INVESTIGATOR'S LOG

Wednesday, November 21, 2018:

1624 hrs: Ptl. Maloney and I were notified, while off duty by Sgt. Hillyer, of a fatal crash that occurred in Clifton. He ordered us to respond to headquarters to investigate this incident.

1715 hrs: I met with Ptl. Maloney at headquarters and gathered all necessary investigative equipment.

1727 hrs: I spoke with Detective Kevin Conroy from the Passaic County Prosecutors Office, who was also notified of the crash and will be responding to the scene with us.

1755 hrs: Ptl. Maloney and I arrived on scene and met with Det. Conroy. We spoke with Sgt. Lawson who had a crash scene set up with Main Ave. being closed between W. 3rd St. and W. 2nd St. Sgt. Lawson stated a motorcycle being operated by Joshua Montan collided with a vehicle being operated by a female driver as she was entering Main Ave. from the Corrado's shopping center (1578 Main Ave.). He further stated Mr. Montan initiated a pursuit and was eluding Sgt. Droubi prior to the crash occurring. Mr. Montan was taken to St. Joseph's Hospital and was subsequently pronounced deceased. Sgt. Droubi was also taken to the hospital for an unspecified reason. The driver of the vehicle, Mrs. Ference, was currently still on scene waiting in her husband's vehicle in a parking lot off of W. 3rd St. Sgt. Droubi subsequently completed an investigative report detailing the facts of this incident.

1800 hrs: Det. Conroy and I spoke with Mrs. Ference, who stated she was leaving the Corrado's to go home and was making a left turn onto Main Ave. when a motorcycle crashed into her car. She further stated she was not injured in this crash. Mr. Ference did not show any signs of impairment due to alcohol or drugs. She agreed to respond to Clifton Police headquarters later in the evening to complete a video statement and was released from the scene.

Det. Conroy stated he contacted the Passaic County Sheriffs Department CSI Unit and they will respond to photograph the crash scene.

1813 hrs: Ptl. Maloney and I set up the laser to map the crash scene.

Sgt. Hillyer spoke with Mr. Emad Elagmi, who works at GNC in the Corrado's shopping center. He completed a signed statement stating he was in his vehicle heading north on Main Ave. by the Chase bank (1459 Main Ave). He observed a motorcycle traveling north on Main Ave. at a high speed with two police cars following approximately 500 ft. behind. Mr. Elagmi did observe the motorcycle drive on the right sidewalk to pass traffic. He did not witness the crash.

1853 hrs: Mapping was completed.

1855 hrs: I advised dispatch to have a city tower respond to the scene to remove both vehicles from the roadway. Inside storage was requested.

1859 hrs: Ptl. Maloney took custody of a white 1Storm helmet and placed it in a large brown paper evidence bag.

1956 hrs: Carol Ferencé arrived at headquarters and Det. Conroy and I conducted an interview in the Detective Division interview room. During the interview Mrs. Ference stated the following: At approximately 4:00 pm on November 21, 2018, she left her residence on Park Slope to go to Corrado's. She purchased three yams and exited the store. Mrs. Ference entered her car and proceeded to the exit at Main Ave. intending to head back home. She looked both ways and seeing it was clear, made a left onto Main Ave. While in the roadway, she heard a motorcycle engine revving and she knew it was a motorcycle due to past motorcycle riding experience. Mrs. Ference then observed a motorcycle traveling north passing a vehicle that was also traveling north. The motorcycle was in the southbound lane while traveling north and collided with the Mrs. Ferences vehicle. The motorcycle rider came through the passenger side area of her front windshield. She came to a stop and had to be helped out of her vehicle by police who arrived on scene shortly after the crash. When asked if she observed the no left turn sign on Main Ave. by the exit Mrs. Ference stated she usually makes a left from this exit because she was told by someone that the no turn signs are not a city ordinance and not enforceable. Mrs. Ference wears glasses that correct her vision 20/20. She was not under the influence of alcohol or drugs at the time of the crash. The interview was completed at 2013 hrs. and Mrs. Ference left Clifton Police headquarters.

