RIGHT TO APPEAL: Please be advised pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.f that if your request for access to a government record has been denied in whole or in part or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the municipality to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
