Communication Media Policy:

The Township's Communication Media are the property of the Township and, as such, are to be used for legitimate business purposes only. For purposes of this Communication Media Policy, "Communication Media" includes all electronic media forms provided by the Township, such as cell phones, smart phones, computers, electronic tablets, access to the internet, voicemail, email, and fax.

All data stored on and/or transmitted through Communication Media is the property of the Township. For purposes of this policy, "Data" includes "electronically-stored files, programs, tables, data bases, audio and video objects, spreadsheets, reports and printed or microfiche materials which serve a Township business purpose, regardless of who creates, processes or maintains the data, or whether the data is processed manually or through any of the Township's mainframe, midrange or workstations; servers, routers, gateways, bridges, hubs, switches and other hardware components of the Township's local or wide-area networks."

The Township respects the individual privacy of its employees. However, employee communications transmitted by the Township Communication Media are not private to the individual. **All Communication Media and all communications and stored information transmitted, received, or contained in or through such media may be monitored by the Township. The Township reserves the absolute right to access, review, audit and disclose all matters entered into, sent over, placed in storage in the Township's Communication Media.** By using the Township's equipment and/or Communication Media, employees consent to have such use monitored at any time, with or without notice, by Township personnel. The existence of passwords does not restrict or eliminate the Township's ability or right to access electronic communications. However, the Township cannot require the employee to provide its password to his/her personal account.

All email, voicemail and Internet messages (including any technology-based messaging) are official documents subject to the provisions of the Open Public Records Act (NJSA 47:1A-1). Employees of the Township are required to use the assigned municipal email account for ALL Township business and correspondence. The use of private email accounts for ANY Township business or during business hours is strictly prohibited.

Employees can only use the Township's Communication Media for legitimate business purposes. Employees may not use Township Communication Media in any way that is defamatory, obscene, or harassing or in violation of any Township rules or policy. Examples of forbidden transmissions or downloads include sexually-explicit messages; unwelcome propositions; ethnic or racial slurs; or any other message that can be construed to be harassment or disparaging to others based on their actual or perceived age, race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, genetic information, disability, national origin, ethnicity, citizenship, marital status or any other legally recognized protected basis under federal, state or local laws, regulations or ordinances.

All employees, who have been granted access to electronically-stored data, must use a login ID assigned by the Township. Certain data, or applications that process data, may require additional

security measures as determined by the Township. Employees must not share their passwords; and each employee is responsible for all activity that occurs in connection with their passwords.

All employees may access only data for which the Township has given permission. All employees must take appropriate actions to ensure that Township data is protected from unauthorized access, use or distribution consistent with these policies. Employees may not access or retrieve any information technology resource and store information other than where authorized.

Employees must not disable anti-virus and other implemented security software for any reason, in order to minimize the risk of introducing computer viruses into the Township's computing environment.

Employees may not install or modify ANY hardware device, software application, program code, either active or passive, or a portion thereof, without the express written permission from the Township. Employees may not upload, download, or otherwise transmit commercial software or any copyrighted materials belonging to parties outside of the Township, or licensed to the Township. Employees shall observe the copyright and licensing restrictions of all software applications and shall not copy software from internal or external sources unless legally authorized.

The Township encourages employees to share information with co-workers and with those outside the Township for the purpose of gathering information, generating new ideas and learning from the work of others to the extent such sharing is permitted by the Township. Social media provide inexpensive, informal and timely ways to participate in an exchange of ideas and information. However, information posted on a website is available to the public; therefore, employees must adhere to the following guidelines for their participation in social media. Employees may engage in social media activity during work time through the use of the Township's Communication Media, provided that it is directly related to their work and it is in compliance with this policy.

Employees must not reveal or publicize confidential Township information. Confidential proprietary or sensitive information may be disseminated only to individuals with a need and a right to know, and where there is sufficient assurance that appropriate security of such information will be maintained. Such information includes, but is not limited to the transmittal of personnel information such as medical records or related information. In law enforcement operations, confidential, proprietary or sensitive information also includes criminal history information, confidential informant identification, and intelligence and tactical operations files.

