Subject: General Order 17-004 SOCIAL MEDIA COMMENTING POLICY

Effective immediately and until further notice, this General Order shall apply to all members of the Bradley Beach Police Department:

### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this policy is to establish effective guidelines which are clear and concise regarding all comments, posts or any other notations submitted or published to the department's social media sites. The purpose is to maintain only content that is courteous, respectful and relevant.

### **Policy:**

The Borough of Bradley Beach Police Department shares notices about municipal government and police activity via social media to reach a broader audience and build strong community relationships. Public responses on social media sites should not be used to replace making any official communication to the borough, for example, reporting crimes, misconduct, dangerous conditions, requesting inspections, giving notice required by any statute, by ordinance or regulations such as but not limited to notices of claim. Official communications shall be made to the appropriate municipal department via contact information as provided on the borough website. Prominent notice of this policy shall be displayed for public view on every active social media site utilized by this department.

The Borough of Bradley Beach obligations with social media require us to enforce the providers' policies with regard to posted comments. The guidelines below are, in part, the boroughs effort to comply with those obligations.

Content of public comments must remain courteous, respectful and relevant. Remember that your comments may be read by persons of any age, and are subject to open public records laws.

In detail, we've established the following guidelines. If a post or comment is found in violation of the policy, it will be removed.

The Borough of Bradley Beach Police Department reserves the right to delete submissions that contain:

- comments containing vulgar, offensive, threatening, harassing language, personal or defamatory attacks of any kind;
- unsupported accusations;
- offensive comments that target or disparage any ethnic, racial or religious group;
- spam or include links to other sites;
- comments that are clearly off topic from the original post;
- identical or repeated comments;
- any and all sexual content or links to sexual content;
- advocate or encourage violence or any other illegal activity;
- threats to any person or organization;
- promote particular services, products, or political candidates or organizations;
- infringe on copyrights or trademarks;
- have the potential to compromise the safety or security of the public or public systems, buildings and grounds;
- are made by persons identifiably under the age of 13;
- contain personally identifiable medical information; or
- contain personally identifiable information such as email addresses, social security numbers, phone numbers or any other information for which a person has a reasonable expectation of privacy.
- photographs or videos;
- conduct in violation of any federal, state or local law.

Users who violate this policy may be banned from future commenting or blocked from the social media site where the violation occurred.

Please note that the public comments expressed on any borough social media site do not reflect the opinions and position of the municipal government or its officers and staff.

We recognize that the internet and social media sites are available 24/7. Comments are welcome at any time. However, due to the need to manage resources, questions and comments will be managed when resources are available to do so.

**Any procedure which conflicts with this order is hereby rescinded. Supervisors shall be held accountable for the application and enforcement of this order. All members of the Bradley Beach Police Department are to follow this order as applicable. Violations of this order will subject members of this department to disciplinary action.**

I have been married 11 years & as you can imagine I am completely heart broken! Here's a tiny description of where we were: My husband said if he had to estimate the description. We entered the 1st entrance to beach by Third Avenue went straight on the beach maybe a little to the right. Then went to the left by the lifeguards to going swimming in between the ropes. When we swam we keep drifting to the left. Meaning if your standing in front of lifeguard chairs looking at the ocean. He says maybe we swam out away from beach 50-60 yards. .

**Request for Assistance in U-Visa Application**

Dear Chief Guida:

I write to you today on behalf of **Ricardo Escarcega Ramos**, a victim of sexual domestic violence. I represent him in a petition for U Nonimmigrant Status (U Visa).

On June 10, 2007, Mr. Ricardo Escarcega Ramos was the victim of domestic violence at the hands of Mr. David McInerney (Exhibit 1). Mr. Escarcega Ramos was physically pushed by Mr. McInerney during a domestic argument (Exhibits 1 and 2). Mr. Escarcega Ramos continues to suffer psychological injuries as a result of the ongoing abuse which subsisted in June 2007 (Exhibit 2).

Below page is a chart showing the requirements for qualifying for a U visa and how Ricardo Escarcega Ramos meets those requirements:

We respectfully request that you assist us in helping him by filling out the attached Law Enforcement Certification (LEIC Supplement B (Exhibit 3), Pages 2 - 4 of the attached guide explains each entry of the document. Additionally, attached you will find Instructions for Form I-918 Supplement B (Exhibit 4) along with a completed sample of the form (Exhibit 5). If you are satisfied with the completed Supplement-B sample, you may sign the provided form or complete a blank one at your own discretion.

I am attaching for your review a guide written by the Department of Homeland Security for law enforcement entitled, "LEIC Supplement B: Law Enforcement Guidance" (Exhibit 6). This guide was written by law enforcement for law enforcement to explain precisely what the U-Visa process is and what your role would be in this process. The guide makes it clear that "Federal, State, and local law enforcement agencies do not grant or guarantee a U visa or any other immigration status by signing a U visa certificate."

I hope you will consider helping Mr. Escarcega Ramos obtain his immigration for legal status in the U.S. Nothing we do can help undo the trauma he has suffered, but hopefully something good can come out of this horrible experience.
