- \$57,500,000 total funding

- 60-month project period to begin January 1, 2021

Eligible Applicants: The following entities are eligible to apply for funding through this program

- Municipalities
- Counties
- Institutions of Higher Education

Overview: Through the Body-Worn Camera Grants program, the NJ LPS supports law enforcement agencies in the purchase of body-worn cameras, ancillary equipment, and storage. Law enforcement agencies are required to store data from body-worn cameras using a tamper-proof digital evidence management system that is compliant with Criminal Justice Information Services and can securely share data, while maintaining an audit trail and chain of custody. All applicant agencies must comply with Attorney General Law Enforcement Directive No. 2015-1 “Law Enforcement Directive Regarding Police Body-Worn Cameras and Stored BWC Recordings” in order to be eligible for support.