2045 hrs: Ptl. Maloney secured the helmet in the locked Traffic Division office.

Friday, November 23, 2018:

0700 hrs: I spoke with Lt. Hasselberger about the no left turn sign posted at the exit of Corrado's on Main Ave. He stated he would look into it to see if there is an ordinance covering it.

0714 hrs: I faxed the NJTR-1 to the NJDOT Fatal Unit

0717 hrs: I faxed the NJTR-1 to the NJ MVC Fatal Unit

0728 hrs: Det. Petrillo e-mailed me the dispatch recording of the pursuit.

Ptl. Bais canvassed the area of Main Ave. and spoke with Mr. Tom Hawrylko who stated he witnessed a motorcycle driving on the sidewalk that was eluding police on November 21st. Ptl. Bais forwarded this information to Ptl. Maloney and myself to obtain a statement in the future. Ptl. Bais additionally spoke with an attendant at the Delta gas station (1196 Main Ave.) who might have cameras facing Main Ave. Ptl. Bais also forwarded this information to Ptl. Maloney and me.

Monday, November 26, 2018:

1000 hrs: Ptl. Maloney and I met with Det. Wefing and Det. McConnell at Telep Towing (574 Van Houten Ave.) to complete the inspection on both vehicles. Ptl. Maloney brought the helmet to inspect also. The Helmet is a 1Storm XP-14A DOT certified helmet (FMVSS No. 218). There are scrape marks on the front of the helmet and visor. Ptl. Maloney took possession the helmet where he subsequently placed it into Clifton Police property.

1112 hrs: The inspections were completed (see Post Crash Vehicle Inspection Reports for further). Det. Wefing will notify Mr. Montan's family that the motorcycle is released.

1128 hrs: Ptl. Maloney, Det. Wefing, Det. McConnell and I arrived at 1639 Main Ave. (East Railway Discounts) to see if the cameras on the building captured the crash. I spoke with manager Abdalla Mohd who reviewed video footage during the evening of the crash. The time on the cameras were still an hour ahead and were not adjusted after day light saving time ended. His camera is north of the crash site

on the Main Ave. side of the building by W. 1st St. and is pointed south. While reviewing the footage I could see vehicle 1 exiting the Corrado's lot and making a left turn onto Main Ave. at approximately 05:08:19. At the same time I observed vehicle 2 traveling north in the south bound lane passing two vehicles in the northbound lane. As vehicle 1 was almost fully into the southbound lane, she was struck by vehicle 2, which collided with the front, passenger area of vehicle 1 at 05:08:22. Vehicle 1 comes to a complete stop as vehicle 2 is thrown over vehicle 1. Vehicle 2 lands north of vehicle 1 in the southbound lane of Main Ave. At the time of impact I could see what appeared to be driver 2 come to a stop on the front area of vehicle 1. At the time of impact I was also able to see two police cars with their emergency lights activated, traveling north on Main Ave. in the area of the Garden State Parkway overpass. Vehicle 1 then rolls forward before coming to a stop at the southbound curb. The footage was placed onto a thumb drive to later place on Pro Phoenix.

1147 hrs: Ptl. Maloney, Det. Wefing, Det. McConnell and I arrived at the Passaic Valley Water Commission (1525 Main Ave.) to review any footage captured from the cameras on the front area of the building. Supervisor Jeffrey Baig was unable to retrieve the video at this time. Det. Wefing will follow up at a later date to obtain the video.

1200 hrs: At headquarters Ptl. Maloney took the holds off of both vehicles.

1305 hrs: Ptl. Maloney notified Mr. Ference that the hold is off of his wife's vehicle. I placed the vehicle inspection photographs into evidence on Pro Phoenix.

1324 hrs: Ptl. Maloney and I responded to the Delta gas station (1196 Main Ave.). Employee Ed Salman was able to work the video system but was unable to retrieve any past video for 11/21/18. He stated the system might not go back that far. He was provided with my number and will give it to his boss to contact us if the video was still available.

1346 hrs: Ptl. Maloney and I responded to the Walgreens (1138 Main Ave.) to check video. Assistant Manager Jonathan Rodriguez had us review the video and gave us a copy of it on our thumb drive.

