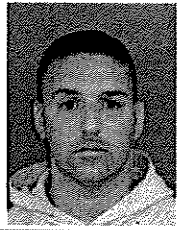

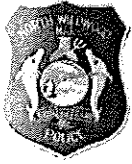

On the above date and time, I was on foot patrol in the area of Walnut and Olde New Jersey Avenue. At the time of the incident, I was standing at the intersection of Walnut and Olde New Jersey Avenues with Ofc. V. Deritis #267 and S/O 1 Travers #2047. As we were standing there, I observed the victim, walking away from the outside seating area of Exit 6. As turned the corner onto the 100 West block of Walnut Avenue, turned around a yelled "because my boyfriend is a piece of shit." At that moment he defendant, David Grogan ran through the outside dining area and jumped over the fence. He then ran up to , grabbed by the arm and threw to the ground.

Myself and Ofc. V. DeRitis #267 ran over to Grogan and attempted to take him into custody. When I grabbed Grogan's arm, he immediately tensed his arm and began to pull away from me. I placed Grogan on the ground face down while Ofc. DeRitis handcuffed him.

After placing Grogan in handcuffs, I picked him up and moved him away from a group or his friends who were surround myself and other officers on scene. as the situation calmed down, Grogan stated that he was a police lieutenant with the Deptford Police Department and the friends that he was with were also police officers. Ofc. J. Kopetsky #260 arrived on scene for transport, Grogan was seat belted into the rear seat of marked patrol car #206 and transported to the police station for processing.

Ofc. DeRitis attempted to speak to the victim, but was extremely lrate and refused to give a statement or sign domestic violence rights form. did sustain a small cut to hand, which was photographed and entered into digital media. Grogan was processed and later released on a summons. CCTV footage of the incident was obtained from Exit 6 and entered into the beast property management system as evidence by Sgt. B. Skill #259.

On the above date and time, I was foot patrol in front of the Exit 6 bar with Officer Demusz #268 and Officer Travers #2047. I noticed an adult now identified as yelling obscenities at an adult male. was outside of the Exit 6 bar and yelling towards an adult male now identified as David Grogan who was in the outside portion of the Exit 6 bar.

yelled, "tell my piece of shit boyfriend to come out here". At this point I noticed Grogan jump the fence of the outside patio portion of the Exit 6 bar. He then grabbed by arm and threw to the ground. At this point, Officer Demusz #268 and I ran towards Grogan and he was instructed several times to get on the ground.

As we came in contact with Grogan, he did not get on the ground and Officer Demusz #268 assisted him to the ground and I placed him in handcuffs. During this time, several individuals who were with Grogan and swarmed Officer Demusz #268 and I while we attempted to gain control of the situation.

Officer Demusz #268 escorted Grogan away from the area and I stayed with who was mostly uncooperative. I noticed had a laceration on hand as a result of Grogan pushing to the ground. Originally tried to say Grogan did not push and I pointed out cell phone which was still laying on the ground where fell. then retrieved cell phone.

I asked to show me hand so I could document injury and stated is not injured. I then informed I could see was bleeding from hand. At this point, stated had fallen earlier. I should note, hand had fresh blood and scrapped skin which would be consistent with being thrown to the ground by Grogan.

During my encounter with, referred to Groan as boyfriend on three separate occasions. Additionally, continuously stated Grogan was a police officer. On several occasions, I had to instruct to stay away from the vehicle where Grogan was placed. One individual claiming to also be an off duty police officer told to not provide any further information regarding personal information. At this point, walked away and refused to comment further or fill out a VINE form.

Officer Demusz #268 went to the North Wildwood Police Department where he processed Grogan. At approximately 01:38 hrs I was approached by two females who claimed they witnessed the incident between Grogan and. These individuals are now identified as Nicole Caballero and Devon Hoff.

Hoff stated she heard say, "If my boyfriend don't come out here, he's single". Hoff stated she then saw Grogan jump over the fence and push to the ground. Caballero also stated she saw Grogan push to the ground.
