Dear Mr. Feldman,

The NJ State Library received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on August 5, 2025. The official Records Custodian, Stephanie Kowalski, received your OPRA request on August 5, 2025. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is August 14, 2025.

The following records are being provided in their entirety and are responsive to your request.

1. Complete list of employees and their salaries

These records are being transmitted to you via email, as per your request. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is \$0.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days, or requested time extension, required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the New Jersey State Library to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
