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Daily 30-Minute Radio Show to Provide COVID-19 Information

*Mayor Jim Cahill to share information on pandemic
starting Monday at 11 a.m. on WCTC AM radio*

NEW BRUNSWICK, NJ (March 21, 2020) - A daily COVID-19-related program will debut on WCTC radio (1450 AM) on Monday March 23. "The New Brunswick COVID-19 Report" will air weekdays at 11 a.m. and will feature Mayor Jim Cahill providing timely updates and information that is vital to residents, business owners and visitors to the City.

The program will update listeners with news and information regarding the COVID-19 emergency, share local information on vital City services and programs, and keep residents updated on changes to facility access policies, Citywide safety measures, and health-related news.