1415 hrs: Back at headquarters I reviewed the video from Walgreens and the copy we were provided was of the wrong month.

Wednesday, November 28, 2018:

1044 hrs: Ptl. Maloney and I responded back to the Walgreens and Mr. Rodriguez was not in.

1055 hrs: Ptl. Maloney and I responded to the Delta gas station and the owner was not currently in.

1241 hrs: I sent an e-mail to Clifton EMS Chief D'Amore-Bottaro requesting all fire department reports.

Thursday, November 29, 2018:

0905 hrs: I attached the dispatch recording to this case in Pro Phoenix.

1356 hrs: Ptl. Maloney and I responded back to the Walgreens (1138 Main Ave.) and were provided with a good video from Assistant Manager Jonathan Rodriguez. The first video camera is pointing towards Main Ave. and the second camera is facing the dumpster area but captures part of Clifton Ave. The first video shows a motorcycle enter the Walgreens lot at 16:09:14 from Main Ave. A Clifton Police marked patrol unit is following behind with the emergency lights activated. They head towards the back of the parking lot and go out of frame. The second camera shows a motorcycle heading west on Clifton Ave. at 16:09:29, in the eastbound lane towards Main Ave. A Clifton Police marked patrol unit is still following behind with the emergency lights activated before going out of frame. The video was placed onto a thumb drive.

1822 hrs: I attached the video from Walgreens to Pro Phoenix.

Friday, November 30, 2018:

0919 hrs: Chief Clifton EMS Chief D'Amore-Bottaro e-mailed me a notification that the fire department reports are ready for pick up. I subsequently responded to fire headquarters and retrieved these reports.

Tuesday, December 4, 2018:

1022 hrs: I received a disc containing the crash scene and autopsy photographs from Passaic County Sheriff's Department Detective Krzysik. I downloaded these photographs to Pro Phoenix as evidence. I also received his supplemental reports that I attached to my investigators report.

Thursday, December 13, 2018:

1048 hrs: Ptl. Maloney went to speak with Tom Hawrylko at his office at 1288 Main Ave. Mr. Tom Hawrylko stated on 11/21/18 at approximately 1600 hrs. ~~he was in his office and was walking to the front area~~ close to Main Ave. He heard an engine roar that came from his left and, as he exited the front door, he observed a motorcycle traveling northbound on the sidewalk. He continued to observe this motorcycle travel on the side walk through all intersections up to and including Piaget Ave. Mr. Hawrylko further stated it was obvious the motorcycle driver was attempting to elude the police. Mr. Hawrylko lost sight of the motorcycle as it continued north on Main Ave. and he never witnessed the crash. Mr. Hawrylko completed a signed statement detailing what he observed.

Thursday, January 3, 2019:

0700 hrs: I was informed by Lt. Hasselberger that the signs at the exit of the Corrado's shopping center on Main Ave., that indicate that a no left turn is allowed, are covered by Clifton City Ordinance 439-46.

1136 hrs: I spoke with Det. Wefing and advised him of the information I received about the no turn sign. I will be issuing a summons to Mrs. Ference for the turning violation.

Friday, January 4, 2018:

1035 hrs: I prepared summons CL667937 for a violation of Clifton City Ordinance 439-46 with the plaintiff being Carol Ference.

1132 hrs: I responded to [REDACTED] in an attempt to serve Mrs. Ference with the summons but no one was home.

1436 hrs: I responded back to [REDACTED] and served Mrs. Ference with the summons. She was advised of the mandatory court date of 1/14/19.

CRASH ANALYSIS

Roadway:

Main Ave. is a county roadway (County Route 601) and a primary thoroughfare connecting Passaic, NJ to Paterson, NJ. It has two lanes, one running northbound and one running southbound. The lanes are divided by a double yellow line. The roadway is paved in asphalt and is in new condition.