Employees are prohibited from releasing or disclosing any photographs, pictures, digital images of any crime scenes, traffic crashes, arrestees, detainees, people or job related incident or occurrence taken with the Township's Communication Media to any person, entity, business or media or Internet outlet whether on or off duty without the express written permission of the Municipal Administrator. Except in "emergency situations," Employees are prohibited from taking digital images or photographs with media equipment not owned by the Township. For purposes of this section, an "emergency situation" involves a sudden and unforeseen combination of circumstances or the resulting state that calls for immediate action, assistance or relief, and may include

accidents, crimes and flights from accidents or crimes and the employee does not have access to the Township's Communication Media. If such situation occurs, employee agrees that any images belong to the Township and agree to release the image to the Township and ensure its permanent deletion from media device upon direction from the Township.

No media advertisement, electronic bulletin board posting, or any other posting accessible via the Internet about the Township or on behalf of the Township, whether through the use of the Township's Communication Media or otherwise, may be issued unless it has first been approved by the Municipal Administrator. Under no circumstances may information of a confidential, sensitive or otherwise proprietary nature be placed or posted on the Internet or otherwise disclosed to anyone outside the Township.

Because (authorized) postings placed on the Internet through use of the Township's Communication Media will display on the Township's return address, any information posted on the Internet must reflect and adhere to all of the Township's standards and policies.

All users are personally accountable for messages that they originate or forward using the Township's Communication Media. Misrepresenting, obscuring, suppressing, or replacing a user's identity on any Communication Media is prohibited. "Spoofing" (constructing electronic communications so that it appears to be from someone else) is prohibited.

Employees must respect the laws regarding copyrights, trademarks, rights of public Township and other third-party rights. Any use of the Township's name, logos, service marks or trademarks outside the course of the employee's employment, without the express consent of the Township, is strictly prohibited. To minimize the risk of a copyright violation, employees should provide references to the source(s) of information used and cite copyrighted works identified in online communications.

To the extent that employees use social media outside of their employment and in so doing employees identify themselves as Township employees, or if they discuss matters related to the Township on a social media site, employees must add a disclaimer on the front page, stating that it does not express the views of the Township, and the employee is expressing only their personal views. For example: "The views expressed on this website/web log are mine alone and do not necessarily reflect the views of my employer." Place the disclaimer in a prominent position and repeat it for each posting that is expressing an opinion related to the Township or the Township's business. Employees must keep in mind that, if they post information on a social media site that is in violation of Township policy and/or federal, state or local laws, the disclaimer will not shield them from disciplinary action.

Nothing in these policies is designed to interfere with, restrain or prevent employee communications regarding wages, hours or other terms and conditions of employment. Township employees have the right to engage in or refrain from such activities.

With regards to the Hazlet Township Police Department, my office is in receipt of your request for records pursuant to the Open Public Records Act (NJSA 27:1A-1), dated June 23rd, 2018. The request was received by my office on June 25th, 2018. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is July 5th, 2018. This response is being provided on June 27th, 2018.

The Hazlet Township Police Department does not delete, block or ban any author's comments, but rather utilizes an automatic filter provided by Facebook which will automatically hide comments that use certain vulgar or potential SPAM-like terms. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the court clerk in your county.

PURPOSE The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance to the employees of the Hazlet Police Department concerning their personal web pages, websites, and other electronic social networking sites. A further purpose is to regulate this department's procedures concerning its social media/networking site(s).

POLICY While employees have a right to maintain personal web pages and websites, their status as members of the Hazlet Police Department requires that the content of those web pages and websites are not in violation of existing agency rules, regulations, policies, procedures, or create a potential conflict of interest. The Chief of Police reserves the right to restrict an employee's involvement in electronic social networking sites for the good of the agency.

It is further the policy of the Hazlet Police Department to utilize electronic social media to advise the public on matters of concern, foster community outreach efforts, investigate crimes, and to provide a mechanism for citizen feedback while safeguarding the Hazlet Police Department's professionalism.

