Chiefs,

I totally agree. Unfortunately, we're on pace to exceed last year's overdose deaths and as you can see a significant number of **OD deaths and naloxone deployments** occur within your respective AOR (see the attached). Regardless of which recovery specialist group your department chooses to use, it's critical to call them as soon as possible at the incident of arrest and even those that receive naloxone. Some are receiving multiple naloxone deployments which ties your officers up and prevents them from doing crime prevention and other enforcement related work. Most, if not all, recovery specialists will respond to your department or scene between 20 and 35 mins after being contacted. As you all know, these folks are recovering addicts themselves and are very successful in convincing at-risk people to accept treatment. I also believe for this to work effectively, it needs to be mandated in some form within your respective department. In addition to the still maps, I've also attached a google earth map (once the google map opens, move the cursor to the US and NJ) which will show you the exact address for each event. Many received naloxone and several days later same died from an OD.

Gents,

Did a good story with nj.com on the "Cuffs to Beds" opioids diversion program earlier this week. We named your towns, among several others, that will be participating in the program. Per the attached "heat" maps, the Asbury/Neptune and Long Branch areas have suffered from higher statistics of fatal overdose rates over the past two years. As we have seen in Howell, Belmar and Hazlet, a robust use of a recovery specialist program can put a big dent in these statistics, while also saving you valuable police response resources.

It's truly a simple program – when an officer in your department either: (1) revives an overdose with Narcan or (2) arrests an individual for a small, low-level crime (think narcotics possession, shoplifting, minor burglary, DP), you need only *call a recovery specialist at the point of revival from Narcan or arrest*. Recovery specialists work in mobile fashion, will come out to your department, and are successful in convincing these at-risk people to accept treatment. From there, they (not your departments) obtain a clinical assessment and find that person a treatment facility to best treat their level of addiction. As for charges, we separately assess whether that person can and should have their charges diverted or not. If it's an indictable, then we'll work with you in that regard. If it's a municipal court matter, you can make that determination with your municipal prosecutors. Regardless of charges being diverted, it *makes good sense to utilize the recovery specialists at the point of arrest or revival*.

Chiefs Hunt and Kelso have had preliminary conversations with John Brogan at Lifeline for this program; Chief Roebuck is leaning towards Howell's group with CFC Loud and Clear. Whatever you decide, but I want to get your towns up and running ASAP. I need your help in getting this to the point of muscle memory for your officers. There's nothing magical or difficult about it. TO make it work, I just need you to make it a strategic priority in your towns. As Prosecutor, I'm calling it a strategic priority for this entire county, and I need your towns to come online considering the high fatal overdose rates in your jurisdictions. By way of example, Belmar has done this for the past 2 years and successfully steered nearly 100 people towards treatment through this process. They have yet to have a single re-arrest. As a collateral benefit, their Narcan sprays have fallen during this period too.

When can we start? Chief McCabe – feel free to supplement where necessary. Thank you for the prompt attention to this request.

Manalapan: began Cuffs to Beds Oct. 1 – to date, utilized recovery specialists 4x with a 75% success rate in convincing at-risk individual (ARI) to accept some level of treatment. Use Lifeline as primary contact; Seabrook as secondary contact. Since rollout, they have had single incident of re-overdose of a person who refused treatment, and he refused again. I forgot to give these stats to Alex.

As for the other towns, they did not readily have statistics available but they are onboard and either are or will be up and running shortly.

Good Morning Director Baum:

Thank you for reaching out to me over the holidays. It was a pleasure meeting you at COA in June. I would love the opportunity to come to DC and give you a full briefing on the success we have found in NJ combatting the this terrible epidemic. After my service in the United States Marine Corps I came home stateside and struggled tremendously with alcohol. It then led to other substances and after an injury I ended up with opiates. After overdosing 4 times in 2010 I attempted suicide. This was that hopelessness that so many of our children are experiencing today. Being led into a long-term program that focused on the disciplines of recovery and a complete "re-booting" of the computer so to speak, my life has transformed and by the Grace of a loving creator we are now showing individuals the same way of life through various programs. I will attach several links so you can see the evolution to where we are at today. The advisory team that we are currently working with is Prosecutor Joseph Coronato (Ocean County), Sheriff Shaun Golden (Monmouth County Sheriff), Prosecutor Chris Grammiccioni (Monmouth County Prosecutor), Fmr. Governor Jim McGreevy, Major Juan Colon (NJ State Police Drug Monitoring Initiative), Director Lenny Ward (NJ State Parole Board), Senator Declan O'scanlon (Monmouth County), Kelly Chiarello (Clinical Program Manager-Hackensack Meridian Health). As you can see with this diverse, but like minded team, we have been able to use our collective experiences to strategize and execute a war on opioids and all substance use related issues. Last year we were able to execute and serve individuals suffering from the moment of crisis (Overdose, incarcerated due to substance use related issues, and or re-entering into society) into long-term recovery. The numbers are overwhelming, as you know, and cost to our hospitals, law enforcement, and society are an unaffordable amount of money, and as a result individuals are dying at rapid rates. The Fentanyl analogs are changing everyday (Major Juan Colon-DMI), and we have to stay ahead of the curve in order to make a difference. Last year we have served and are tracking over 789 people from Ocean and Monmouth County alone. This Saves our Hospital systems approximately \$18 million a year and the legal system we are working on calculating now. Rutgers University has been doing a case study for 6 months following individuals that are successful through these programs so we can hopefully make this a national

model. We have had success in Williamson County Texas as well as Maine and Ohio.

There was a saying on the Statue of Liberty that said "bring us your wretched refuge". That is how we have attacked this issue in NJ. I do have to add that none of this would have been possible without the help of Governor Chris Christie and Senator Corey Booker. These men have guided us and broken down barriers so that people that have been stigmatized and forgotten about can now receive real help and find hope in a place where they have lost all. I look forward to meeting with you soon.