Crash Event:

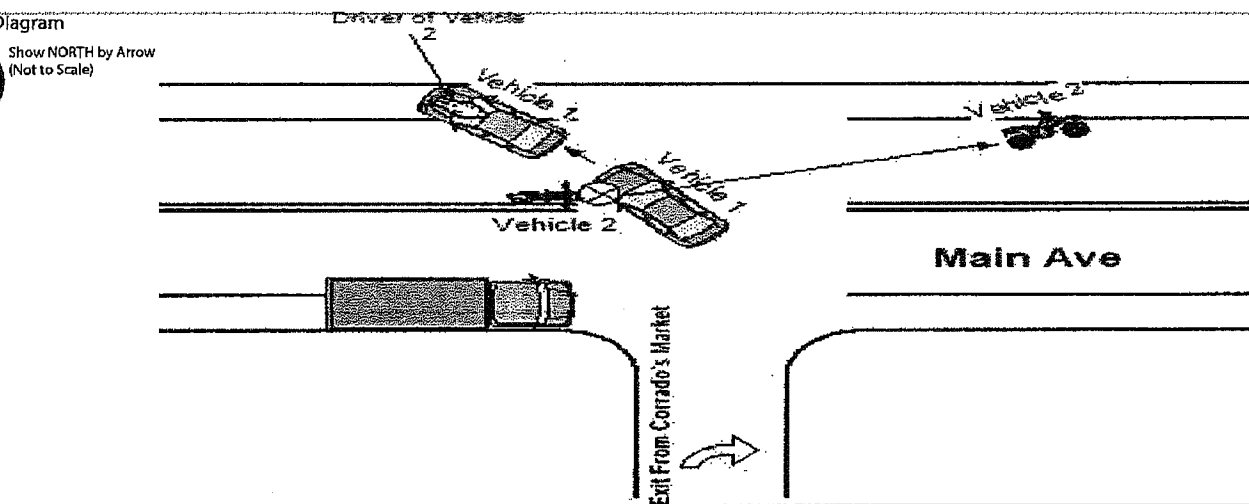
Based off of witness statements, video surveillance and police reports, the crash occurred in the following manner:

Mr. Montan was operating vehicle 2 and was traveling north on Main Ave. in the southbound lane. He was passing vehicles that were traveling in the northbound lane. Vehicle 1, operated by Carol Ference, exited the Corrado's Shopping Center and started to make a left onto Southbound Main Ave. It should be noted there was a no left turn sign posted on Main Ave. across the street from the exit Mrs. Ference was utilizing. As her vehicle entered the southbound lane she was struck by Mr. Montan. This caused vehicle 2 to be launched over vehicle 1, before coming to a rest just north of the crash site and Mr. Montan to come off of vehicle 2 where he continued forward, crashing into and through the windshield of vehicle 1. Vehicle 1 slowly rolled forward before coming to a stop at a curb in the southbound lane of Main Ave. Mr. Montan showed no evidence of breaking or slowing prior to the crash. Mrs. Ference did not see vehicle 2 prior to the crash due to vehicle 2 being obstructed by the vehicle's that were traveling north in the northbound lane of Main Ave. At the time of the crash event, Sgt. Droubi was driving north on Main Ave. with his lights & siren activated and was in the area of the Garden State Parkway. Mr. Montan was actively eluding Sgt. Droubi at the time of the crash.

145. Crash Description/Narrative

Driver of Vehicle 1 stated she was stopped at the exit for Main Ave, from the Carrado's Market. She stated she looked both ways and did not see any vehicles coming, at which point she attempted to make a left turn onto Main Ave. Driver of Vehicle 1 stated as she was turning left onto Main Ave, Vehicle 2 struck Vehicle 1.

Driver of Vehicle 2 was unconscious, had labored breathing, and was bleeding from his face. He was transported to St. Joseph's Hospital in Paterson by Fire Department Personnel on scene (E2, LD3, EMS2, ALS258 Run# 18-10997). Vehicle 1 and Vehicle 2 were both disabled and were towed by Telep Towing. No valuables were left inside of Vehicle 1. Telep Towing received their copy of the tow cards. The other copies of the tow cards were placed in the records bin to be mailed out to the registered owners of Vehicle 1 and Vehicle 2. See Traffic report for further detail.