PROCEDURES

I. GENERAL

A. Definitions:

1. Avatar – A computer user's representation of himself/herself, or an alter ego.
2. Blog – A series of electronic entries, diary or commentary, written by one or more persons in an on-line journal that may permit visitors to post responses, reactions or comments. The term is an abbreviated version of 'web-log'.
3. Comments – Responses to a blog post, news article, social media entry or other social networking post.
4. Commenting – The act of creating and posting a response to a blog post, news article, social media entry or other social networking post. Commenting can also entail the act of posting an original composition to an unrelated post or article.
5. Forum – An online discussion site.
6. Hazlet police personnel – Includes all sworn and non-sworn personnel.
7. Identity – An online identity, Internet identity or Internet persona that a social networking user establishes. This can be a real name, an alias, a pseudonym or a creative description.
8. Mobile social networking – Social networking using a mobile phone or other cellular based device.
9. Page – The specific portion of a social media website where content is displayed, and managed by an individual or individuals with administrator rights.
10. Post – The content a person shares on a social media site or blog; an entry to any type of computerized bulletin board; the act of publishing content on a social media site.
11. Posting – The act of creating, uploading, editing or adding to any social media outlet. This includes text, photographs, audio, video or any other multimedia file.
12. Profile – Information that a user provides about himself or herself on a social networking site.
13. Social networks – Online platforms where users can create profiles, share information, and socialize with others using a range of technologies.

14. Social media – A category of Internet-based resources that integrate user-generated content that allow people to communicate, share information, share photos, share videos, share audio and exchange text and other multimedia files with others via some form of online or cellular network platform. This includes, but is not limited to, social networking sites (Facebook®, MySpace®), micro-blogging sites (Twitter®), photo- and video-sharing sites (Flickr®, YouTube®), wikis (Wikipedia®), blogs, and news sites (Digg®, Reddit®).
 15. Speech – Expression or communication of thoughts or opinions in spoken words, in writing, by expressive conduct, symbolism, photographs, videotape, or related forms of communication.
 16. Web 2.0 – The second generation of the World Wide Web focused on shareable, user-generated content, rather than static web pages. Some use this term interchangeably with social media.
 17. Wiki – Web page(s) that can be edited collaboratively. Post: an item inserted to a blog or an entry to any type of computerized bulletin board or forum.
- B. There are no reasonable expectations of privacy while engaging in social media efforts. All social media is subject to public view and comment, criminal defense and prosecutorial review, and review by this agency.
 - C. Conduct both on and off duty is subject to the rules and regulations of this agency. Any electronic social networking activity that brings discredit to the Hazlet Police Department and/or of an employee's status as an employee of this agency is prohibited.
 - D. Employees shall not express personal opinion as official agency policy or position.
 - E. Employees shall not display or post any image or comment involving a reference concerning any form of bias, hatred, or derogatory comments about any protected class of persons.
 - F. Except while in the course of official law enforcement business (e.g., intelligence gathering, criminal investigation, homeland security, etc.), employees shall not assume the identity of another or an identity that could be assumed to be a factual (e.g., alias, penname, avatar, etc.) while posting any comments.

II. DEPARTMENTAL USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA

- A. Sanctioned Presence
 1. Determine strategy
 - a. Where possible, each social media page shall include an introductory statement that clearly specifies the purpose and scope of the agency's presence on the website.
 - b. Where possible, the page(s) should link to the Hazlet Police Department's official website.

- c. Social media page(s) shall be designed for targeted Township residents such as youth or potential police recruits.

2. Procedures

- a. All Hazlet Police Department social media sites or pages shall be approved by the Chief of Police or his/her designee and shall be administered by the Chief of Police or his/her designee.
- b. Where possible, social media pages shall clearly indicate they are maintained by the Hazlet Police Department and shall have Hazlet Police Department contact information prominently displayed.
- c. Social media content shall adhere to applicable laws, regulations, and policies, including all information technology and records management policies.
- d. Where possible, social media pages should state that the opinions expressed by visitors to the page(s) do not reflect the opinions of the Hazlet Police Department.
- e. Pages shall clearly indicate that posted comments will be monitored and that the Hazlet Police Department reserves the right to remove obscenities, off-topic comments, personal attacks, and any posts that may identify juvenile offenders, endanger victims, or jeopardize an active investigation.

