Job Summary

The Linden Housing Authority is seeking a reliable and skilled Part-Time Maintenance Technician to join our team. This individual will work under the supervision of the Maintenance Supervisor or Property Manager and will play an important role in ensuring that our apartments, offices, and common areas remain safe, clean, and well-maintained for residents.

Key Responsibilities:

- Perform general maintenance and repairs in apartments and facilities, including carpentry, electrical, plumbing, and painting.
- Troubleshoot and repair issues such as electrical outlets, switches, light fixtures, leaky faucets, clogged drains, toilets, sinks, and minor carpentry work.
- Assist with apartment inspections, routine service requests, and preventive maintenance.
- Maintain grounds by picking up litter, sweeping walkways, raking leaves, and assisting with snow removal when necessary.
- Operate and maintain approved hand tools, power tools, and light mechanical equipment.
- Support skilled technicians on larger repair projects.

- Ensure compliance with safety standards and proper use of personal protective equipment.

Qualifications:
