In reply to your last email June 15, here is the documentation you requested.

1. Don Murray's FF1, HMA, and HMO were all completed per item number 5 on Mr. Kirkham's email dated June 13th. No Hazmat applications for Julio Cerrato were submitted since Julio already has the certifications issued by the DFS (see attached documents). For Frank Kowalewski, as I stated previously has been on active military leave for several years therefore shall be inactive and can complete the hazmat applications whenever he returns (no know date of return). For Kyle Ayotte, he is working on getting a letter/copy of Hazmat Certs from Middletown Fire Academy therefore he will not run calls until this is completed and submitted to Mr. Kirkham. For Harry Rocheskey, same situation as Kyle except the letter/ certificate has to come from Ocean County Academy.

2. As for James Bevaqua, like we discussed previously, he stated he was going for permanent disability therefore is out of service.

3. This point was satisfied on June 1st.

4. Amanda and Garen Wenal needing ICS 200. Per your letter submitted to our Borough Administrator dated June 6th, " To be fully transparent, the requirement was recently promulgated and a fixed date for compliance has not been set yet. Technically, nobody is out of compliance at this very moment. However, other similarly

situated volunteer fire companies which are progressive and proactive have already had their staff trained and/or are training them now." That being said this bullet is not a deficiency but do know that training for ICS 200 and 300 is in the scheduling process for necessary members.

5. In my email response to you on June 9th, under the document labeled "Record Request" at the MOA's with West Tuckerton and Parkertown Fire Departments. When you read them in our administrators office you told us the verbiage seemed adequate. If the verbiage of those MOA's is not adequate, please supply me with a MOA template that has the adequate verbiage for your liking and I will get them signed.

6. Also in the June 9th email I sent to you was the transcript of the 65 plus former members with descriptions of their known reason for leaving if one was available and also our knowledge of where they are now. Also on June 15th an email was submitted to yourself by Lee Eggert giving you a more detailed summary of some of the past member who have left, the real reasons why they left, and supporting documentation to show the situation. These above listed documents should be more than ample information.

7. See attached respiratory protection plan we adopted.

With all this work having been completed and after conversation with Jenny the other night if you submit a letter to her to show we have met your requests and now can go back in service, we can continue to serve the residents of this town.
