Effective June 1, 2021, P.L. 2020, Chapter 128 (approved November 24, 2020) requires that all uniformed patrol officers be equipped with body worn cameras. In addition, under P.L. 2020, Chapter 142, the State appropriated \$58,000,000 for grants-in-aid to support the statewide body worn camera program. Therefore, we are supplying a survey for all law enforcement agencies to complete, as an initial step in gathering data to guide the implementation of the program.