3. Sanctioned Use

- a. Hazlet Police Department personnel representing the Hazlet Police Department via social media outlets shall:
 - 1) Except where officially authorized by the Chief of Police, identify themselves as a member of the Hazlet Police Department and shall adhere to all existing federal, state, and local laws policies, standards of conduct, policies and procedures of the Hazlet Police Department, laws regarding public information on arrests, investigations, and personnel data, and shall observe conventionally accepted protocols and proper decorum.
 - 2) Under no circumstances, make statements about the guilt or innocence of any suspect or arrestee, or comments concerning pending prosecutions.
 - 3) Not post, transmit, or otherwise disseminate confidential information, including photographs or videos, related to Hazlet Police Department training, activities, or work-related assignments without the permission of the Chief of Police or his/her designee.
 - 4) Not conduct political activities or private business.

- 5) Not endorse any product or service without the prior written permission of the Chief of Police or his/her designee.
- b. The Chief of Police shall designate personnel to manage the department's social media. The designee is authorized to access such media from personally owned devices.
- c. Employees shall observe and abide by all copyright, trademark, and service mark restrictions in posting materials to electronic media.

III. PERSONAL USE

- A. Barring state law or binding employment contracts to the contrary, Hazlet Police Department personnel shall abide by the following when using social media while off duty and using privately owned property.
 1. Hazlet Police Department personnel are free to express themselves as private citizens on social media sites to the degree that their speech does not impair any working relationships within the Hazlet Police Department for which loyalty and confidentiality are important, impede the performance of duties, impair discipline and harmony among coworkers or negatively affect the public perception of the Hazlet Police Department.
 2. As public employees, Hazlet Police Department personnel are cautioned that speech, dealing in matters of public concern, on or off-duty, made pursuant to their official duties, that is, that owes its existence to the employee's professional duties and responsibilities, is not protected speech under the First Amendment and may form the basis for discipline if deemed detrimental to the Hazlet Police Department. Hazlet Police Department personnel should assume that their speech and related activity on social media sites will reflect upon their office and the Hazlet Police Department.
 3. Employees are prohibited from using Hazlet Police Department computers or cell phones / MDTs or any other devices for any unauthorized purpose, including participation in social media or social networking.
 4. This prohibition shall include the use of departmental computers for bidding, buying and / or selling of personal items on such sites as E-Bay or similar activities that shall instead be conducted on an employee's personal computer.
 5. Employees are prohibited from updating / posting to any social media or social networking platform from a department-owned device while on duty, (except while on an approved break or meal period, but not using a department-owned device) unless written permission is granted for investigative or public information purposes.
 6. Hazlet Police Department personnel shall not post any information concerning their employment with the Hazlet Police Department that would be deemed inappropriate, offensive, or in violation of any rule, regulation or policy of the Hazlet Police Department, nor shall they post information pertaining to any other member of the Hazlet Police Department without that employee's permission. As such, Hazlet Police Department personnel shall not:

