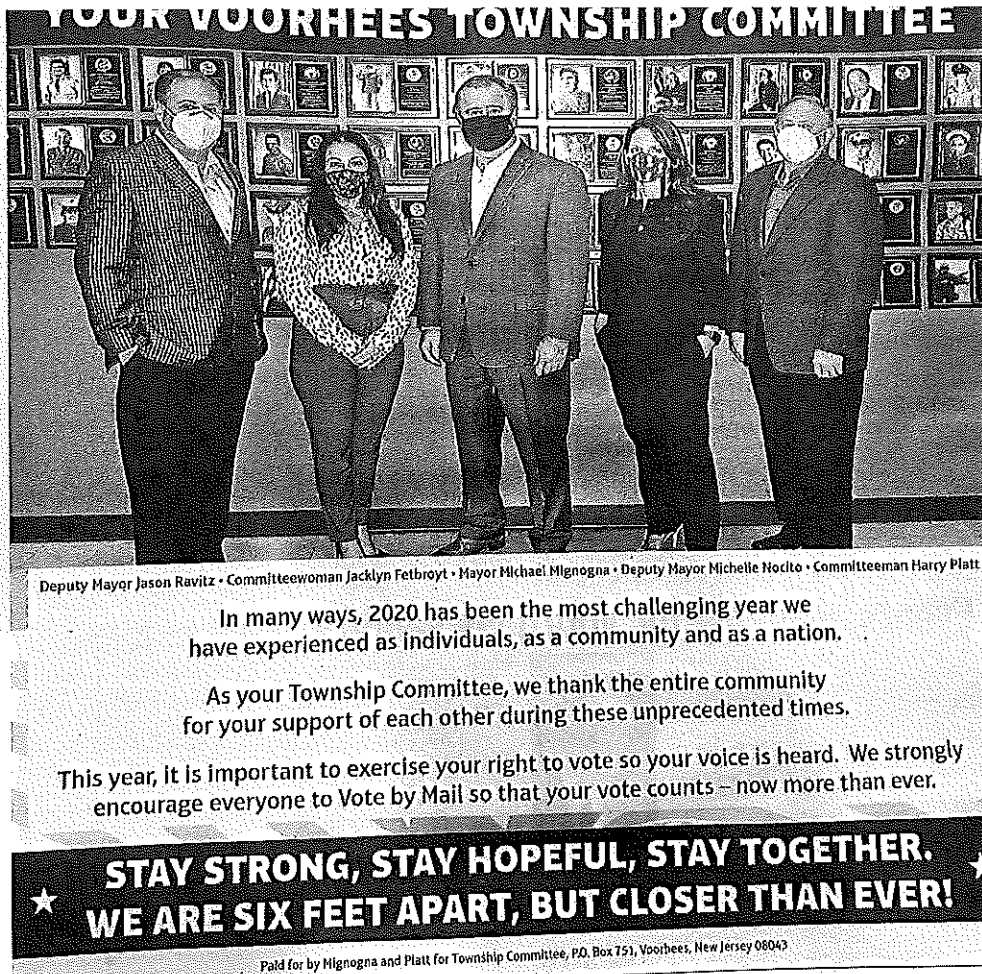

The past few months have been increasingly challenging. With my fellow Deputy Mayor Jason Ravitz losing his father to COVID, our Mayor Michael Mignogna waging his own fight against COVID, and our OEM coordinator Chief Bordi tracking an alarming trend in some of our long-term facilities, we have been slammed with the heavy and helpless feelings that this virus delivered with its unwelcome arrival.

I cannot even begin to articulate the extreme frustration and disappointment that I have right now regarding the lack of support and advocacy for the staff and residents in our 14 long-term care facilities here in Voorhees and countless others across NJ. However, this is not an issue that started with COVID. There has been a very low bar for oversight in many of these facilities and we should all be concerned about proper inspections and procedural guidelines. This is not to say that there are not facilities and employees out there who work tirelessly to keep our senior population safe and healthy while providing them the much-needed companionship they deserve. What I am addressing here and what needs attention is those who do not. What I am addressing is a system that allows these things to exist. What I am addressing is a disregard and ignorance that some have toward our elderly population.

