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State Income Tax & Corporate Business Tax Filing Deadlines Extended to July 15

*Postponed from April 15 to allow NJ to focus efforts
on COVID-19 relief*

NEW BRUNSWICK, NJ (April 1, 2020) - Governor Phil Murphy today announced an extension of the State tax filing deadline as well as the State budget timetable.

Citing hardships, financial strain and disruptions caused by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the Governor announced he has reached an agreement with the leadership of the Legislature that the state income tax filing deadline and the corporation business tax filing deadline will be extended from April 15 to July 15.

Also, and as part of the government effort that is going into fighting COVID-19, the state fiscal year would be extended to September 30 to allow the State representatives to focus fully on the COVID-19 crisis.
