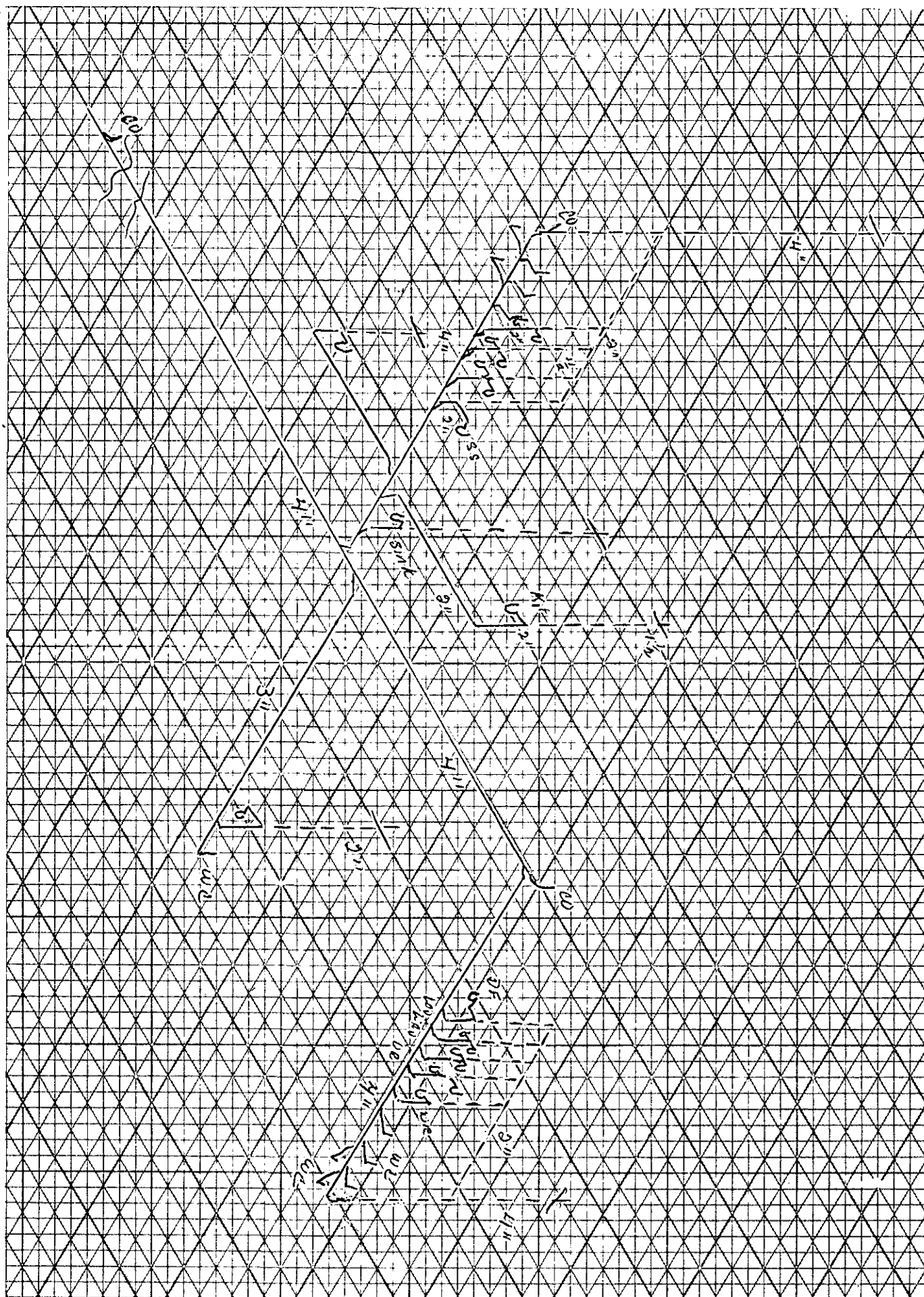