- a. Post personal photographs, or provide similar means of personal recognition that would cause them to be identified as a police officer of the Hazlet Police Department that would be deemed inappropriate, offensive, or in violation of any rule, regulation or policy of the Hazlet Police Department.
- b. Post false or improper personal or professional information (e.g., college degree when one was not earned, training certification when one was not earned, etc.)
- c. Unless granted explicit permission, employees of the Hazlet Police Department are prohibited from posting any of the following on any social networking platform, either on their own sites, the sites of others known to them, the sites of others unknown to them, news media pages, or other information exchange forums:
 - 1) Any text, photograph, audio, video, or any other multimedia file related to any investigation (criminal, quasi-criminal, or administrative), both current and past, of the Hazlet Police Department.
 - 2) Any text, photograph, audio, video, or any other multimedia file related to any past or current action of the Hazlet Police Department, either in homage or critique.
 - 3) Logos, badges, seals, uniforms, vehicles, equipment or any item or symbol that is affiliated with the Hazlet Police in an inappropriate or offensive manner or in a way that is in violation of any rule or regulation or policy of the Hazlet Police Department.
 - 4) Any item, symbol, wording, number, likeness or material that is identifiable to the Hazlet Police Department in an inappropriate or offensive manner or in a way that is in violation of any rule or regulation or policy of the Hazlet Police Department.
 - 5) Any text, photograph, audio, video, or any other multimedia file that is related to any occurrence within the Hazlet Police Department in an inappropriate or offensive manner or in a way that is in violation of any rule or regulation or policy of the Hazlet Police Department.
 - 6) Weaponry, owned by this department and/or owned personally or privately, shall not be displayed or referenced to, in any multimedia format, on social media or social networking sites if such displays or depictions promote or glorify violence.
 - 7) Any text, photograph, audio, video or any other multimedia file included on a social media or social networking site that infers, implies, states, opines or otherwise expresses the officer's views on the public shall not be detrimental to the

department's mission, nor shall it in any way undermine the public's trust or confidence in this department.

7. When using social media, Hazlet Police Department personnel should be mindful that their postings becomes part of the worldwide electronic domain. Therefore, adherence to the Hazlet Police Department's code of conduct is required in the personal use of social media. In particular, Hazlet Police Department personnel are prohibited from the following:
 - a. Postings containing obscene or sexually explicit language, images, or acts and statements or other forms of speech that ridicule, malign, disparage, or otherwise express bias against any race, any religion, or any protected class of individuals.
 - b. Postings involving themselves or other Hazlet Police Department personnel reflecting behavior that would reasonably be considered reckless or irresponsible.
 8. Engaging in prohibited postings noted herein may provide grounds for undermining or impeaching an officer's testimony in criminal proceedings. Hazlet Police Department personnel thus sanctioned are subject to discipline up to and including termination of office.
 9. Hazlet Police Department personnel may not divulge information gained by reason of their authority; make any statements, speeches, appearances, and endorsements; or publish materials that could reasonably be considered to represent the views or positions of this Hazlet Police Department without expressed written authorization.
 10. Hazlet Police Department personnel should expect that any information created, transmitted, downloaded, exchanged, or discussed in a public online forum may be accessed by the Hazlet Police Department at any time without prior notice.
- B. Employees have the potential to be called as a witness in court proceedings related to their employment as a member of this agency. Credibility and character are subject to challenge and potential impeachment based upon the nature of postings on personal web pages, websites and other electronic social networking sites from any time, past or present and the person(s) or organization(s) with whom the employee networks.
- C. Employees shall not network with judges, attorneys, court personnel, or other members of the judiciary or defense attorneys as it may result in adverse consequences to the operation of the police department or the Prosecutor's Office when prosecuting or attempting to prosecute criminal and civil matters. Examples of such consequences include, but are not limited to:
1. Having to change prosecution venues if a conflict of interest is alleged;
 2. Rendering testimony of investigative personnel inadmissible or impeachable due to alleged conflicts of interest due electronic personal relationships;
 3. An increase in successful appeals due to perceived conflicts of interest.

IV. REPORTING VIOLATIONS

- A. Any employee becoming aware of or having knowledge of a posting or of any website or web page in violation of the provision of this policy shall notify his or her supervisor immediately for follow-up action.

V. APPROVAL PROCESS

- A. Any employee seeking approval to use any item, object, or material described in subsection III.A.6 on a personal webpage or site shall submit a written request through the chain of command to the Chief of Police.
 - 1. Describe the proposed reference to the agency and purpose.
 - 2. Provide a list of media to be used on the web page.
 - 3. Provide a printed layout of the material that is the subject of the request.
- B. The Chief of Police will approve or deny the request based upon the merits of the request and its compliance with existing agency policy or other written directives.
