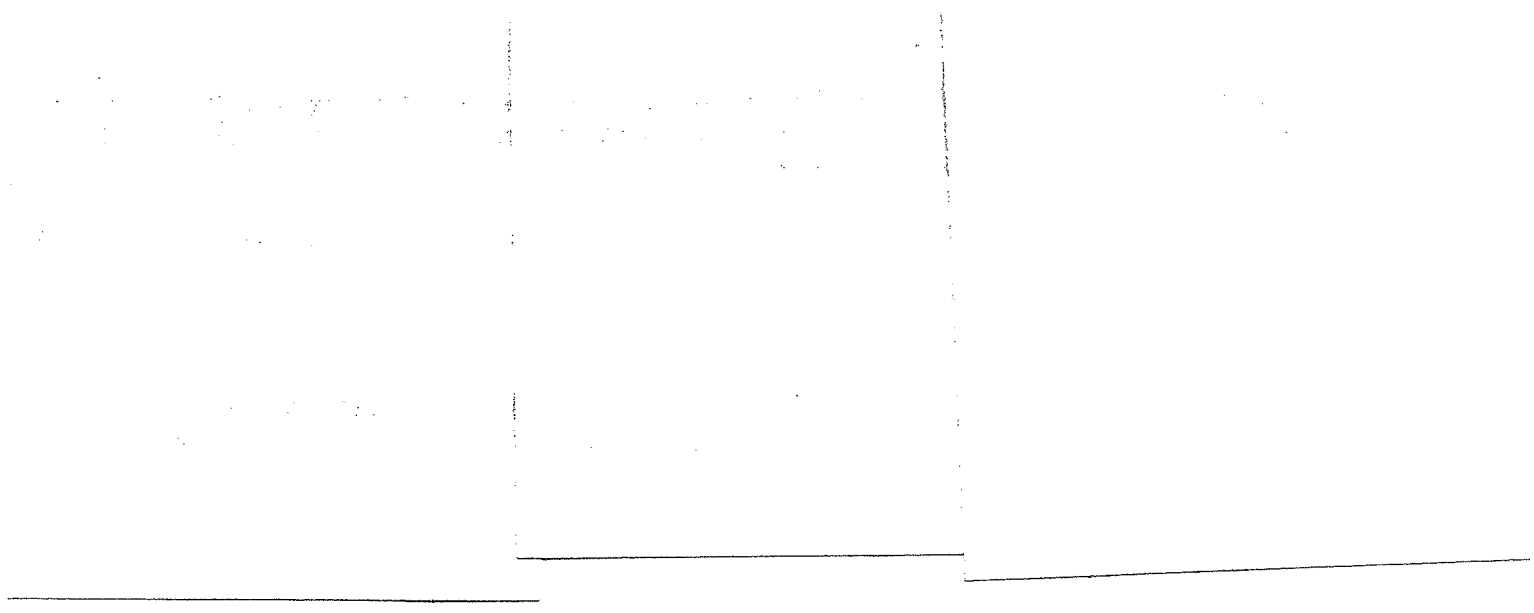

I think we are going to start with the document that was created by Cheryl and then build on it as time goes on. This document is a comparable that was composed after speaking with multiple stakeholders who will be involved in this project. As you might be aware the microgrid is still under review. The phase that we are in now is sort of phase 2 of the feasibility to see if this project can happen based on partners, logistics, and economics. Some of the questions being asked can't be answered until we complete phase 2 of the feasibility study. We were expecting to have a more comprehensive shareable document for all at this time, however things were delayed, because we allowed the community most impacted to continue their questions with stakeholders and this has held up the process a little.