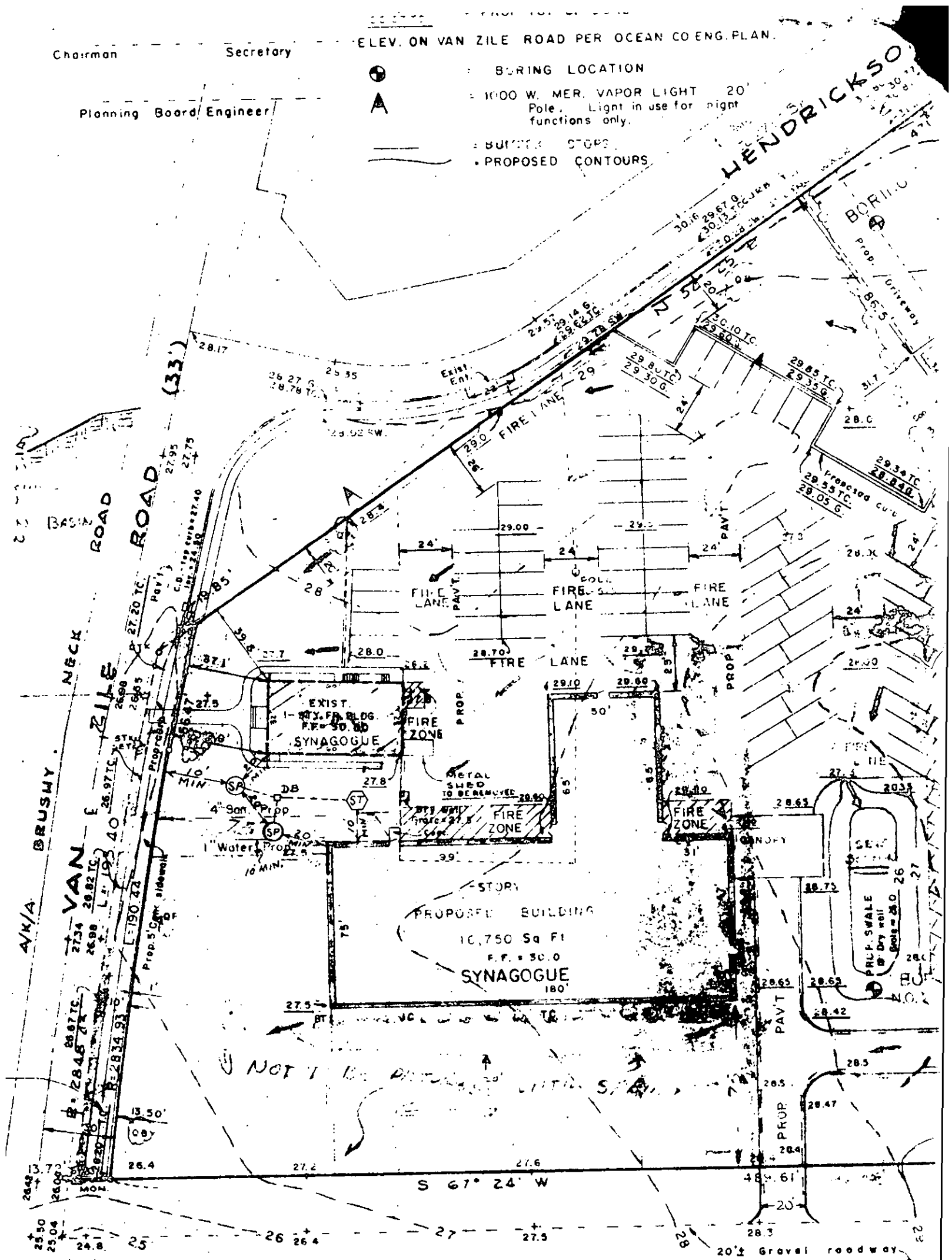


BORING LOCATION
