Good afternoon, Mr. Minus-Vincent,

As a follow-up from today's conversation, I spoke with Ashleigh, our Camden City health liaison, who stated at this time, we are close to an outbreak. Still, it is not confirmed until we complete additional contact tracing. We have seven positive cases and six close contacts with symptoms awaiting results. This does not include our student count. Due to coverage amongst our leadership team, teachers, and support staff and due to the number of pending cases, we will go virtual until June 1, 2022, effective tomorrow. All scholars will go home with their computer devices in addition to food distribution logistics today.

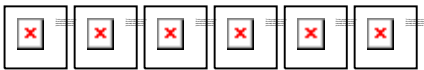

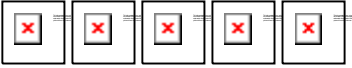

The New Jersey Primary Election is being held on Tuesday, June 7, 2022. As the State has seen a recent increase in COVID-19 transmission, and due to the increased number of individuals entering school facilities used to vote during school hours, those local education agency (LEA) with school facilities that are polling locations are encouraged to explore the option of virtual or remote instruction within the parameters of N.J.S.A. 18A:7f-9. If the statutory requirements are met, the virtual or remote instructional day will count toward the 180- day requirement for those school facilities that are being used as polling locations.

LEAs that intend to use a virtual or remote instruction day on June 7, 2022 must notify my office, and provide the name(s) of each school facility that will be using virtual or remote instruction by Monday, June 6, 2022.

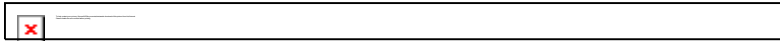

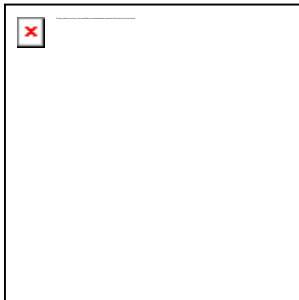

If the statutory requirements are met, the virtual or remote instructional day will count toward the 180- day requirement for those school facilities that are being used as polling locations.
