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Reminder Regarding Services for Houses of Worship

*As of now, State regulation of 50-person maximum
and social distancing requirements during services
remains in effect*

NEW BRUNSWICK (March 20, 2020) – With the State having enacted strict policies limiting the size of public gatherings in response to the COVID-19 outbreak, all houses of worship in The City are reminded they too are bound by these restrictions.

For those religious organizations and faith-based groups that may be continuing to hold weekend services, please remember to limit the size of the gathering to no more than 50 participants. Please also remember to adhere to the social distancing requirements by maintaining a safe distance of at least 6 feet between one another.

For those religious and faith-based groups who can offer streaming services via web or social media sites, you are encouraged to make that option available and accessible to your congregations.

Many religious and faith-based organizations throughout the state have already suspended in-person worshipping until further notice due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
