treasury to calculate and disburse the allocations for smaller local governments (generally those with under 50,000 inhabitants, comprising over 33,000

entities), the Department of Treasury is instead required to send those funds to the states within 60 days of the law's enactment. States would then have 30 days to disburse the funds to the local governments (called "nonentitlement units of local government") based on population. A state could ask Treasury for an extension for distributing one or more of those allocations if necessary, but it would need to justify why the extension is warranted. States would have no discretionary authority to change the amount of, or attach additional requirements to, the payments allocated to local governments.

Went to the state website to get the forms that are necessary to fill out for the emergency and in the first sentence it says we can only declare after budget has been adopted (see below).

"As permitted under NJS40A:4-46, local governments may make emergency appropriations, after adoption of the annual budget, for purposes unforeseen at the time of adoption. The total amount of an emergency appropriation shall be fully funded as a deferred charge in the succeeding fiscal year's budget, except if the appropriation is to be funded through the authorization of bonds pursuant to 40A:2-3."

If this is the case should we charge to roads department account and then decrease the Capital Improvement Fund Budget from 100,000 to 58,000 and increase the Roads Department Budget by \$42,000 to cover the cost. We can still pass the "Authorize the Emergency Work" resolution but I do not understand how I fill out the Emergency Appropriation Resolution without the budget being passed.