Many of these residents cannot speak for themselves and right now their families cannot enter these facilities to advocate for them. Imagine being in a position where your parents or grandparents are isolated, afraid and you cannot visit them or advocate for them. It is up to those of us who can, to advocate for those who cannot. You think you feel trapped right now in your house? How do you think they feel? These are the people that fought for our country, our right to vote, our right to bear arms, our freedom of choice and so many other issues that the rest of have the luxury of being able to debate with one another. We have this luxury because they represent ALL of us. They are Democrats and Republicans. They are men and women. They are mothers and fathers. They are human beings and right now, we are failing some of them.

I will NOT sit idle and allow this to happen without a fight. After listening to our Chief continually follow-up on the initial red flags and request additional oversight and help, and me waving my arms wildly and literally shouting for attention to anyone who would listen and to several who wouldn't, I finally feel like we are being heard. But this is just the beginning. We have so much work ahead of us. But just for this moment, I am grateful to Camden County and the Board of Freeholders as well as Congressman Norcross's office and Senator Booker's office for stepping in and helping us get the much needed attention from the State of NJ that we so desperately need right now.

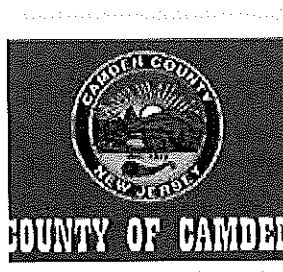

Governor Murphy has issued Executive Order 130 which allows for municipalities to extend the grace period for collection of second quarter property taxes due May 1, 2020, through June 1, 2020. The Voorhees Township Committee has considered and adopted Resolution 113-20 to allow for the extended grace period through June 1, 2020, for Voorhees Township taxpayers. Please be advised that this is an extension of the grace period only. Payment must be received by end of business on June 1, 2020, to avoid interest. 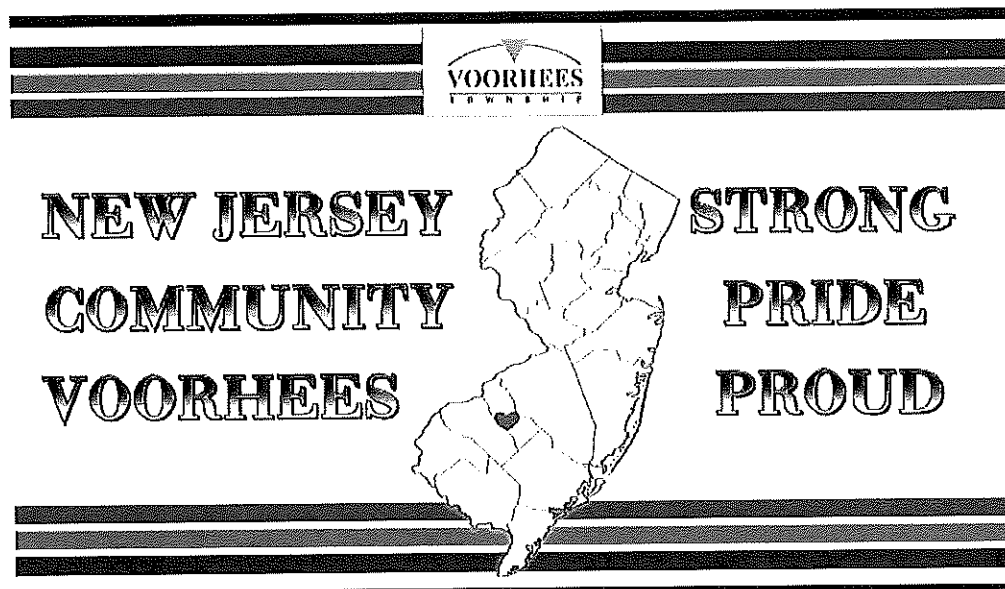

Just got off a conference call with Mayors Association, representatives from Congressman Norcross' office and Freeholder Director Cappelli. There is a new testing site at Camden County College in a partnership between the County and Jefferson University. County is pleased that the test results at that site seem to be coming back within 1 to 2 days.

