I used my phone and screen shoted the comments that I could find, and then printed them out for you they are in your box.

I confirmed that as of this writing NO PERSON is banned from our OPD facebook page.

Sgt. Perruli, Leimburg and allegedly Weir using someones logins all deleted persons or photos over the last 2 days, however the people have been reinstated or unblocked.

I have built this page from scratch, and for many years it was our only interaction with residents to provide up to date information and advisories prior to us utilizing the reverse 911 more.

Our page is always well received, and people always forward to Oceanport residents page.

I would hate to lose the Facebook page, however there are too many hands in the pot, if I didn't get that call this could have been a lot worse, but I can not help you if it stays this way.

Please issue an order that no person is to delete posts/pictures or ban any person from the page without staff on call approval.

In addition no officer with the exception of Perrulli, Tucci, Petrillo, Leimburg and Grimes should be accessing our page and posting anything. We need to research how to archive our social media, and or the cost to have a 3rd party contractor such as Targeted do it for us.

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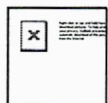

JUDGE RULES THAT TRUMP CANNOT BLOCK HIS CRITICS ON TWITTER A federal judge in New York has said that President Donald Trump violates the First Amendment by blocking critics on Twitter for political speech. Judge Naomi Reice Buchwald in Manhattan issued the written decision on Wednesday. In the ruling, she said no government official - including the president - is above the law. The case was brought last July by the Knight First Amendment Institute at Columbia University and seven individuals blocked by Mr Trump after criticising the Republican president. After a hearing this year, the judge had suggested that President Trump mute rather than block some of his critics. At the time, a Justice Department attorney agreed that muting would enable President Trump to avoid a tweet he does not want to read.
