On June 4, 2023 I stood on an home office chair with wheels. It gave out and I hit my head on the corner of a metal book shelf.

I was on speaker phone with a friend who was saying did I lose you are you muted, which prompted my husband to come check. I remember him screaming oh my god Stacey what do I do you are going to die. I had punctured an artery. Lots of blood.

I said call 911 call my neighbor my mom and get me a towel They had to call back 911 2 times bc it was bad. 20 minutes later a private company arrive from the Hasidic community. They were amazing!!

No one not a police officer not EMS no one came from Toms River.

My injury was so bad that I was transported as a trauma patient with a brain bleed to RWJ in New Brunswick in which I am still a patient of. If it weren't for the private company I would have died.

So hands down we need more EMS and better response time.
