

Resignation/Retirement Agreement

Catherine Mitchell hereby RESIGNS her position as a Police Officer with the Township of Clark Police Department subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1) The resignation shall take effect September 1, 2002
- 2) All pending administrative disciplinary charges against Catherine Mitchell will be dismissed. The charges presently pending are scheduled for hearing on August 15, 2002. To effectuate this agreement, Catherine Mitchell requests an adjournment of these matters until September 1, 2002 and thereby waives the 30-day rule on all charges pending.
- 3) Catherine Mitchell is considered by the Township of Clark to have been on an approved leave of absence up to September 1, 2002.
- 4) Catherine Mitchell waives any claim against the Township of Clark for attorney fees in connection with the charges listed above.
- 5) The Township of Clark recognizes that Catherine Mitchell has applied for disability retirement benefits pursuant to N.J.S.A. 43:16A-7 and has no objection to being awarded any disability benefits for which she qualifies or has already qualified and, if she qualifies, Township of Clark records or Department of Personnel records are to be amended to state "retirement in good standing."
- 6) This agreement does not affect any aspect of Catherine Mitchell's pending compensation claim petition.
- 7) This agreement will not take effect until signed by Catherine Mitchell and a representative of the Township as listed below. [END]