It appears that the percentage growth of new cases is plateauing. Yesterday's increase was 6%, a total lower than the norm. In addition, only 15% of those being tested are resulting in positive results which is likewise a decline. Unfortunately, there were 10 deaths yesterday, mostly from Long Term Care Facilities. The County is inspecting all Long Term Care Facilities in the County and hopes to have that task completed by end of this week.

Additionally, Governor Murphy announced he will be extending the closure of NJ public schools through May 15th.

We continue to climb this mountain together. Stay healthy. Stay hopeful. Stay together.

Good afternoon Voorhees. It's your Deputy Mayor Michelle Nocito. I wanted to bring you another update on COVID-19 cases here in Voorhees and in Camden County. We also wanted to bring another update on our Mayor and his continued fight with this virus.

In Camden County, we have 1,478 positive cases reported as of April 14th. The county reported 95 new cases with 6 of those new cases coming from Voorhees, bringing our total to 111 cases. Unfortunately, we do have to report that to date, we have lost 4 Voorhees residents in COVID-related deaths and we extend our

On April 14th, Governor Murphy signed into law legislation extending protections of the Family Leave Act, allowing for up to 12 weeks of unpaid family leave for employees forced to take time off to care for a family member without losing their job. The intention here is to help ensure that NJ Residents will not be in a position to have to choose between caring for their loved ones, and their jobs in crises such as the COVID-19.

Today's message from Mayor Mignogna as he continues his recovery at home and is so grateful for the overwhelming love and support. We have been sharing stories of how you have stepped as a community to help one another and he asked that you continue to do what you can to help one another out. As the Governor said on Monday, we are going through hell and back together, so let's do this right so we only have to do this once. Remember asymptomatic carriers are a concern so please make sure you wear facemasks when you are out on essential business. You could be spreading the virus without even knowing it.

Our schools are returning from their stay-at-home Spring Break this week and today we applaud all of the parents in town who are finding their inner teaching and tutoring skills, and we applaud our K-8 district and Eastern for their dedication to our students and their education. Necessity is the mother of invention and we recognize that our school districts and our residents have been adjusting to this new educational landscape and doing their very best. One of my favorite things to tell my own children is "do the best you can, to do the best you can".

We know it's difficult and that you and your families miss visiting so many of the special places that we all enjoy here in town, but we implore everyone to stay diligent in their social distancing efforts so that when we come back together as a community, we are stronger and healthy.

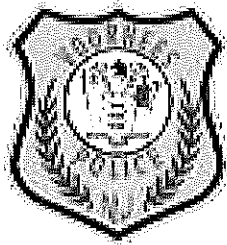

In order to protect the health and safety of the community and our employees, and to help minimize the spread of COVID-19, Voorhees Township Town Hall will be temporarily closed to the public and non-essential employees for a one week period beginning Monday, March 16, 2020. The closure will remain in effect through March 22, 2020, at which time the situation will be reevaluated. All essential Township operations including police, fire, and public works will continue. Trash and recycling will continue to be collected.

This closure includes Municipal Court.

We will be reviewing all scheduled public meetings, including meetings of Township Committee, to determine whether they are necessary for the continuation of government operations.

Township officials, along with the Emergency Management Coordinator, have been meeting regularly to address and respond to the latest guidance for our community. The Township maintains an Emergency Operations Plan to ensure our ability to continue essential services to our residents, as well as support State and local health efforts.

We ask for your cooperation as we do our best to continue non-essential operations in a more limited capacity.

Waking up grateful. Last night I was selected by my fellow committee members to serve another year as Deputy Mayor. It was a monumental evening as we also welcomed another female Jacklyn Kassab Fetbroyt to the VOORHEES Township Committee. A special thank you to Katie Hardesty for stepping in to hold the Bible for me. I couldn't think of a more fitting thing than having two women I respect by my side.

