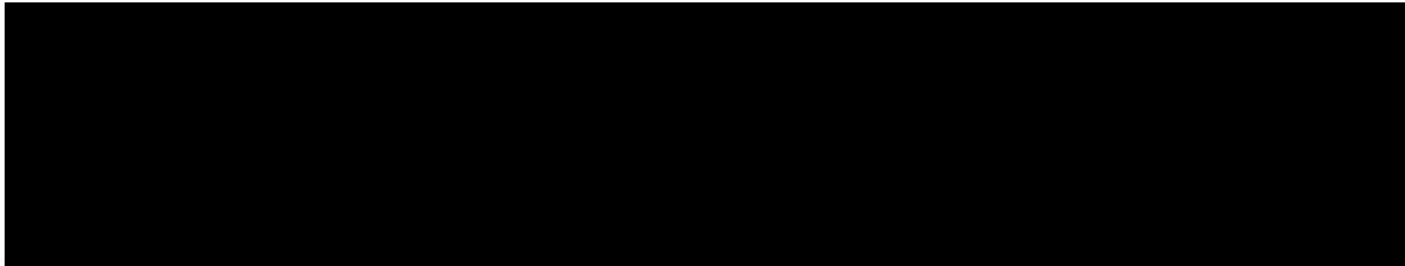
Tax Collector T. Beshada explained that she was in attendance at the meeting to discuss the Tax In Rem Foreclosure. [REDACTED]

Tax Collector T. Beshada explained that she and Receptionist Danielle LoCascio have been diligently working on trying to locate the correct mailing address for the foreclosures. She stated D. LoCascio had found some other addresses online that they mailed notices out to. T. Beshada stated that she is going to be more proactive with trying to locate the correct addresses for tax bills if bills get mailed back to the Township, to get to the appropriate mailing address. [REDACTED]

The Township Committee reviewed the letter from Township Resident Christina Gordon requesting her interest in the amount of \$14.77 be waived on her taxes. Ms. Gordon's letter stated she mailed her tax payment via the USPS on August 9th before she left on vacation, but the payment was never received at the municipal office, and the check was never cashed. When Ms. Gordon came in to pay in person after her vacation on September 11th, she had accumulated interest since the payment was made after the due date of September 1st.



The Committee members asked Tax Collector T. Beshada to respond to C. Gordon on the Township Committee's behalf explaining that it is a state statute that taxes cannot be refunded and include the online options that are available: print the tax bill online and that online bill pay is available.



The Township Committee asked for an update on the anticipated date of the tax sale. T. Beshada responded it may be the first part of December at this point; she must mail out a 50-day letter, advertise in the paper for four weeks, and prepare the notices. She stated that the tax sale notices normally go out in October, however with the tax conversion and still learning how to

use the new system, that it will be behind this year. She also expressed that the new company is not quick to respond to inquiries when she needs assistance. Next year will be better.
