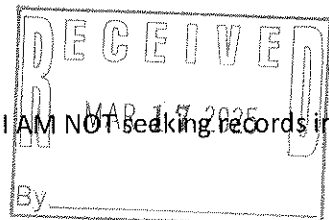

On Tuesday January 7, 2025 at 7:59pm I responded to Wawa (270 Greentree Road) for a report of a theft of service. Upon arrival I spoke with Galyna Kimachuk (Store Manager), who stated a subject came to the store for gas. After \$15.00 worth of gas was pumped into his vehicle, he advised the gas attendant he forgot his wallet. He advised the gas attendant he would return with his wallet to pay for the gas. Galyna stated she would contact police if the subject returned to pay for the gas.

Galyna stated the vehicle appeared to be a gray or silver 4 door BMW with possible NJ registration 751UPZ. An inquiry of that registration was found to be not on file. An inquiry of (NJ Z51UPZ) found a gray 2010 4 door BMW, registered to Sharif Cooper [REDACTED] Willingboro, NJ 08046). It is unknown if this is the vehicle involved in the incident.

I located a telephone number Sharif, but it was not in service. I then contacted Central Communications and requested to have the Willingboro Police Department respond to [REDACTED] and attempt to make contact with Sharif. Central Communications advised Willingboro Police responded to the residence and determined Sharif is her ex-boyfriend, but she has not seen him in several years and confirmed does not reside there.

A short time later, the subject returned to the store and paid for the gas. There were no further issues. Galyna did not get the subjects information or vehicle registration.

Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] priority two, for the report of stolen medications.

Upon arrival, contact was made with the complainant/victim, identified as Theresa Zaborowski. Zaborowski advised that sometime early in the morning on today's date, her upstairs neighbor broke into her apartment, stole her medications, and replaced the stolen medication with fake medication. Furthermore, she advised that she is aware that her residence was broken into due to damage on the front door of her residence. She had no further evidence to substantiate that her upstairs neighbor broke into her residence.

Upon inspection of the front door of the residence, it was determined that the damage on the door is consistent with damage from the "hotel lock" being caught in the door when a subject closes the door. There were no obvious signs of forced entry into Zaborowski's residence. Zaborowski was advised that this report would be generated, documenting this incident, and to contact this agency if further assistance is required.

Zaborowski refused medical attention, and officers did not observe any mental health issues at this time.