My remarks were short but hopefully meaningful because I have a feeling this is going to be a year where political tensions cause some emotional fevers for many of us. Please remember to respect and honor your differences, even when it's the ones around political opinions. My family lost one of the great humans that we were proud to call our own during 2019, and I was reminded as we all are during moments of immeasurable loss that life is much shorter than we ever project and that while we are busy being wrapped up in our own little beehives, time is not waiting for any of us to keep those "someday" promises we make to ourselves and others. This past year, along with my career and intimate conversations with clients over the years around their finances and goals have taught me that almost universally, no matter what your religious beliefs or political opinions, few people look back on their life and wish they had done more worrying, more arguing, or spent more time on any other soul sucking behaviors. They wish instead that they had spent more time doing things they loved and with the people they love and cherish. I learned some hard lessons this past year about life, friendships and who is really there to wipe your tears, but I won't let them harden me. I am present to a new question I ask myself every single day courtesy of my coach @julieketovercoaching which is "What do you want your life to look like?" And I am making changes moment by moment to discover the answer to a simple question that stunned me the first time I heard it, but is a constant beacon for accountability around my daily choices and commitments.

My speech and message from last night:

Thank you to Donna Platt for swearing me in. Donna is the first female prosecutor in VOORHEES, something I am proud to have cast a vote for while on committee. She's done incredible things for our town and for our public safety team. I didn't prepare a formal speech for tonight because tonight belongs to Jackie. I couldn't be more proud as a mother join to have another female join me on committee. 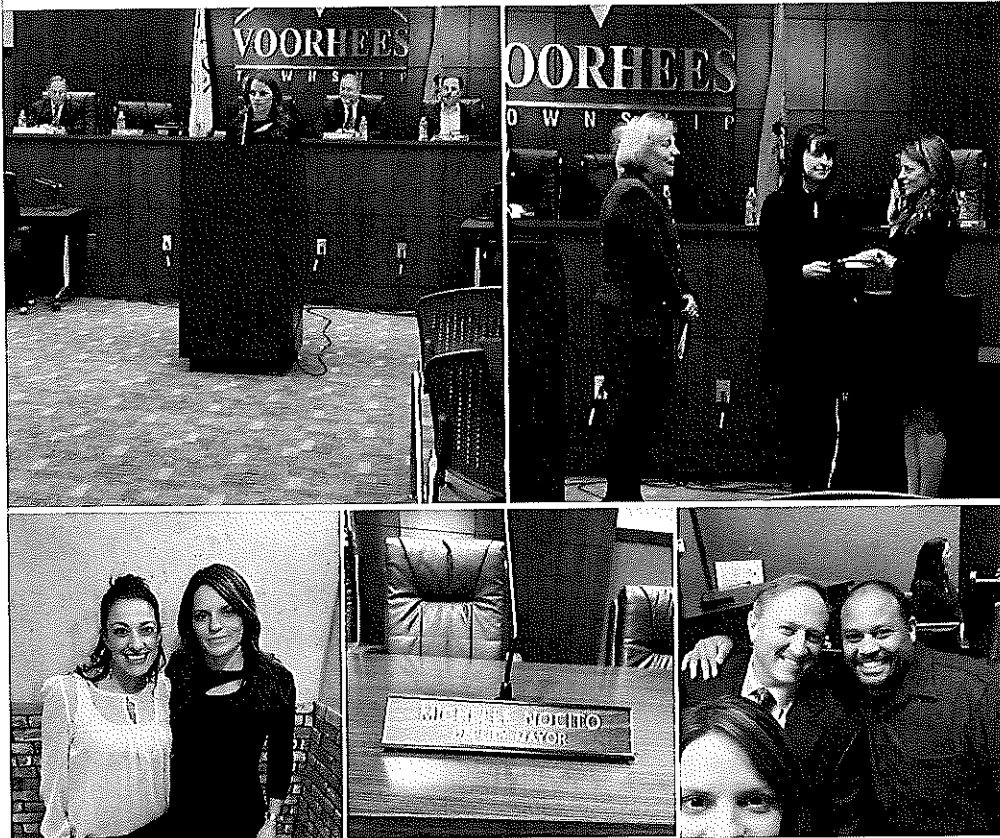
