As per our meeting this past Thursday evening February 13th, enclosed is our list of items that we would appreciate being fixed at our building at 733 Albert E. Clifton Ave. These items being corrected or replaced would definitely help address some of the safety issues that we have with Point Paws. As we discussed, the following items need prompt attention: 1- The wire hanging across our parking lot needs to be raised and tightened or replaced, 2- We would like the phone line replaced so that we can use our phone and WiFi added to increase the productivity and organization of our program. 3- The front steps / Deck & Railings are in desperate need of replacement. They are rotten and we fear one of our volunteers may get hurt by falling through the boards or railing giving way. 4- Our buildings basement and the attached garage are infested with mice, which occurred after the OEM moved out, so we need an exterminator. Breathing in mouse feces are not only bad for our building cats, but most importantly, our volunteers and visitors too. 5- The basement needs to be emptied of items that have been ruined by the mice and lack of air circulation. Clifton Ave. These items being corrected or replaced would definitely help address some of the safety issues that we have with Point Paws. As we discussed, the following items need prompt attention: 1- The wire hanging across our parking lot needs to be raised and tightened or replaced, 2- We would like the phone line replaced so that we can use our phone and WiFi added to increase the productivity and organization of our program. 3- The front steps / Deck & Railings are in desperate need of replacement. They are rotten and we fear one of our volunteers may get hurt by falling through the boards or railing giving way. 4- Our buildings basement and the attached garage are infested with mice, which occurred after the OEM moved out, so we need an exterminator. Breathing in mouse feces are not only bad for our building cats, but most importantly, our volunteers and visitors too. 5- The basement needs to be emptied of items that have been ruined by the mice and lack of air circulation. We would like to have a dumpster so we can clean up. 6- The gutters do not work right which leads to water pouring down in-between the building and the garage causing the roof to leak. The roof on our building is in need of repair in a few spots as water damage inside is evident and you can see it on the ceiling in certain areas.

I know we briefly spoke about and you had wanted me to include in this email about our next fundraiser which will be Friday, May 8th at the Point Pleasant Moose Lodge on River Road. It is a designer bag bingo/gift auction which we've done a few times already and had great success. They are natural and actually help enrich the soil in garden areas dirt etc. They are not harmful to wildlife. They are just too strong of a smell which deters the cat or cats from going in the area you place them.

As part of the COVID-19 relief bill signed into law on December 27th the Employee Retention Tax Credit (ERTC) was extended into 2021 with both a larger amount of eligible wages per employee and a higher tax credit rate. In 2020 the maximum wages per employee that can be claimed for this credit is \$10,000 with a tax credit rate of 50%. For 2021, it is \$10,000 of wages per employee for both Q1 and Q2 (\$20,000 total per employee), and the tax credit rate is now 70% of wages paid. The program was also expanded to cover more businesses, and this expansion is retroactive to the original start date of the program, 3/13/2020.

Employers who received a PPP loan may also now participate in this program, however, any wages paid to employees using PPP loan dollars that have been (or will be) forgiven are ineligible for the tax credit.

While Primepoint is not in a position to help determine whether you are eligible for the program, we are here to help you to claim the tax credits. Please be aware that the IRS has not yet published guidance with regards to the updates to this program, and it is possible that specific details of its implementation may change.

If you wish to begin claiming these credits in the current quarter please email covid19@primepoint.com to request that your business be set up with the required earning.

In order to claim the credits for previous quarters, including the recently filed 4th quarter, Primepoint will be required to amend the Form 941 for each quarter being adjusted. We will ask that you complete the ERTC Adjustment Template, which we will provide to you, in order to instruct us on how much wages per employee per quarter you wish to convert to ERTC wages.

If you have determined that you are eligible for the Employee Retention Tax Credits and wish to have prior quarters adjusted and amended please email covid19@primepoint.com to request the ERTC Adjustment Template and to receive pricing on producing the amended forms.
