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City Office of Emergency Management Accepting Donations of Personal Protective Equipment

*Masks, gloves and other surplus PPE being collected
and distributed to facilities to assist in COVID-19
treatment*

NEW BRUNSWICK, NJ (April 3, 2020) – The Office of Emergency Management of the City of New Brunswick is currently collecting donations of personal protective equipment (PPE) to be used in the fight against COVID-19.

The donation bin is located in the Main Lobby of Civic Square at 25 Kirkpatrick Street. Items can be delivered between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. After-hours donations can be made in the main lobby of the police department.

Specific PPE items that are being collected include:

Masks

Gloves

Goggles and face shields and other eye protection

Surgical masks and gowns

Disinfecting wipes

All items must be new or in new condition and in its original packaging.

There is no minimum quantity of any item being collected.
