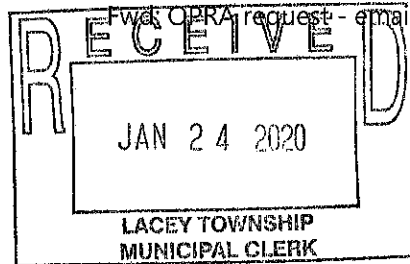

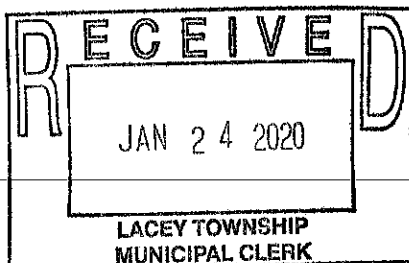

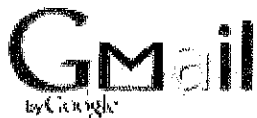

Good Afternoon,

After long discussion's with the operation and administrative staff of Lanoka Harbor EMS we have decided to reinstate Scott Stenerson effective 1/25/2020. Mr. Stenerson will be placed on a 12 month probationary period.
